SUBJECT:	INMATE FOOTWEAR

PROCEDURE

I. ORTHOPEDIC FOOTWEAR

- A. All inmates at the George Bailey Detention Facility (GBDF) will wear jail issued sandals, unless authorized by detentions medical staff per Detentions Services Bureau Policy and Procedures Section Q.61.
- B. Inmates wearing orthopedic footwear approved by medical staff will be permitted to wear them in all parts of the facility, except Safety Cells/EOH.

II. INMATE WORKER BOOTS

- A. Inmate workers assigned to the kitchen area.
 - 1. When an inmate is hired to work in the kitchen, the Inmate Worker Deputy will issue them a pair of black rubber boots during their first shift.
 - 2. These boots remain the property of GBDF and will be stored outside the kitchen on the wooden shelves when not in use.
 - 3. New, unused boots will be stored in the House 1 shed.
- B. Inmate Workers assigned to House 5
 - 1. Rubber boots are available for use when cleaning House 5. These boots should not be used elsewhere in the facility.
 - 2. Boots are stored in the House 5 shed when not in use.
