A report on Jack Sparrow has been submitted to the Court, pursuant to Penal Code section **1370**, 181 subdivision (b)(1), referring them back to county custody with no substantial likelihood of regaining competency. D subdivision (c)(1). referring them back to county custody as they are within 90 days of their maximum commitment.

Recently, Assembly Bill (AB) **133** amended Penal Code section **1370**, to affirm the requirement that committing county Sheriffs take custody of Penal Code section **1370** incompetent to stand trial (1ST) defendants from Department of State Hospitals (DSH) within **10** days-notice that the relevant 1ST defendant has no substantial likelihood of regaining competency within the foreseeable future or is within 90-days of their maximum commitment date following notice to the Sheriff by OSH. AB **133** further provides that, if the committing county Sheriff does not take custody of the defendant from DSH within **10** days upon receiving notice, the committing county shall be charged the daily rate for a state hospital bed, as established by the State Department of State Hospitals for civilly committed patients.
