PURPOSE

To prohibit the use of incarcerated persons or medical experimentation.

POLICY

Incarcerated persons in the custody of the Sheriff shall not be used as a subject for medical, pharmaceutical, or cosmetic experiments.

PROCEDURE

- I. No experiment for medical, pharmaceutical, or cosmetic purposes shall be initiated by the Sheriff's Medical Services Division.
- II. Incarcerated persons who are actively participating in a drug study at the time of incarceration may be allowed to continue after case review and approval by the Sheriff's chief medical officer (CMO), pharmacist and administrative case manager and only if the study or treatment is as defined in Section 312 of Title 21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, pursuant to California Penal Code sections 3502 and 3502.5.
