## PROCEDURE

- I. Incarcerated Worker Privileges (I/W)
  - A. Unless subjected to discipline, the following privileges are afforded to all I/W's (per JIMS) at the East Mesa Reentry Facility:
    - 1. Pay: \$0.50 per day
    - 2. Food: One extra hot tray daily during the dinner meal
    - 3. Visiting: One-hour social visits
    - 4. Clothing: Change of clothing at the end of daily work
  - B. Mainline incarcerated persons (IP's) in House 3 and House 4 who serve as the module workers (clean- up and serving meals) shall receive one extra hot tray daily during the dinner meal. There will be no more than two IP's per module assigned to this duty.
- **II. Special Projects**

I/W's who are instructed to complete special projects above and beyond their normally assigned duties may be rewarded with special meals. At the recommendation of the sworn staff member supervising the work crew, and with approval of the Watch Commander or Administrative Lieutenant, the IP's may be provided with meals normally used to serve inmates assigned to the Inside Kitchen.

III. D1 Dorm Privileges

In addition to the above privileges, I/W assigned to D1 Dorm shall also have the following extra items and privileges.

IV. Incentive Based Housing (IBH) Privileges

In addition to the above privileges, inmate workers assigned to the IBH dorms shall also have access to:

- 1. Vending machines with frozen food items
- 2. Microwave
- 3.Game Tables
- 4. Video gaming console with games
- 5. Extra recreation yard time
