**Course Summary:**

This course will focus on the policies and procedures related to search and rescue during a fire response incident.

**Course Objectives:**

At the conclusion of this course, each trainee will be able to: Recognize the dangers inherent to a search and rescue action.

- Identify search and rescue equipment.
- Demonstrate search and rescue techniques during a simulated fire response. Identify the procedures for the safe evacuation of inmates.
- Identify logistical concerns related to evacuating inmates. Identify security procedures for the return of inmates to housing.

Instruction should be given on the procedures related to deploying search and rescue teams during a fire response incident including rescue team coordination, safety and communication issues prior to participating in training scenarios. Practical training exercises should be conducted to further develop effective and safe search techniques in various structural and low visibility conditions. Instruction should be given on evacuation procedures specific to the facility including, types of evacuations, evacuation routes, inmate movement procedures, staging and holding areas, staff responsibilities and evacuation of public and professional staff. Training scenarios should include various contingencies involved in the evacuation of staff and inmates. The entire team should participate in this training.
