## TRAINING REFRESHER INSTRUCTIONS

### Max Restraint with Cord Cuff

#### Course Summary:

The purpose of this training is to provide deputies a refresher on the policies and procedures in the use of cord cuff restraints and the application of cord cuffs to effectively maximally restrain a subject.

#### Course Objectives:

At the conclusion of this course, each trainee will be able to:

- Identify applicable policy and procedure sections related to the use of restraint equipment.
- Demonstrate the proper application of cord cuff restraints.
- Demonstrate the proper aftercare of a subject that is maximally restrained by cord cuffs.
