- Trained
- Qualified
- Section 11
- I.85
  - **Deputies shall not use the Electronic Immobilization Shield on an incarcerated person known or suspected to be pregnant, or in recovery after delivery.**



# Electronic Immobilization Shield

- Minimum of 1 trained deputy per shift
- Display of device
- Digital video recording
- After action plan
