EXAMPLE # 11 SUTIL (1-10)

- 1. Inmate Sutil is committed to Sheriff's custody for:
- 2. What is inmate Sutil Court Ordered Credits?
- 3. Which 4019 credits will inmate Sutil receive?

EXAMPLE # 13 RICO (Case # SCD211747)

- 1. What is inmate Rico commitment time?
- 2. What are the total ordered credits?
- 3. Will inmate Rico receive any 4019's credits?
- 4. Should the phrase: "Jail parole not granted", be entered in notes?
- 5. What other important notes should be entered into the notes section? **Note:** *No early release mean NO ARC'S*

EXAMPLE #14 JOHNSON

- 1. What is inmate Johnson commitment time?
- 2. What are the total ordered credits?
- 3. Will inmate Johnson receive any 4019's credits?

EXAMPLE# 15 ELLIS

- 1. What type of commit will inmate Ellis be serving?
- 2. What is the commit sentence time?
- 3. Will inmate Ellis receive any 4019 credits?
- 4. When Inmate Ellis is done serving his sentence, what time will he be released?

Note: When serving hour commits, inmate must be release at the same reporting time. Ex. Report time 11am, Release time 11am

EXAMPLE #17 PARKER (Male)

- 1. What is inmate Parker being charged with?
- 2. Do females only get charged with prostitution?
- 3. Will inmate Parker receive any ARC credits?

EXAMPLE #19 HOLT

- 1. What are the committed days for both cases?
- 2. Are both cases concurrent or consecutive?
- 3. Which case goes first?
- 4. Which case will receive the ARC credits?
- 5. Does inmate Holt have a future court date?

Note: The additional 365 days will remain" stayed" pending with successful completion of probation.

EXAMPLE # 20 SCIMECA

- 1. What are the committed days for both cases?
- 2. Are both cases concurrent or consecutive?
- 3. Which case goes first?
- 4. Which case will receive the ARC credits?

Note: The last case receives the ARC credits
