### SYNOPSIS:

On Tuesday, November 03, 2009, at approximately 0700 hours, Lemon Grove Detectives conducted a 4<sup>th</sup> waiver search at a residence located inside the Villas of Casa De Oro apartment complex at 3860 Helix Street. Based on an ongoing robbery series investigation being conducted by Sheriff's Lemon Grove Detective Bill Kerr, potential suspects were identified living at the specific residence inside the complex. During the past two weeks the suspects had lured two pizza delivery drivers to a vacant residence inside the complex. Upon arrival, the drivers were confronted by two suspects, who were armed with what appeared to be a handgun. During one of the robberies, the victim was pistol whipped by one of the suspects when he did not immediately comply with the suspect's demands. During Detective Kerr's follow-up, he was able to identify a suspect residence at the location. As a result of the search/operation, two adult suspects and one juvenile suspect were taken into custody. Additionally, evidence was located inside the residence that was linked to the two robberies. Twenty-seven (27) year-old David Selmon and Twenty-five (25) year-old Clarence Rodgers were both arrested and booked into jail for the two pizza delivery robberies. In addition to the robberies, Selmon was identified as a parolee-at-large and Rodgers was wanted on an Assault with a Deadly Weapon warrant. A sixteen (16) year-old male was also taken into custody and booked into Juvenile Hall for possession of stolen property related to an armed robbery. The investigation is continuing.
