

Conditional Custody Program - CCP

The Conditional Custody Program (CCP) is a San Diego Sheriff's Department screening process that permits persons arrested for California Vehicle Code (VC) Section 23152 (a)-(g) Driving Under the Influence alcohol/drugs (DUI) to be released on their own recognizance, with a promise to appear, when they have met certain criteria.

When authorized by the Sheriff, an incarcerated individual arrested with driving under the influence charges will remain in custody until they are capable of assuming responsibility for themselves and, if qualified, will be released on a signed promise to appear using the Notice to Appear – Per 853.6 PC form (J-14).

Incarcerated individuals brought into custody with the following field arrest charges as indicated on the San Diego County Sheriff's Department Booking Acceptance Criteria (BAC) qualify to be processed under CCP:

• 23152 (a) – (g) VC: Driving under the influence alcohol/drugs


PREBOOK

After intake is completed and the incarcerated individual is declared 'Fit for Jail' by medical staff, the pre-booking process will begin. Prior to entering the arrest in the Jail Information Management System (JIMS), the Detention Processing Technician (DPT) must verify the Booking/Intake Personal Property Inventory (J-15 Form) is complete and obtain any clarification while the Arresting /Transporting officer is still present.

If the arrest qualifies for the CCP program, the Probable Cause Declaration (PCD) will not be sent to the judge via the scanning application and will remain part of the incarcerated individual's custody record.

Once the pre-book process is complete, the DPT will bring up the JIMS Booking queue to find the incarcerated individual, click on the Intake Status button and select "CCP PEND."





CCP DENIAL

The following factors will <u>disqualify</u> an – incarcerated individual from the CCP program:

- DUI arrests within the past two years
- Active felony warrants that meets the current booking acceptance criteria
- Additional misdemeanor/felony charges (exception: 12500 VC)
- No local address. Residents of Mexico are not eligible. (Residents of San Diego, Orange, Riverside, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Imperial Counties and Military Personnel stationed within San Diego County are eligible).

When it has been determined that a DUI arrest does not meet the CCP criteria the following will be completed:


1. Notify the Deputy that the individual is a "Keeper", and the wristband must be changed

from purple to blue.

2. Update the Intake Status to **CCP DENI** on the JIMS Booking queue.



3. Enter "CCP DENIED" on the JIMS Maintenance "Notes" section.




4. Change the bail flag to Y – Yes and enter the bail amount.

BOOKING

The DPT assigned to Booking will conduct an inquiry in the San Diego Law and Justice Network (SDLAW) for any prior DUI arrests. Once it has been determined, the incarcerated individual qualifies for CCP, the following will be completed:

1. Update the Intake Status to reflect **CCP APPR** on the booking queue.




2. Enter "CCP APPROVED" on the Maintenance Notes section.




SDLAW RI01 CRIMINAL HISTORY SEARCH

An RIO1 search must be conducted in SDLAW to determine eligibility.

- 4. Scan the DOB's to find the incarcerated individual.
- 5. Select the RIO2 entry for the correct incarcerated individual





- 7. Each DA10 entry reflecting a DUI charge must be selected and reviewed.




8. If the offense date is within the 2-year time frame, the incarcerated individual will be disqualified from a CCP release.



9. The **SR31** will also need to be reviewed for any arrests within the last 2 years that may also disqualify the incarcerated individual from the CCP program. This will be found when selecting the identified incarcerated individual from the RIO1 search.



10. An inquiry reason must be entered to proceed with the SR31 history, CCP will be utilized for this process, then select "Get Data"



11. This will show you any recent booking numbers, charges, and dates for the selected incarcerated individual.

WANTS AND WARRANTS

Wants and warrants MUST be cleared for an incarcerated individual's release to be authorized under the CCP program. Once Sheriff's Records has verified the incarcerated individual's identity and linked their record, and the SCN and JIMS Verified "Y" are present, a wants and warrants query will be conducted. If Sheriff's Records has not verified prints in a timely manner forward a Request to Verify Receipt of Livescan (J-352 form) to determine if the incarcerated individual needs to be live-scanned again.

If an active warrant is discovered and does not meet the current BAC, it will be cleared and given the Notice to Appear per 853.6 PC (J-14 form). The date and time the incarcerated individual is scheduled to appear is derived from the Daily Release Schedule, the court location will be determined by the court jurisdiction on the warrant.


If the incarcerated individual is cleared of wants and warrants in the JIMS Booking queue, you may bypass the JIMS Medical Recom and JIMS Housing Assignment screens, as Medical and Classification screenings are not required.




NOTICE TO APPEAR PER 853.6 PC (O.R.): J-14 FORM

Incarcerated individuals qualified for the CCP will remain in custody until they are capable of assuming responsibility for themselves. Once the incarcerated individual has been cleared for release, the DPT will initiate the release process and place the incarcerated individual on the release queue.

During the prerelease process the disposition of **CCP** will be applied and the future court, date and time will be entered. **CCP – CONDITIONAL CUSTODY PROGRAM** will be used as the prerelease and final release disposition to close out the arrest.



Under the Release Reports screen the DPT will print 3 copies of the NOTICE TO APPEAR REPORT.



Incarcerated individuals processed under CCP must agree to appear in court on the pending charges at a later date and time by signing the Notice to Appear per 853.6 PC (J-14 form). The date and time the incarcerated individual is scheduled to appear is derived from the Daily Release Schedule and the court location is determined per the J-15. It is imperative to accurately fill out the J-14 form in its entirety and obtain the incarcerated individual signature.

Without the signature, the Notice to Appear form is not valid and enables the judge to issue a warrant if they fail to appear for their court appearance.

After the incarcerated individual signs the Notice to Appear (J-14 form), the original will immediately be forwarded via interoffice mail addressed to the Custody Court Supervisor in the court of jurisdiction, one copy will be provided to the incarcerated individual and one copy will remain with the incarcerated individuals custody record.

Once the incarcerated individual has been processed, proper notes will be entered into the release queue identifying the CCP release information.



INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL REFUSAL

If an incarcerated individual refuses to sign the Notice to Appear Per 853.6 form (J-14), CCP REFUSED will be notated in the maintenance notes, "Refused" will be written on the signature line and the J-14 will be filed in the incarcerated individual's custody record. The incarcerated individual will remain in custody with bail, be scheduled for court per PC 825 guidelines and the PCD will be submitted electronically to the on- duty judge via the Probable Cause Declaration Scanning Application.
