SYNOPSIS:

On November 9, 2017, at 3:47 p.m., deputies were dispatched to a missing person at risk call. Upon investigation it was determined that 91 year old, Ralph Solis Reyes Sr., drove away from his residence in a red 4 door 1999 Chevrolet Metro to a medical appointment he believed he had somewhere in the city of San Diego. The reporting party, Ralph Solis Reyes Jr. said his father did not have a medical appointment and called his father on his cell phone. Reyes Sr. answered his cell phone around noon and said he was somewhere in San Diego heading to a

medical appointment. The phone is now turned off or not working and no one has heard or seen him since. There is no other family in town and no known location he may have gone. Reyes Sr. has not gone missing before. Reyes Sr. takes medications and suffers from memory loss.

DESCRIPTION: Reyes Sr. is a Hispanic male, about 5'4", 125 pounds, short gray hair, brown eyes, wearing unknown clothing, eyeglasses, and possibly a baseball cap.
