 Deputy Will Ward **End of Watch:** November 27, 1899 **Deputy Ward** succumbed to wounds sustained when he was beaten by a prisoner he was transporting to San Quentin on the Steamship Santa Rosa.

SDSO Deputy Lydia Warner

October, 1992 prisoner Jonathan George broke out of a Sheriff's Trans van, overpowered Deputy Warner and took her handgun. Armed with her service pistol, George used it to carjack and murder passing motorist Mark Champion. Warner was beaten, but survived her injuries.
