V. FEMALE INMATE PROCEDURES

- A. Female inmates shall not be housed or temporarily housed with male inmates at any time per Penal Code 4002(A), except inmates classified by JPMU as Transgender Female (TGF) and Transgender Non-binary (TGX).
- B. Female inmates shall not be transported with male inmates absent exigent circumstances.
- C. If the same entrance/exit is utilized by both male and female inmates, movement shall be scheduled in such a manner that there is no opportunity for contact between those two groups of inmates. Common areas will be visually verified to be clear of opposite sex inmates prior to use/placement, e.g., Medical Holding, multi-purpose rooms, etc.
