SUBJECT: EMERGENCY BACK-UP SYSTEMS - WATER

PROCEDURE

The emergency water supply is to be used in cases of extreme emergency in which the water supply to the facility has been eliminated due to natural disaster or other uncontrollable situations.

The San Diego Central Jail's emergency water supply consists of Safety/Security Interests - 7922.000

Tampering

with the emergency water supply is strictly prohibited.

In an instance in which the emergency water supply is needed, the order to begin use will be given by the watch commander. If the order is given, each incarcerated person and staff member will be given 3 bottles per day at mealtimes. The consumption of the water will be closely monitored by jail supervisors.

In case of extreme emergency, kitchen staff will need twenty (20) five gallon bottles of water to prepare meals. The watch commander will assign a deputy to collect twenty (20) five gallon bottles from various areas of the facility and deliver them to the kitchen.
