SUBJECT:	EMERGENCY ALARM SYSTEMS

PROCEDURE

The George F. Bailey Detention Facility utilizes three independent emergency alarm systems:

I. STAFF ALARM SYSTEM

II. INMATE EMERGENCY ALARM SYSTEM

Intercoms are accessible to inmates in all areas throughout the facility. In the event of an emergency, inmates can push an intercom button which sounds in the corresponding control stations: Central Control, Processing Control, House Control, the Release area, the Medical/SIM Nurses Station, and Medical/SIM Control Station. Alarms activated in the Professional Visit area will be acknowledged by Central Control. Central Control will communicate with the appropriate housing unit and clear the alarm. Deputies will be dispatched to verify the alarm and provide assistance if needed.
