SUBJECT:	WORKER PRIVILEGES

PROCEDURE:

- I. When an incarcerated individual is assigned as a facility incarcerated worker, the worker shall receive certain benefits and privileges, including but not limited to:
 - A. Daily clothing exchange.
 - B. Extra food during the evening meals only.
 - C. Additional T.V. privileges, Friday and Saturday 2300 hours.
 - D. Extra social visit as scheduling permits.
 - E. Extra gym equipment in the module.
 - F. Two Sheets and two blankets.
 - G. Use of ping-pong table, pool table, and X-Box as permitted by the station deputy.

- II. When a mainline incarcerated individual is assigned as a module worker, he will receive the following privileges, including, but not limited to:
 - A. Extra T.V. (Friday and Saturday until 2300 hours) at the discretion of the module deputy.
 - B. May keep cell doors closed during dayroom hours.
 - C. Extra food during the evening meals only.
