#### **LASSWELL**

- 1. How many arrests will inmate Lasswell have in JIMS? 2
- 2. What is the court destination on this warrant? El Cajon Superior Court
- 3. Should a court date and time be entered into JIMS for this warrant? If or if not, please explain why. No, because the superior court schedules their own court dates.
- 4. Can inmate Lasswell post bail? No, because the warrant is a "No Bail" warrant.
- 5. What is the arrest type for both arrests? FIELD ARRST AND SUPERIOR COURT WARRANT

  \*\*\*NOTE: Inmate Lasswell refused the O.R.\*\*\*

#### **TREGOE**

- 1. Who is the arresting agency? SOEN or Sheriff's Office Encinitas
- 2. What is the court destination? NCV or North County Vista
- 3. Based on the J-15, inmate Tregoe is a "Chronic". Do we process inmate Tregoe as a B&R or as a "keeper"? Process Tregoe as a Keeper; He is on the Chronic list in Vista
- 4. Is inmate Tregoe a city inmate? If or if not, please explain why. No, because SOEN is the arresting agency.
- 5. According to the Property Remarks indicated on the J-15, inmate Tregoe has no property. Therefore, is it required by the DPT to collect and enter a property bag into JIMS? If or if not, please explain why? Yes, because all inmates must come into custody with a sealed bag regardless if the bag is empty. Use "Empy Sealed Bag" in JIMS.
- What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

#### **PERKINS**

- 1. What charge is inmate Perkins being brought into custody on? 647(f) PC
- 2. Who is the arresting agency? SDPD
- 3. The word "Chronic" is listed on the J-15. At Pre-Book, do we schedule inmate Perkins for court? Yes
- 4. Under the "Arrest Remarks" section, does "SIP" need to be listed? SIP or Chronic can be listed anywhere on the J-15.
- How many sealed property bags does inmate Perkins have? 2 bags; (1) Medicine and (1) Sealed Property bag.
- 6. What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

#### **HERNANDEZ**

- 1. Who is the arresting agency? NCPD or National City Police Department
- 2. What is inmate Hernandez being charged with? 40302(A) VC or Failing to provide a driver's license.

- 3. Does this charge meet our Booking Acceptance Criteria? If or if not, please explain why Yes, because this charge is listed on the Booking Acceptance Criteria.
- 4. According to the California Law website, how many hours can inmate Hernandez remain detained per 40307 VC? 2 Hours
- 5. Who is the Billing Agency? NCPD
- 6. What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

# LOPEZ

- 1. Who is the arresting agency? SOIB or Sheriff's Office Imperial Beach
- 2. What charge is inmate Lopez being arrested for? 21200.5 VC or DUI on a bike
- 3. Does this charge meet our Booking Acceptance Criteria? Yes
- 4. Is inmate Lopez a B&R? Yes, he will receive an 853.6 Notice to Appear form with a future court date; Also known as a long form
- 5. Can inmate Lopez post bail? No, because Lopez is a B&R; he must wait a minimum of 8-12 hours before he can be released from custody.
- 6. What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

### **TOMA**

- 1. Prior to Pre-booking Toma in JIMS, what is the first step taken to determine if a warrant was issued on the bail bond surrender? Run a wants and warrants check through SDLaw to determine if the bail bond surrender has gone to warrant. The DPT should verify the documentation is acceptable per a DPS or a Lead DPT's approval at Information
- 2. What is the arrest type used when a bail bond surrender has NOT gone to warrant? Booked Other or OBKD.
- 3. According to the Detentions Processing Technician Manual, what are two reasons bail bond surrenders would not be accepted?
  - a. If the inmate was already in custody on the case
  - b. If the bail bond surrender is for an out of county case
- 4. What is the arrest type?

Active: PER THE WARRANT Non-Active: Booked Other

#### **PENA**

- 1. Inmate Pena was brought into custody on two drug charges. Will these charges be booked as felonies or misdemeanors? Felonies.
- 2. According to the Bail Setting Request form (J-107), if a request is not acted upon after eight hours, can inmate Pena post bail? Yes, inmate Pena can post the original bail amount of \$35,000
- 3. At what point does the eight hour window begin? The eight hour window begins from the time stamp of the documents upon arrival into the facility
- 4. Is the bail setting request for a bail increase, decrease, 1275 PC or a 1275.1 PC? 1275.1 PC

- 5. What is a 1275.1 PC? 1275.1 PC requires the inmate to prove that the funds posted fo his/her bail came from a legitimate source or means.
- 6. What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

# **BUTLER**

- 1. Inmate Butler came in with a Bail Setting Request form. Is the request for a bail decrease or increase per 1275 PC or a 1275.1 PC? A bail increase per 1275.
- 2. Is the bail request approved, pending or denied? The bail request is pending
- 3. If Inmate Butler's bail is pending, what's the bail amount entered into JIMS? If the bail request is pending, .88 would be entered along with the bail schedule amount of: \$30,000.88
- 4. What is the arrest type? FIELD ARRST

#### CARLLEL

- 1. Inmate Carllel is brought into custody on a felony warrant. What is the arrest type for this warrant? BMCW or Booked Municipal Court Warrant.
- 2. According to the warrant, what department should we schedule inmate Carllel for? FA or felony arraignment.
- 3. Will inmate Carllel appear in video court? Yes, because inmate Carllel is a male, the court destination in JIMS will be entered as: SDF\*.
- 4. What additional bail information is listed on the warrant? A 1275.1 PC hold. Don't forget to set the bail flag in JIMS to "P".
- 5. What is the arrest type? **BOOK MUNI COURT WARRANT**

#### **GRANNIS**

- 1. What is the agency case #? 08070813
- 2. A charge of 1203.2(a) PC is listed on the J-15 while a 243(c)(2) charge is listed on the Probation Re-Arrest form. Which charge will be entered into JIMS? Both charges will be entered into JIMS.
- 3. A court destination of North County is listed on the J-15. Do we schedule inmate Grannis for North County court? If or if not, please explain why. No, because a probation rearrest is booked as a superior court warrant and the superior court will schedule their own court dates.
- 4. What is the arrest type? **BOOKED SUPERIOR COURT WARRANT**

#### BETTS

- 1. What is the arrest type for inmate Betts? BPCS or Booked Post Community Supervision
- 2. What is the case #? CPR110748
- 3. According to the Post Release Community Supervision Offender Re-arrest form, inmate Betts is scheduled to serve 10 days of a flash incarceration. Is this a sentence? Yes
- 4. According to the PRCS form, what is inmate Betts' release date? 02/23/12

- 3. Can inmate Ware post bail? If or if not, please explain why. No, because any inmate who comes in on a probation re-arrest is ineligible for bail.
