

City Incarcerated Person

Per the Memorandum of Understanding signed on May 18, 1998 and amended in 2009 between the City and County of San Diego and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, the City agreed to pay an additional amount of money for the operating expenses incurred by housing City misdemeanants brought in by the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) and/or San Diego Harbor Patrol (SDHP).

Once a city incarcerated person has been identified, the CITY disposition will be selected from the drop- down list. After the incarcerated person has been arraigned in court and the ART/ARR Reason on Calendar(ROC) changes, the individual will no longer be considered a CITY incarcerated person. The CITY disposition MUST be removed to maintain accurate real-time reporting for the number of city incarcerated persons in Sheriff's custody.

ELIGIBLE FIELD ARRESTS

When SDPD/SDHP arrests an individual for misdemeanor charges that do not meet the San Diego County Sheriff's Booking Acceptance Criteria, the incarcerated person will be booked as a CITY incarcerated person. If the incarcerated person has any holds, the misdemeanor charges will be booked as a city incarcerated person and an additional arrest will be completed as a hold type of arrest.

ELIGIBLE WARRANTS

Misdemeanor warrants from the City of San Diego originating from a SDPD/SDHP arrest will be accepted from any San Diego County law enforcement agency and will be identified as a CITY incarcerated person arrest. The originating agency is not reflected on the warrant abstract. To verify the originating agency, access warrants in SDLAW. If unable to access SDLAW or determine the originating agency, contact a Detention Processing Supervisor PRIOR to the acceptance/denial of these warrants.

If the incarcerated person is arrested for felony charges and a misdemeanor warrant(s), do not enter the CITY disposition for the felony charges, ONLY for the misdemeanor warrant(s).

EXCEPTIONS

Arrests from SDPD or SDHP which are acceptable as Book and Release charges will be accepted and processed as a B&R (See Book and Release Section B. These are NOT city incarcerated persons.

However, if SDPD or SDHP charges an individual with acceptable Book and Release charges and additional misdemeanor charges NOT listed on the Booking Acceptance Criteria, the individual will be kept as CITY INCARCERATED PERSON. These individuals will NOT be processed for release per 853.6 PC or 849(b)2 PC.
