Subject: VERIFICATION OF LEGAL STATUS CONFORMANCE TO IMMIGRATION LAWS

Related Sections: California Penal Code 834(b); Assembly Bill 2792

PROCEDURE

All releases of I/Ps to Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents assuming custody of I/Ps on Federal warrants or on approved Notification Requests, in accordance with California Senate Bill 54, will be processed for release at final release by IPD staff and then will be **Govt. Code 6255(a)**

I. ICE RELEASE

- A. Prior to the arrival of ICE, the I/Ps will be taken to final release. Release procedures will remain the same by IPD, however the I/Ps will be held in a final release holding cell separate from other I/P releases. They will remain at final release until the ICE officers arrive to take physical custody.
- B. The I/P will not be in possession of their personal property, other than their street clothing while in the holding cell. The personal property items will be turned over to the I/P after physical custody by ICE has occurred.
- C. When ICE officers arrive, **Govt. Code 6255(a)** **Control Deputy** will call IPD staff and inform them of the immigration officer's arrival and then call for an available deputy to escort the officers to the final release window.
- D. Upon completion of the release process by IPD, the I/P's and the officers will be escorted **Govt. Code 6255(a)** by a deputy, so they can depart the facility.
