SYNOPSIS:

On June 18, 2017, at 8:56 p.m., deputies from the Poway Station responded to a two-vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of Poway Road and Carriage Road. It appeared from witness statements, the debris field, tire friction and gouge marks on the roadway that a 2002 Honda Civic was traveling westbound in the #1 lane on Poway Road. As it approached a red signal light at the controlled intersection at Carriage Road, it continued through the intersection without coming to a stop. A second vehicle, a 2000 Toyota Tundra was making a left-hand turn eastbound onto Poway Road from Carriage Road on a green signal light. As it went through the intersection, its front end collided into the rear right side of the Honda.

The driver of the Honda lost control of his vehicle and veered to the right. The vehicle drove over the raised curb and through a chain link fence. One of the metal posts from the fence was bent forward turning it into a raised ramp. This caused the Honda to go airborne as it went onto the property of Perry Ford Motors. The airborne Honda collided diagonally into a car on the sales lot which pushed it into the car next to it. The Honda rolled over the first vehicle and came to its uncontrolled point of rest on its roof after colliding into another parked car in the next isle.

The driver of the Honda, a 22-year-old male, sustained non-life threatening injuries. He was transported by paramedics to Palomar Hospital for evaluation and treatment. He was arrested for Driving Under the Influence. The driver of the Toyota left the scene after the collision. However, evidence left at the scene provided deputies with the name and address of the registered owner. The 26-year-old male was contacted at his residence and issued a Notice to Appear for Hit and Run.
