### SYNOPSIS:

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report

On 11-18-09, at about 8:53 A.M., a female juvenile was walking to school, near the area of Apple Street and Paraiso Avenue, when she was approached by a Hispanic male adult in a late model dark blue minivan. The female juvenile has never seen this person before. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male adult approximately 40 years old, unshaven goatee, short unkempt hair, about 6'-0", wearing a brown shirt. The minivan was described as being a late model dark blue minivan with miscellaneous dents and scratches.

As the suspect pulled his vehicle along side of the female juvenile, he asked her if she wanted a ride to school. The juvenile told him no and that she was fine. The subject then stated, "I've been watching you and your sisters." The juvenile became unsettled to the fact the subject knew she had sisters. The suspect asked the subject how he knew she had sisters and he replied, "I've been watching you and seeing you around here." The subject asked the female juvenile for her phone number and she told him she did not have one. As the juvenile continued to walk, the subject continued to insist he give her a ride to school. The juvenile became frightened and ran to the 7-11 Store, located on Jamacha Road and Grand Avenue, where she called her mother and waited until deputies arrived.

A BOL was sent out to surrounding agencies of the suspect and vehicle description. A check of the surrounding area turned out negative for the suspect and suspect's vehicle. Lemon Grove detectives will be conducting further investigation.
