CA Army National Guard is a state agency; therefore, cannot have their soldiers serve confinement at a federal facility, (different jurisdiction) instead they serve confinement at a county facility.

In the past, the California Army National Guard has coordinated with other California county jails where soldiers have served their confinement.

At the CA Guardsman request, they will contact the facility in which they will transport their soldier to. The CA Guardsman wants to ensure we receive the soldiers sentenced to confinement.

Accelerated release credits DO NOT pertain to these sentence calculations.

Whatever statutory credits we would normally give would not be applicable to a sentence that was not imposed by the Superior Court. That leaves only the *Hudler* credits. These credits are not applied either because unlike the Superior Court, which issued the *Hudler* orders and is presumed to know that any sentence given is going to be subject to *Hudler* credits unless directed otherwise; the military judge who imposed this sentence clearly intended for seven days to be served. Therefore, the soldier serves the full sentence imposed.

NOTE: CA Guardsman will contact the on-duty supervisor should he have any questions or concerns. In the event a supervisor is not on duty, the Watch Commander is contacted.
