PROCEDURE

I. BIOHAZARD CART

- A. The Las Colinas Detention and Reentry Facility biohazard response cart is located in the storage room of the PSU corridor hallway. The cart contains personal protective equipment (PPE) needed for the handling, cleaning, and/or disposal of biohazardous materials.
- B. Whenever contamination with blood, bodily fluids, or other potentially infectious materials (OPIM) is confirmed or suspected, sworn staff should utilize the facility biohazard cart materials to properly and safely handle and dispose of biohazardous materials. Appropriate PPE shall be worn by any staff or incarcerated persons handling contaminated items.
- C. The biohazard cart will remain stocked with the following items:

Germicidal bleach spray Disposable mop heads

BETCO ph7Q Dual (soap) Mop handle and red biohazard mop bucket

Nitrile gloves Caution sign

Yellow gowns Dustpan and counter brush

Disposable shoe covers Green scrubbing pads

Plastic face shields Angle broom

Plastic safety goggles Red biohazard trash bag
N95 respirator masks Large plastic trash bags

Paper towel Blood spill kits

Disposable cloth rags Red biohazard trash can

- D. Whenever sworn staff utilizes or supervises the use of the biohazard cart, they shall note the supplies used on the accompanying inventory forms located on the biohazard cart and notify the incarcerated worker deputies of their use. Facility incarcerated worker deputies are responsible for maintaining the biohazard cart inventory.
- E. All waste contaminated with biohazardous materials shall be packaged and disposed of in accordance with facility green sheet M.41.L INFECTION CONTROL: MEDICAL WASTE.
