WRISTBANDS AND CLOTHING

PROCEDURE

I. PREGNANT INCARCERATED PERSON

For specific information about pregnant incarcerated person's wristband and clothing colors, see LCDRF green sheet M.38.L.

II. MEDICAL HOUSING

- A. Incarcerated people who meet the criteria to be housed in the medical observation unit (MOB) at LCDRF will be issued an applicable colored wristband with red vertical stripes on the white insert. If no beds are available in the MOB, incarcerated person(s) will be placed in a designated housing unit determined by JPMU and medical staff. Incarcerated people housed as medical overflow will retain their red striped insert until cleared by medical staff.
- B. Any incarcerated person(s) cleared from MOB or MOB overflow will have their red striped insert removed unless they are pregnant or participating in the breastfeeding program. The affected housing unit deputy will ensure that the wristband is changed prior to moving to their assigned housing unit.
