Police Officers Standards and Training (POST) Travel POETA

and Training Reimbursement Requests (TRR) Forms

The purpose of this bulletin is to address uniformity in completing paperwork for the POST reimbursable and non-POST reimbursable classes.

Department members are mandated to attend POST training to better equip them to do their jobs as deputies, detectives, supervisors, etc. Several of the mandatory classes are reimbursable by POST and required forms need to be completed. The In-Service Training Unit is responsible in completing paperwork for the Sheriff Department's sworn employees who attend training that is paid by the org unit's travel budget. On several occasions there are individual stations that have funds in their budget to pay for the specialized training attended by deputies that will not go through the In-Service Training unit.

The correct expenditure account number must be used in order to track POST funds accurately. The <u>**E**</u> <u>section</u> of the **POETA**, which stands for Expenditure, has to be completed uniformity across the department.

For POST reimbursable classes, please use expenditure account number **expenditure**. For any class that is POST reimbursable, a completed <u>TRR form must be submitted</u>.
