## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. When transporting incarcerated person(s), deputies will check out the next available facility radio unit number and transportation vehicle from Processing Control. This information, along with the name and booking number of the incarcerated persons being transported and the transport destination, is to be logged in the NOTES section of an Area Activity Log entry in the Jail Information Management System (JIMS) using the event type of TRANS. The information on the check-out board will be as follows:
  - Radio number located on the "Property of S.D. County" sticker on the back of the radio. This

number is also engraved on the side of the radio just below the transmission key.

- Deputy(s) name, ARJIS(s) Contact Phone Number and destination.
- Time and date logged out/in
- The Processing Control Deputy will be responsible for logging this information into JIM's.
- 2. When ready to transport, advise the Communications Center Govt. Code 6255(a)
