SUBJECT: INMATE IDENTIFICATION WRISTBANDS AND CLOTHING

PROCEDURE

- I. The color thumbnail photograph on the inmate wristband will be compared with the inmate, to make a positive visual identification. This shall be done any time current practice requires a check of the wristband but is not limited to [REDACTED]

In cases where positive identification cannot be determined from the photograph alone (e.g., radical appearance change while in custody), the inmate shall be identified utilizing alternate methods such as [REDACTED]. Once positively identified, an updated photograph shall be taken and utilized on the replacement wristband.

- II. Houses One and Two will have one assigned worker in each quad. [REDACTED]
