## **Armed Robbery Suspect Caught on Tape** **Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered**

November 4, 2009

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** is joining forces with San Diego County Sheriff's Department Ramona detectives to help identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for robbing a Chevron gas station in Ramona.

*Detectives said that on October 16, 2009 at approximately 11:30 p.m., an unknown suspect, armed with a rifle, entered the Chevron gas station located at 802 Main Street in Ramona. The suspect immediately demanded money from the male cashier. The cashier refused to give in to the suspect's demand and a fight ensued. At some point during the fight the cashier got control of the rifle and chased the suspect off of the premises. The suspect fled on foot.*

*The cashier suffered minor injuries to his head, face, jaw and left hand.*

Suspect description:

- Male, about 18-21 years old, 5'10" tall, with a thin build. He was wearing a black jacket, grey mask with eye holes cut out and dark pants.
- The black jacket and mask were later found near the scene.

*A copy of the video from the store surveillance cameras will be available at Sheriff's Headquarters located at 9621 Ridgehaven Court San Diego, Ca 92193.*

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest.
