


Senate Bill 54 - California Values Act

<u>California Senate Bill 54</u>, also known as the California Values Act, was recently enacted and amended the California Government Code Sections 7282 through 7282.5, and added sections 7284 through 7284.12. These laws regulate how the Sheriff's Department can share data with federal agencies responsible for immigration enforcement.

I-247A IMMIGRATION DETAINER - NOTICE OF ACTION FORM

When an <u>Immigration Detainer – Notice of Action (I-247A Form)</u> is received, a copy will remain with the custody record and the original will be given to the Jail Population Management Unit (JPMU) for review. All facilities will have a designated "ICE" area for all pending ICE documents. JPMU's decision will require further action from custody processing staff. The following flow chart summarizes the responsibilities when processing an Immigration detainer:







JAIL POPULATION MANAGEMENT UNIT (JPMU)

Upon receipt of the I-247A form, JPMU will review the incarcerated individual's criminal history to ensure compliance with the TRUTH Act and Senate Bill 54. Once a decision has been reached, JPMU will create a JIMSentry in the incarcerated individual's criminal history and will forward the copy of the I-247A form along with a Notice to incarcerated individual of ICE Request and Intent to Notify (J-340 Form) to custody processing staff.

Jail Information Management System (JIMS) Entry

If an I-247A Form is approved, an event type of **247A** will be entered. If an I-247A Form is rejected, an event type of **247R** will be entered.



J-340 NOTICE TO INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL OF ICE REQUEST AND INTENT TO NOTIFY FORM

Regardless of the outcome of the I-247A Form, JPMU must also generate a **Notice to Incarcerated individual ofICE Request and Intent to Notify (J-340 Form)** and forward to custody processing staff for further action.

J-344 QA Form

Once custody processing staff receives the J-340 Form, A quality assurance check will be conducted to ensure the receipt of the I-247A Form and a JIMS entry specifying approved or



rejected. In the event the J-340 Form or the JIMS entry has not been completed, all documentation must be returned to JPMU and no further action will be taken until these necessary steps are completed.



J-340 Form Approved

When a J-340 Form is received with an approved I-247A, custody processing staff must book an additional arrest of <u>Notification – Immigration Customs Enforcement (NICE)</u>.



A copy of the I-247A and the J-340 Form must be sent to the incarcerated individual and an entry must be made in the incarcerated individual's history in JIMS with the Event Type of **340S** when the J-340 Form hasbeen sent to the incarcerated individual and **340R** when the J-340 Form has been received from the incarcerated individual.





Further, the J-344 QA Form must be updated to reflect the current status

Lastly, all documents will be forwarded to a second Detentions Processing Technician (DPT) who will conduct a quality assurance check to confirm all necessary entries were completed and the J-344 QA Form has been updated.

J-340 Form Rejected

When a J-340 Form is received with a rejected I-247A, custody processing staff must forward the copy of the I-247A and the J-340 Form to the incarcerated individual. Once the forms are sent, an entry must be made in the incarcerated individual's history in JIMS with the Event Type of **340S**.





When the J-340 Form is received with the incarcerated individual's signature, a new entry will incarcerated individual's history with the Event Type of **340R**.



The J-344 QA Form will be updated to reflect the current status


Resubmission

The resubmission of the I-247A by the Immigration Customs Enforcement cannot occur until after the preliminary hearing of the incarcerated individual. A resubmission will require a new I-247A and the J- ICE QA form. Resubmissions will result in multiple entries in an incarcerated individual's no history as well as seemingly duplicate copies of related forms. It is important to note the dates and times on all forms and entries to ensure accuracy.



J-335 NOTICE OF INTENT TO COMPLY WITH ICE REQUEST FORM

When an I-247A has been approved and an incarcerated individual's release date is known, the DPT will complete a <u>Notice of Intent to Comply With Immigration and Customs Enforcement Request (J-335 form)</u>. The J- 335 Form will be sent to the incarcerated individual and related entries must be made in JIMS along with updating the J-344 QA Form. The following flow chart summarizes the responsibilities when processing an incarcerated individual that has been committed or is pending release.



*Note: Prior to initiating the release process the <u>REVERIFICATION PROCESS</u> must be completed



When sending the J-335 Form to the incarcerated individual, an event type of **335S** must be entered in history in JIMS.



When the J-335 Form is received with the incarcerated individual's signature, an event type of **335R** will be entered inthe incarcerated individual's history in JIMS.



Lastly, all documents will be forwarded to a second Detentions Processing Technician (DPT) that will conduct a quality assurance check to confirm all necessary entries were completed and the J-344 QA Form has been updated.



J-330 FORM CONSENT FORM TO INTERVIEW WITH ICE

The Transparent Review of Unjust Transfers and Holds (TRUTH) Act requires the department to obtain written consent from an individual in custody prior to an interview with Immigrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE). This interview is voluntary, and the incarcerated individual can elect to have their lawyer present.


J-330 Form Consent Form to Interview with Ice Flow Chart



Upon request for an interview, the ICE agent must fill out the J-330 form and J-47 form at the Custody Information Window. The DIA assisting the Agent will forward the documentation to the on-duty supervisor. See Request for Visit by ICE Agent in section 6 of the DIA manual. The DPS will forward the J-330 via sworn staff to the incarcerated individual for signature.

The <u>J-330 Consent Form for Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Interview</u> includes a space for the incarcerated individual to provide their lawyer's information if they choose to have their lawyer present.


If the incarcerated individual agrees to have their attorney present:





The receiving detention processing supervisor will:


- Complete the "Received by" section
- Create an entry in the incarcerated individual's history with event type 330L J-330 FORM RECD-WITHLAWYER



- Ensure both the lawyers name and email address are provided
- Access the State Bar of California website to obtain the lawyer's email address, if missing.

The DPS will:

- Generate an email to the lawyer using the template below
- Subject: incarcerated individual's Last name, first name and Booking number




- Include the custody information office number for their respective facility
- CC all the shift supervisors and SOS
- Only email notifications will be provided, no phone calls
- Print out verification of email sent (located in the Sent Items folder) and file along with the J-330 in the incarcerated individual's custody record

If the incarcerated individual agrees to be interviewed without a lawyer, the receiving DPS will create an entry in the incarcerated individual's history with event type 330W J-330 FORM RECD-W/O LAWYER.



If the incarcerated individual does not agree to be interviewed, the receiving DPS will create an entry in the incarcerated individual's history with event type 330N J-330 FORM RECD-DID NOT AGREE.







Consent for Interview J-47 Statistics

Each facility will have an assigned DPS who will monitor and maintain the statistics for all J-47 Forms – Request to Interview Incarcerated individual.

The following statistics shall be updated daily and made available upon request:

- Total number of interviews requested by ICE
- Total number of interviews granted and scheduled (330W)
- Total number of interviews denied (330N)
- Total number of interviews with attorney (330L)

INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL HOUSED AT ANOTHER FACILITY

If the incarcerated individual is not housed at the updating facility the following procedure will occur after the qualityassurance process has been completed.

- Generate and fax all documents to the housing facility along with a copy of the J-344 QA form.
- The DPT at the housing facility will create the entries pertaining to documents sent for signature in the incarcerated individual's history and update the J-344 QA form.
- Once a signature is obtained the receiving DPT at the housing facility will create an entry in the incarcerated individual's history notating the forms were received.
- A copy of the documents will be provided to the incarcerated individual.



- The J-344 QA form will be updated each time an entry is made in the incarcerated individual's history.
- If the custody record is not maintained at the housing facility, the DPT will forward all
 documents via interoffice mail, and faxed to the facility where the custody record is
 maintained for filing.

REVERIFICATION

Reverification must be completed for incarcerated individuals that have an approved J-340 prior to processing them for release.


At the time of release all facilities must generate a fax cover sheet and send the J-344 to the Jail Population Management Unit (JPMU) at San Diego Central Jail.

Only fax the J-344 accompanied by a fax cover sheet and include the following information:

- TO: SDCJ JPMU
- ATTN: SB-54
- RE: Reverification of approved J-340
- incarcerated individual name and booking number
- Facility phone and fax number
- Description "When completed please return to (facility name), fax to (facility fax)"
- Sender's name, ARJIS, date, and time


If the incarcerated individual's status has changed from "approved" to "denied", JPMU willforward IPD a new J-340 in addition to the J-344.



Do not place the incarcerated individual on the release queue until JPMU has responded.

If JPMU has not responded to the requesting facility within a thirty-minute time frame, contact the on duty DPS at SDCJ and request a follow up.





Once the reverified J-344 form has been received, it will be added to the custody record and the Final Release DPT may move forward with the release process. Upon release from custody, these records will need to be forwarded to the on-duty DPS for review.



RELEASE

Upon the incarcerated individual's final release from custody, during the pre-release process, the disposition NINA – Notification Immigration No Action will be utilized when closing the NICE arrest.








When closing out the booking at final release, the applicable release type will be used in the JIMS Final Release Navigator. If ICE takes custody of the incarcerated individual upon release, select ICE as the Agency Released To.



The ICE agent will need to sign the Release Approval Report when the releasing DPT witnesses an incarcerated individual being picked up by ICE.



CUSTODIAL RECORD

After an incarcerated individual has been released from sheriff's custody, we must ensure the custodial record is managed properly. If while in custody an incarcerated individual has ever had a Notification ICE I-247 form (either approved or denied) their custodial record will be forwarded to the on-duty DPS after being released.

INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS NOT CURRENTLY BOOKED ON ICE NOTIFICATION

In the event an ICE agent asks questions about an incarcerated individual in Sheriff's custody that is not booked on anICE notification, refer them to the San Diego County Who's In Jail website. Information regarding an incarcerated individual's pending release is now available for the public to view on this website.





BOOKED IMMIGRATION WARRANTS

Any Arrest Warrant issued by the United States District Court and signed by a United States Magistrate Judge is a Federal warrant and is to be accepted and processed without delay.






If the incarcerated individual is in custody on pending matters, the warrant will be processed as HICE-HOLD IMMIGRATION. Additionally, an 850(c) PC Notification Form (J-124) will be completed if the warrant is placed against them after the initial booking. These warrants are not subject to the provisions outlined in the California Values Act Senate Bill 54 and should not be forwarded to JPMU forreview.

Upon adjudication of local case(s) or when the incarcerated individual has completed their sentence, the HICE arrestwill be closed out with the disposition of RBHD-REBOOK HOLD. An additional arrest will be completed with an arrest type of BICE-Booked ICE and the disposition of DPS given. The custody record will be placed in the court contact tray for pickup arrangements.

A designated DPT on the A shift (Monday-Friday) will run the ICE HOLDS - On Demand JIMS Web Report for their respective facility to identify incarcerated individual ready for pickup. This will ensure the arrest was correctly processed and the USM will be contacted to arrange a pickup time for these incarcerated individuals.
