SUBJECT:	WEEKEND SENTENCES

PROCEDURES:

A person's judicial sentence may require them to spend weekends in custody. These people, also known as "weekenders", will report to the Front Street Pedestrian Gate (immediately north of the vehicle gate). The weekender will use the intercom to notify the intake control deputy of his presence. An intake deputy will meet the individual at the pedestrian gate within 30 minutes and verify the identity of the weekender. A pat down search will be conducted, and the deputy will handcuff and escort them into the facility.

Weekenders will complete the intake/booking process. A returning weekender without changes to their physical appearance will not require a new photograph. Returning weekenders can also bypass fingerprinting, booking, x-ray, and 2nd stage medical screening if there have been no changes to the weekenders' personal information or medical status. After confirming appropriate housing with JPMU, the weekender can be sent directly to their assigned housing.
