PROCEDURE:

The incarcerated persons assigned to the East Mesa Reentry Facility (EMRF) will be allowed one visit per week. Visits will last 30 minutes for the incarcerated persons in Houses 3 & 4 and 1 hour for the incarcerated persons in Dorms A-D. The incarcerated persons should arrange their visits in advance to avoid conflict with work assignments.

For the security of the facility, a wants and warrants check shall be conducted on adult visitors by EMRF staff. All visitors will be appropriately attired. Deputies shall use discretion when determining if questionable attire will be grounds for denying a visit. If necessary, the Central Sergeant will be contacted.

Visitors will report to the information window at least 60 minutes prior to the visit. If the visitor arrives after the 60 minute window, IPD staff will contact the affected housing unit to evaluate if the visit can be accommodated. Walk-up visitors attempting to schedule a same-day visit will only be permitted with the approval of the Watch Commander or designee.

Social visitors are required to pass through the metal detector prior to entering the visit yard. Visitors will only be allowed to bring car keys and their photo identification with them.

All incarcerated persons will be fully dressed in either their jail issued tan or blue clothing, including undergarments.

EMRF incarcerated persons can receive social visits utilizing Securus Video Visitation Monitors from the public via remote access through the Securus application.

Remote video visitations can only be scheduled through the Securus Video Visitation application. The user must set up an account and get prior approval to use video visitation before scheduling

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Only the watch commander may cancel visits during periods of poor weather.

CONTACT VISITS

A social worker/representative from Child Protective Services (CPS) can schedule court ordered contact visits for minors by contacting the facility administrative Lieutenant or designee for approval. The visit will be scheduled outside of the normal social visit hours and will take place in the social visit area. The facility administrative Lieutenant or designee will notify the detentions processing supervisor and the affected team.

INCENTIVE BASED HOUSING

In addition to the two visits set forth by Title 15, Incentive Based Housing of Incarcerated persons will be granted an additional 1-hour visit in their allotted time slot. This will increase their visit opportunities to three 1-hour visits per week.
