
### WAYS TO VERIFY IDENTITY

- Match fingerprints
- Run fingerprints
- Match picture with person's appearance
- Request identifying information from the inmate
- Match physical description with appearance
- Match newly obtained signature with original signature

### VERIEY IDENTITY cont

- Methods used more for in-house verification
  - Face cards
  - Wrist bands
  - Floor sheet
  - Floor evacuation list

### DETENTIONS P&P

#### • Q. 79 ARRAIGNMENT AND RELEASE UNDER P.C. 825

- All inmates not arraigned within 48 hours of arrest, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and official court holidays, will be released from custody pursuant to California Penal Code section 825.
- With the exception of Superior Court Bench Warrants, State Parole Warrants, and Out-of—County Warrants an inmate must be taken before a magistrate within 48 hours from the time of his/her arrest, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and official court holidays. When the 48 hours expires at a time when the court is not in session, the time will be extended to include the duration of the next regular court session

### DETENTIONS P&P cont

- Q. 71 INMATE RELEASES WHEN COMPUTER IS INOPERATIVE
  - DPS or designee will contact the Help Desk to determine the length of time
  - If outage exceeds four hours, DPT will;
    - Pull all documents from the custody record and make sure there are no additional pending cases.
    - B. Check the custody record for any pending warrants or holds.
    - C. Look at the Booking Intake/Personal Property Inventory (form J-15) to see if the arresting officer has written any information that is not already within the custody record.
  - DTP will submit records to Watch Commander for review to determine if release process will commence.


### ERRONEOUS RELEASE


- DPS will notify Watch Commander ASAP who will notify FTF and DIS
  - They will provide two copies of supporting documents
  - Two copies of inmate custody record
  - DP\$ will notify court should the inmate have future court dates
- Erroneous release crime report will be written
- Jail investigator will attempt to contact released inmate
- Warrant will be issued
- Upon re-arrest, inmate will be booked on same charges as the erroneously released booking

### TYPES OF RELEASES

- Removal order court order through immigration court
- Commitment released from prison
- Time served
- Bail
- Special circumstances
- Acquittal release from court per 1165 PC

### 1165 PC

• 1165. Where a general verdict is rendered or a finding by the court is made in favor of the defendant, except on a plea of not guilty by reason of insanity, a judgment of acquittal must be forthwith given. If such judgment is given, or a judgment imposing a fine only, without imprisonment for nonpayment is given, and the defendant is not detained for any other legal cause, he must be discharged, if in custody, as soon as the judgment is given, except that where the acquittal is because of a variance between the pleading and the proof which may be obviated by a new accusatory pleading, the court may order his detention, to the end that a new accusatory pleading may be preferred, in the same manner and with like effect as provided in Section 1117.

### TIME SERVED RELEASES

- an order from the court
- REQUIRES NOT FURTHER CONTACT WITH THE COURT SYSTEM IF...
  - Fines are paid
  - Suspended sentence

- Program time
- Good time
- Work time

- Early release time
- Credit for time served
- School time

MANDATED BY THE COURT/JUDGE



### PROCESSING ROR

#### "RELEASE ON OWN RECOGNIZANCE"

- Must clear wants and warrants
  - Fingerprint during booking
  - Automated fingerprint identification system
  - Hit/ no hits?
- Determine eligibility
  - charges

### PROCESSING ROR cont



Individual must sign acknowledging information

Potential to miss court date and warrant will be issued

### BAIL

- Confirm eligibility
  - 187, 664, 209, hold (INS, PROB etc.) NOT ELIGIBLE
- Inform inmate of bail amount using the J-15 (handout)
- All information must be accurate for bail to be set (handout)

Purpose of posting bail?

- INI
- Different types of bail? (form)
  - Cash Bail
  - Professional Bail
  - Self Bail
  - Bail on Appeal

### CONFIRMING BAIL BOND

- Signed by notary/ agent
- Amount equal to bail set
- Correct court date and jurisdiction
- No holds on insurance company
- Offense/ charge stated
- Name booked under must match name on bond
- Warrant and case number or booking number

## HANDLING INMATE PROPERTY

- Sealed property bags
  - Inmate must sign acknowledging receipt
- Unclaimed property is retained by our agency for \_\_\_\_\_ days.
- Transfer to other agency

### **EACHLITY TRANSFER**

- Module and Personal property (training bulletin)
  - Log # of bags being transferred in JIMS inmate history
- Sealed medical records
- Face cards
- Booking jacket
