SUBJECT:	INCARCERATED PERSONS - ORANGE AND GREEN BAND MOVEMENT

PROCEDURE

When escorting orange and green band incarcerated persons, differences in securing the incarcerated persons will exist depending on whether the movement occurs within the housing area or if the incarcerated persons are leaving the housing area. For the purposes of this green sheet, the housing area is defined as follows:

- On floors 4 through 8, the housing area includes all areas on the floor outside of the elevator wells (e.g. staging areas, mezzanine level, modules, visit rooms, recreation yard).
- In the Medical Observation housing (MOB), the housing area is that area within the individual MOB cells. Govt. Code 6255(a)

- In the Psychiatric Stabilization Unit (PSU), the housing area is that area within the PSU double doors (adjacent to the 3rd floor safety cells) and the PSU double doors (adjacent to MOB).

I. GREEN BAND INCARCERATED PERSONS ASSIGNED TO MAINLINE HOUSING MODULES

- A. Movement within the housing areas of green band incarcerated persons assigned to a mainline housing module Govt. Code 6255(a)
[REDACTED] The housing control deputy will ensure staff and incarcerated person sliding doors to the elevators are secured prior to the movement of these green band incarcerated persons within the housing area.
- B. Green band incarcerated persons assigned to a mainline housing module moving off the housing area will Govt. Code 6255(a)

- C. Deputies will apply or remove the handcuffs or waist chains in the staging area and not in the module or cell when other incarcerated persons are present.

II. ORANGE AND GREEN BAND INCARCERATED PERSONS ASSIGNED TO HIGH RISK SECURITY LEVEL (HRSL) HOUSING MODULES (E.G. ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION)

- A. Orange and green band incarcerated persons assigned to HRSL housing moving within the housing areas will Govt. Code 6255(a) [REDACTED]
