SUBJECT:	ENHANCED OBSERVATION HOUSING (EOH)- DEFINITION AND USE

PROCEDURE

I. LOCATIONS OF EOH CELLS

A. The following are designated EOH cells:

1. [REDACTED] is for any mainline (blue wristband) inmates, levels 1-5. There is a maximum of 12 beds available. If this area is full, place the inmate in an alternate location (see other locations listed).
2. [REDACTED] is primarily used for any administrative segregated protective custody inmates (orange-band with yellow stripes) levels 1-6. There is a maximum of 1 bed available. Although built for EOH, when available, this cell can be used by medical staff for short term medical needs.
3. [REDACTED] will be a shared medical cell with ADSEG/ PC EOH priority. If an inmate is already in [REDACTED] as a medical isolated patient at the time of an EOH assessment, sworn staff will contact the gatekeeper and request the inmate be moved, in order to put the ADSEG EOH inmate in [REDACTED]

II. PROPERTY

EOH inmates will have their property placed into a brown paper bag. The inmate's name and booking number will be clearly inscribed on the bag and stored in the Medical Control area.

III. HYGIENE

When providing hygiene items, deputies must ensure designated EOH hygiene items are used for safety. Deputies should place shampoo/body wash in a soft disposable container. Hygiene items (e.g. disposable toothbrush, towel, etc.) should be collected after each use by deputies.
