SUBJECT: Deputy Involved Shooting

LOCATION: Highway 125 Northbound, North of Grossmont College Drive, Santee

The following information is fragmentary and has not been completely verified. It is based, in part, on hearsay and is intended for early information use rather than being a formal investigative report.

On September 8, 2017 at about 6:40 p.m., deputies from the Sheriff's Santee Station responded to a report of a male threatening to commit suicide. Deputies learned a possible location of the subject and began searching the area. At about 6:55 p.m. deputies located the subject inside a vehicle parked on the right shoulder of the Northbound Highway 125, just north of the Grossmont College Drive exit. After a deputy made contact with the male, he refused to cooperate. The male then exited his vehicle, armed with what appeared to be a handgun.

A confrontation ensued, which culminated in a deputy involved shooting. The facts surrounding the confrontation are currently under investigation by the Sheriff's Homicide Detail. The suspect was treated at the scene by deputies before medics transported him to a local hospital. The male has not yet been identified and is currently being treated for his injuries. The involved deputies were not injured.
