PROCEDURE

I. GO BAGS

- A. Las Colinas Detention and Reentry Facility's (LCDRF) transportation "Go Bags" will be kept in the JPMU office in intake. Transportation deputies shall check out a "Go Bag" and conduct a brief inventory of the bag, with time permitting, prior to leaving the facility with an incarcerated person. ". If the bags need supplies, they can contact the Administrative Deputy for the items.
- B. The Administrative Deputy will inventory the facility "Go Bags" on a monthly basis and document the inventory in the JIMS area activity log under "Inspection

II. RESPONSIBILITIES/EXPECTATIONS

- A. Deputies will ensure that security of the incarcerated person, hospital staff and public is paramount.
- B. Deputies are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and to place themselves in the position of advantage as it relates to security.
 - 1. Deputies will utilize an appropriate seating area and not the available hospital bed while guarding an incarcerated person.
 - 2. No outside visitors for the deputy will be allowed while guarding an incarcerated person.
