Subject: FAGILITY SEGURITY TRASH CONTROL

## PROCEDURE:

I. Disposal of security trash shall be under the control of the on-duty team. Any waste article that may pose a threat to the security of the facility or an individual will be disposed of in a controlled manner.

- II. The Inside Kitchen Deputy will remove any/all security trash, which has accumulated in all areas except House 3 and House 4. Security trash will be placed in the locked blue dumpster located in the Inside Kitchen loading/unloading area. The Inside Kitchen Deputy during nightshift will pick up all security trash accumulated inside the facility once per shift. Once field day is completed, the Inside Kitchen Deputy will ensure all security trash is placed in the locked blue dumpster located in the Inside Kitchen loading/unloading area.
- III. House 3 and House 4 Deputies will ensure all security trash is placed inside the locked security trash bins located in the lower staff break area. When security trash bins become full, House 3 and House 4 Deputies are responsible for ensuring all security trash is placed in the locked blue dumpster located in the Inside Kitchen loading/unloading area.
- IV. Biomedical waste (waste which is generated or has been used in the diagnosis, treatment, or immunization which may contain infectious agents and may pose a substantial threat to health) shall be labeled with an 18" strip of black and yellow tape. Place the black and yellow tape across the middle of the clear bags prior to removing the waste from the medical dispensary. Biomedical waste shall be disposed of in locked dumpsters inside the safety area adjacent to the inside kitchen.
- V. Bio-hazardous waste (Surgical specimens including human parts or tissues removed surgically or by an autopsy, recognizable blood elements, hypodermic needles, syringes, surgical blades, etc.) disposal is the responsibility of the East Mesa Reentry Facility Medical Staff. Bio-hazardous waste shall be disposed of in a Bio-Hazardous infectious red waste bag located in the medical examination room.
