Purpose

To establish guidelines for the Sheriff's Transportation Unit (STU) while transporting individuals wearing the Bandit Electronic Restraint Device.

Policy

The STU will use the Bandit Electronic Restraint Device on individuals that have been identified with "Bandit Transport" (BT) in JIMS under Hazards and Instructions and High-Risk Indicators. Only deputies that have been trained in the use of the Bandit will control the remote to the Bandit.

Procedure:

I. Transport

- A. At a minimum, two deputies will be used to transport an individual wearing the Bandit. Depending on the history and actions of the individual, additional deputies and the use of a chase car should be considered. Individuals transported utilizing the Bandit will be transported without any other incarcerated individuals. All individuals transported utilizing the Bandit will be cross-chained during transport.
- B. If the individual has the High-Risk Indicator "Bandit Transport" (BT), it will be removed when the individual arrives at the receiving courthouse or facility. If the individual has both High Risk Indicators "Bandit Transport" (BT) and "Bandit Court" (BC), the receiving courthouse will have a deputy qualified on the use of the Bandit to take control of the individual and Bandit remote.

II. Reporting

- A. A Bandit Checklist will be completed for all individuals transported with the Bandit.
- B. All activations of the Bandit will be reported as required by Department P&P 6.48 and Addendum F.
