REPORT NARRATIVE**Synopsis:**

Michael Pines was arrested for Terrorist Threats, 422 P.C., In the city of Rancho Santa Fe (Reference CN# 11152960.) Incident to Pines' arrest, he Resisted a Peace Officer, a violation of 148 (a)(1) P.C. Pines did this by refusing to be transported and resisting with force. Post arrest, Pines was discovered to

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have an Extraditeable warrant from the Orange County Sheriff's Department, warrant # 2174370, court case # 2011003560. He was subsequently transported to the Sheriff's Department Encinitas Patrol Station for processing on those charges.

While inside the Encinitas Patrol Station, Pines attempted to escape the custody of a Sheriff, with force, a violation of 836.6 P.C. During his escape attempt, Pines again resisted a Peace Officer, another violation of 148 (a)(1) P.C. Pines was injured during his escape attempt. He was transported to the Scripps Encinitas and later to the Scripps La Jolla Hospital, to be treated for his injuries.

Pines was arrested for the above mentioned charges. He was admitted to the Scripps La Jolla Hospital where he subsequently refused care and demanded to be transferred to the Kaiser Hospital of San Diego. Once released from hospital care, Pines will be transported to the Sheriff's Vista Detention Facility for booking on the above mentioned charges.

Origin:

On 10-22-2011, at about 1252 hours, Deputy Abbott #5620, Deputy Lovato #7162, and I received a radio call to assist the Rancho Santa Fe Patrol Officers. Rancho Santa Fe Patrol had contacted several subjects protesting in downtown Rancho Santa Fe near the intersection of El Tordo with Avenida De Acacias, in the city of Rancho Santa Fe.

One of the subjects was known by **(b)(5)(B)** to be, disbarred California Civil Attorney, Michael Pines.

Background:

On 10/26/11, at 2133 hours, Deputy D. Thompson, # 7364 responded to a radio call of Criminal Threats, at **(b)(5)(B)** in the city of Rancho Santa Fe. (CN# 11152960). In this case, Private Security Guard, and retired **(b)(5)(B)** **(b)(5)(B)**, had been hired by a bank to watch the home located at **(b)(5)(B)** in Rancho Santa Fe. **(b)(5)(B)** responsibility was to prevent the reentry of the home by the evicted owners and their disbarred attorney, Michael Pines.

While **(b)(5)(B)** was patrolling the **(b)(5)(B)** residence, Michael Pines, D.O.B. **(b)(5)(A)** drove onto the **(b)(5)(B)** property. Pines was known by **(b)(5)(B)** to be the friend and Attorney of the legally evicted resident. The eviction was completed by the San Diego County Sheriff's Department on the morning of 10-26-2011.

Pines contacted **(b)(5)(B)** Pines screamed at **(b)(5)(B)** telling him he would return on 10-27-2011, with armed men. Pines told **(b)(5)(B)** that he was going to personally "...shoot all of you." (Meaning security guards/ bank employees, and contractors)."

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The statements made to **(b)(5)(B)** caused him to fear for his personal safety, the safety of his co-workers and bank employees that were on the property at the time.

Pines was gone when Sheriff's Deputies arrived on scene. A criminal report was written about this incident. At the time of completion, **(b)(5)(B)** did not desire prosecution because Pines was no longer present.

I arrived on scene. I was told by **(b)(5)(B)** Officer **(b)(5)(B)** who Michael Pines was. I contacted the subject. He identified himself as Michael Pines. We were near the intersection of El Tordo with Avenida De Acacias in the city of Rancho Santa Fe.

Having knowledge of the incident that had occurred involving Pines a **(b)(5)(B)** I called the victim in Detective Thompson's case **(b)(5)(B)**. I spoke to him on his cellular telephone.

I told **(b)(5)(B)** I had found Michael Pines in the city of Rancho Santa Fe. I asked **(b)(5)(B)** if he desired prosecution for the threats Michael Pines made against him on 10-26-2011.

(b)(5)(B) said "Absolutely." "I did not think you would find him... He freaked me out yesterday." I specifically asked **(b)(5)(B)** if he wanted Pines arrested. **(b)(5)(B)** said "Yes."

Deputy Abbott and I approached Pines. Deputy Abbott was actively audio recording the incident from his department issued digital audio recorder.

Deputy Abbott and I arrested Pines pursuant to 422 P.C. Criminal Threats related to CN# 11152960. Subsequent to arrest, Pines refused to be transported to the Sheriff's Encinitas Station for processing. Deputy Abbott, Deputy Lovato, and I used body weight and a balance break to force Pines to a seated position within my marked Sheriff's vehicle. Pines' physical and verbal resistance was a violation of 148(a) P.C., Resist Obstruct or Delay a Peace Officer.

Deputies Abbott and Lovato wrote a detailed Deputy's Report of this incident. See their reports for specific information.

During Pines' arrest, Pines was discovered to have an outstanding warrant for his arrest in Orange County California. Warrant # 2174370, Court Case # 2011003560, was confirmed by the Orange County Sheriff's Department Records Clerk, **(b)(5)(B)** On 10-27-2011, at about 1355 hours. According to **(b)(5)(B)**, the Orange County Sheriff's Department was willing to extradite Pines back to Orange County in this case.

Once at the Sheriff's Encinitas Patrol Station, Pines was secured to the Station Briefing Room Custody Bench. Pines was there for several minutes during processing. While he was seated on the bench, I

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read Pines his rights under Miranda. I read Pines his rights directly from my Department Issued Deputy Notebook. Pines said "Yes Sir." When asked if he understood his rights and "Yup...Yes." When asked if he was willing to speak with me about his arrest.

Statements:

Statements of Michael Pines: (Arestee)

Pines was under constant digital audio recording during this entire contact. For his exact statements review the attached audio recording.

In essence, Pines denied ever having stepped foot on to the property located at **(b)(5)(B)** in Rancho Santa Fe. Pines also denied threatening anyone on 10-26-2011 for any reason.

Investigation Continued:

After speaking with Pines, I told him that I was going to relocate him to a secured holding cell. Pines was seated and handcuffed to the bench. I asked Pines to face away from me. Pines complied. As I attempted to unlock Pines' right wrist from the secure custody bench, my handcuff key stuck inside the lock as the handcuff cuff released.

Almost immediately Pines jumped to his feet and lunged for the briefing room exit door. From the corner of my eye, I saw Deputy Longfellow #5210 several feet away from our location with his back turned to us. Pines was still in possession of my handcuff with the stuck handcuff key on his dominant right hand.

Fearing Pines was now attempting to escape the station and the now unsecured handcuff could be used as a weapon to strike Deputy Longfellow or myself, I immediately attempted to bear hug Pines to limit and control his movement. I did this to slow his charge toward Deputy Longfellow and the Briefing Room exit door.

As Pines and I struggled, I yelled "Hey." "Stop, and "...Get down." I could feel my grasp slipping off Pines upper torso. I extended my right leg behind Pines locked knees. I utilized the grip I still had on Pines' upper torso and attempted to guide him backward to the ground by breaking his balance. As I did this, Pines and I fell to the floor. Pines landed on his left side and I fell with Pines to the ground. I ended up landing on the floor behind Pines back with my torso slightly over his right shoulder.

Once on the floor, I remained partially covering Pines' torso. I did this to maintain my body weight on him to control and further limit his continued resistance. As we remained on the ground I told Pines "...stay down." Deputy Longfellow assisted me in re-securing Pines into handcuffs. Pines was groaning and appeared to have been injured during his escape attempt.

The entire incident was recorded by Encinitas Station Camera Systems. On 10-27-2011, at about 1421 hours, station cameras seven and eight recorded Pines' escape attempt and struggle with me.

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Encinitas Station Camera 5 recorded Pines' confinement in station holding cell #2. The camera also recorded Pines' medical evaluation by the Encinitas Fire Department. The recordings were later burned onto a CD. The CD was later placed into the Sheriff's Encinitas Station Evidence Locker under the assigned case number.

The Encinitas Fire Department was immediately called to medically evaluate Pines for possible injuries. Pines was treated on scene and was transported to the Scripps Encinitas Medical Center for further treatment.

Deputy Abbott continued to monitor Pines with his digital audio recorder. Deputy Abbott rode with Pines inside the Encinitas Fire Department Ambulance to Scripps Encinitas Hospital. Pines was under the constant observation of Deputy Abbott during this process. Again see Deputy Abbott's Deputy Report for specific information after Pines left the Encinitas Sheriff's Station.

I called the original victim, **(b)(5)(B)** again. I took his official statement.

Statements of **(b)(5)(B)** (victim)

(b)(5)(B) had already given his official statement to Deputy Thompson on 10-26-2011 for case number 11152960. I called **(b)(5)(B)** so that he could have the opportunity to elaborate on the details of the incident.

I asked **(b)(5)(B)** how he knew Michael Pines and how he first came in contact with him. **(b)(5)(B)** told me that he was made aware of Michael Pines potential for violence through his boss, Attorney **(b)(5)(B)**. **(b)(5)(B)** told **(b)(5)(B)** that Pines was a disbarred local attorney. **(b)(5)(B)** said that Pines had multiple arrests in multiple California counties for burglary, vandalism, and criminal threats.

(b)(5)(B) said Pines was known to be "crazy." On 10-26-2011, at about 1730 hours, **(b)(5)(B)** met Pines when he drove onto the property at **(b)(5)(B)** in his Blue Toyota RAV-4. Pines drove his vehicle all the way down the driveway near the homes front entrance. Pines told **(b)(5)(B)** "...what they (bank representatives) were doing was illegal. Pines then screamed out the window of his car and said "I am going to come back tomorrow with armed men, and I am going to shoot everyone."

I told **(b)(5)(B)** that Deputy Thompson had written a criminal report but it implied that he did not want to prosecute Pines for the threats. **(b)(5)(B)** said he was under the impression (Sheriff's Department) would never find Pines. Now that I had found Pines, **(b)(5)(B)** wanted him arrested for the threats.

I asked **(b)(5)(B)** why the comment caused him to be fearful. **(b)(5)(B)** said that he knew that inside the home at **(b)(5)(B)** were multiple cases of live handgun and rifle ammunition. **(b)(5)(B)** also knew the guns that went with the ammunition were not believed to be inside the home or accounted for. The absence of the weapons led **(b)(5)(B)** to believe that Pines and the home owner were in possession

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of their guns. **(b)(5)(B)** knew that Pines was easily capable of locating the weapons and returning to the residence with them to carry out his promise.

I asked **(b)(5)(B)** to Describe the person he knew as Michael Pines. **(b)(5)(B)** told me that Pines was a 5'07" to 5'08" tall white male adult. Pines was in his mid to late 50's. He had dirty blond hair that was turning grey. **(b)(5)(B)** also estimated Pine's weight to be about 200 pounds.

(b)(5)(B) also told me that on 10-26-2011, as a white male adult drove onto the property **(b)(5)(B)** (who knew Pines personally) identified Pines as Michael Pines to **(b)(5)(B)** Pines was driving a small, blue, Toyota SUV with UTAH plates at the time of this incident.

Investigation Continued:

While processing Pines, I learned that Pines was out on bond from the San Diego County Sheriff's Department, Court Case Number 291531. Pines had a pending court case in San Diego County for Stalking 646.9 P.C. This is a violation of 12022.1 P.C. Commit a Felony While Released on Bond. Pines also showed a violation of 6126 (b) of the Business and Professions Code for a Bar Card Practice Law: Suspension.

Pines was later transported to Scripps Encinitas Hospital for an evaluation. He was then transported to Scripps La Jolla Hospital to be admitted. It was later learned on 10-28-2011, at about 1100 hours, Pines who was under the supervision of under the Supervision of Vista Detention Facility Personnel. Pines was refusing care at the Scripps La Jolla Hospital against medical advice. Pines was scheduled to be transferred to the Kaiser Hospital in San Diego.

Injuries:

At the time of this report, Scripps La Jolla Hospital believes Pines may have a broken collar bone, and nine broken ribbs.

SYNOPSIS:

(b)(5)(B) was the owner of the property and lived at (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe. On the morning of 10-26-11, the property was foreclosed on by One West Bank. Several people hired by One West Bank attended the lockout including two San Diego County Deputy Sheriff's, security personnel from (b)(5)(B) the attorney from One West Bank, (b)(5)(B), the real

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estate agent assigned the transaction, **(b)(5)(B)** and **(b)(5)(B)** from a property maintenance company.

Michael Pines claims to be an attorney representing **(b)(5)(B)**. On 10-26-11 at approximately 1700 hours Pines drove onto the property at **(b)(5)(B)**. Pines contacted one of the security guards identified as **(b)(5)(B)**. Pines told **(b)(5)(B)** the people evicting **(b)(5)(B)** had no right to do it. Pines told **(b)(5)(B)** he was going to come back to the property with armed men and shoot everyone there. **(b)(5)(B)** called the Sheriff's Department and reported this incident, case #11152960.

On 10-27-11 at about 1252 hours, Deputy Bloomberg #5393 responded to a call from **(b)(5)(B)** to respond to El Tordo and Avenida De Acacias to assist with protesters. Deputy Bloomberg arrived on scene and Pines was identified as one of the protesters in the group. Deputy Bloomberg arrested Pines for a violation of 422 PC Making Terrorist Threats.

While Pines was being processed at the Encinitas Patrol Station, Pines attempted to escape. Pines was apprehended and restrained by Deputy Bloomberg. See case #11153072 for details.

INVESTIGATION:

On 10-27-11, I received 422 PC Terrorist Threat, case #11152960. On 10-31-11, I received 836.6(B) PC Attempted Escape, case #11153072. These two cases are related incidents. The suspect in both cases is Michael Pines **(b)(5)(A)**

On 10-31-11, I sent an e-mail request to the Sheriff's Communications Center requesting the CAD history and the recorded telephone calls to the Sheriff's Communications Center on both of these cases.

On 11-03-11, I received the printed CAD histories and a CD recording of the telephone calls to the Sheriff's Communications Center. I placed these items into evidence at the Encinitas Patrol Station.

On 11-14-11 at 0920 hours, I called **(b)(5)(B)** DOB **(b)(5)(B)** on the telephone and took his statement.

VICTIM **(b)(5)(B)** STATEMENT:

(b)(5)(B) stated he works as a private security guard for **(b)(5)(B)** **(b)(5)(B)** hired **(b)(5)(B)** to guard the foreclosed property at **(b)(5)(B)** in Rancho Santa Fe.

On 10-26-11 at approximately 1400 hours, he **(b)(5)(B)** received a telephone call from **(b)(5)(B)** who was assigned to guard the house and was on his shift at **(b)(5)(B)** in Rancho Santa Fe. **(b)(5)(B)** told him he was having problems with the evicted owner from **(b)(5)(B)**. The evicted owner

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was threatening the uniformed security guards at the residence. (b)(5) suggested (b)(5)(B) come out to the residence and talk with the client (bank representatives).

(b)(5)(B) was in Riverside County when he received the telephone call from (b)(5). He drove to the residence. (b)(5)(B) arrived at the residence at about 1600 hours and met with the person from (b)(5)(B) who had hired (b)(5)(B) the real estate agent who was representing the bank, (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) who is the attorney representing the bank.

(b)(5)(B), (b)(5) and (b)(5)(B) told (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) came to the residence and began making threats to the security guards. He threatened that he was going to have warrants issued for all of their arrests. (b)(5) and (b)(5)(B) said they were videotaping everything being removed from the residence. They removed a shotgun, a handgun and several boxes of ammunition from the residence.

(b)(5)(B), (b)(5) and (b)(5)(B) then brought up (in conversation) Michael Pines. (b)(5)(B) said he had never heard of Michael Pines before. They said Pines is an attorney who encourages his clients to reclaim their real estate property. They said he (Pines) may come and try to claim it for his friend, (b)(5)(B) saw Pines driving up on the property. (b)(5)(B) pointed Pines out to him. (b)(5)(B) said there was no reason for Pines to be on the property. He told him (b)(5)(B) to tell Pines to leave.

(b)(5)(B) said he walked over to Pines who had stopped and was sitting in the driver seat of his car. He told Pines the property was bank owned and he had to leave. Pines yelled at him and told him what they were doing was illegal and he was going to have arrest warrants issued for all of the people involved with the foreclosure take over of the property from the bank.

(b)(5)(B) told Pines he would have to leave the property. He was now trespassing because the property was now bank owned. Pines said he was going to return with his own armed men and they were going to shoot them all. He said it very convincingly. Pines sped off.

(b)(5)(B) called the Sheriff's Department to report a violation of 422 PC Terrorist Threats. (b)(5)(B) thinks Pines is a "loose canon."

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

On 11-16-11, I reviewed the audio recording made by Deputy Bloomberg of his conversation with Pines while Pines was seated on the prisoner bench in the briefing room at the Encinitas Patrol Station and after Deputy Bloomberg had advised Pines of his Miranda Rights. Pines waived his Miranda Rights and made the following statement.

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Pines stated he is familiar with the residence at (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe and he knows that (b)(5)(B) is the owner of the residence. He is a friend of (b)(5)(B). Pines stated on 10-26-11 he was near (b)(5)(B) but he did not contact/talk with anyone at or near the property. Pines stated if anyone said he did talk with someone at (b)(5)(B) they are making the story up.

Pines denied making threats to a security guard at the residence on 10-26-11. Pines stated he went "near the property alone" early in the morning on 10-26-11. Pines stated that on 10-26-11 at approximately 1700 hours, he was with (b)(5)(B) at (b)(5)(B)'s residence on El Camino Real in Rancho Santa Fe. He later left (b)(5)(B)'s and went to a condominium in the City of Encinitas. He went to dinner and went to bed early that evening.

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

On 12-12-11 at 1610 hours, I talked with (b)(5)(B) DOB (b)(5)(B) on the telephone and took his statement.

WITNES (b)(5)(B) STATEMENT:

(b)(5)(B) stated he is the attorney representing One West Bank. One West Bank won a judgment for possession of the property at (b)(5)(B). By virtue of foreclosure, One West Bank owned the property. The previous owner was (b)(5)(B).

On 10-26-11 One West Bank was able to serve the writ for possession of the property. He (b)(5)(B) went to the property 10-26-11 upon One West Bank's direction. (b)(5)(B) was at the property at about 1000 hours observing the re-keying of the front gate and the removal of property from the residence. Two San Diego County Deputy Sheriff's were at the property while the writ of possession was being served.

Pines drove up to the residence. (b)(5)(B) was familiar with Pines because Pines was an attorney representing (b)(5)(B) in court while (b)(5)(B) was contesting One West Bank foreclosing on the property. Pines told him what they were doing was wrong and the bank was going to pay for this. Pines said he was going to have some people come by the residence and protest.

The two San Diego County Deputy Sheriff's told Pines he would have to leave the property because he had no right to be there. Pines left the residence between 1015 hours and 1030 hours.

The Sheriff's Deputies told him that if Pines returned, he should call the Sheriff's Department and they would arrest Pines for a violation of 602 PC Trespassing.

Between 1730 hours and 1800 hours, he was standing at the residence with (b)(5)(B) (a security guard). He saw Pines driving through the driveway gate up towards the residence. He told (b)(5)(B) he needed to watch out for Pines because he had made threats in the past. (b)(5)(B) walked over to Pines and talked with Pines. (b)(5)(B) was standing about 15 to 20 feet away from Pines and (b)(5)(B)

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(b)(5)(B) told Pines to leave. Pines told (b)(5)(B) he was going to, "come back with a bunch of armed people" the next day. Pines drove away.

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

On 12-12-11 at 1700 hours, I talked with (b)(5)(B) on the telephone and took her statement.

WITNESS (b)(5)(B) S STATEMENT:

(b)(5)(B) stated she is a self employed real estate agent representing One West Bank. She was first assigned the property by One West Bank in August of 2010. On 10-26-11, she along with two San Diego County Deputy Sheriff's, (b)(5)(B) parents, a locksmith and (b)(5)(B) were taking control of the property at (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe. It was about 1030 hours. She led the caravan of vehicles to the front gate of the property.

She was out of her vehicle and the two Deputy Sheriff's were standing by their vehicles when Michael Pines drove up in a car with Utah license plates on it. Pines was in a car similar in appearance to a Honda Element. Pines was standing on the driver's seat of the car, standing through the sun roof of the vehicle. He verbally identified himself to the Sheriff's Deputies as Michael Pines. Pines told the Deputies he was an attorney and what they were doing was illegal. Pines made some threats to the Deputies but she couldn't remember them specifically. Pines asked for the Sheriff's Deputy's cards. It appeared that the Sheriff's Deputies were familiar with Pines. The Sheriff's Deputies told Pines that they remembered him from other evictions they were present for. They told Pines he could not come on the property. Pines said he would be back and he drove away. (b)(5) stated the Sheriff's Deputies and she were the only people out of their cars and only they heard what Pines said. The other people there to assist in the eviction were still in their vehicles.

They entered the property through the front gate and entered the house. There were no occupants in the house. The Deputy Sheriff's left the property. Sometime early in the afternoon (around noon), (b)(5) (b)(5)(B) girlfriend (b)(5) drove up to the residence in an SUV. She was complaining to (b)(5)(B) (the security guard) that she was being threatened and harassed. (b)(5) told (b)(5) she could be on the property if she wanted to be. She threatened to make a citizen's arrest of (b)(5) (b)(5) was making some threatening comments to (b)(5) (b)(5) told (b)(5) he wasn't sure why she was feeling this way since no one was threatening her. (b)(5) continued to complain to (b)(5) that they couldn't evict them (her and (b)(5)(B) (b)(5) called the Sheriff's Department to return to the property because she said she was being harassed. (b)(5)(B) mother told (b)(5) that no one was harassing her and they were allowing her to retrieve her personal property from the residence. (b)(5) said she was trying to stay away from the confrontation (b)(5) was creating because (b)(5)(B) had previously threatened to sue her brokerage company previously.

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The **(b)(5)(B)** owner was there since it was a high value property. Two property evaluation managers, **(b)(5)(B)** his brother **(b)(5)(B)** his mother and father, **(b)(5)(B)** assistant and a young videographer and some security guards.

(b)(5) drove up and left a few times during the afternoon. **(b)(5)(B)** also came up to the residence during the afternoon. **(b)(5)** is an assistant for **(b)(5)(B)** **(b)(5)** is a real estate broker. **(b)(5)(B)** introduced **(b)(5)** to her in March of 2010 as an attorney when they were attempting an eviction. **(b)(5)** may have been an occupant of the residence.

(b)(5) became afraid since **(b)(5)(B)** Pines and **(b)(5)** were contesting the eviction and making personal threats. She called One West Bank and suggested they hire armed guards to protect the people and the property.

Later in the afternoon, another security guard identified as **(b)(5)(B)** arrived at the residence. **(b)(5)(B)** called the bank also, and suggested they have armed guards guard the property 24 hours a day. She was leaving the property when **(b)(5)(B)** told her a man by the name of Michael Pines had just left. Pines had told him he was going to come back to the property and shoot everyone there at 5:30 PM when he returns. **(b)(5)** said she was surprised that Pines returned to the property after she heard the Sheriff's Deputies clearly tell Pines that he could not come onto the property again.

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

On 12-13-11 at approximately 1600 hours, I talked with **(b)(5)(B)** DOB **(b)(5)(B)** **(b)(5)** made the following statement.

WITNESS **(b)(5)(B)** STATEMENT:

(b)(5) stated he is a full time employee as a **(b)(5)(B)** He was employed part time as a security guard for **(b)(5)(B)** **(b)(5)** received a telephone call on the evening of 10-25-11 from his supervisor, **(b)(5)(B)** to go to **(b)(5)(B)** on 10-26-11 at approximately 1000 hours, to provide security for the eviction that was going to take place there.

(b)(5) arrived at the location at approximately 1000 hours, where he met the real estate agent hired by One West Bank, an attorney representing One West Bank, the people facilitating the eviction and two San Diego County Deputy Sheriff's who were serving the eviction notice. **(b)(5)** was armed and was wearing a polo shirt and black cargo pants.

All of the people involved in the eviction entered through the front gate of the property and the Sheriff's Deputies checked the interior of the residence for occupants. There were none.

After the residence was secured, a white male drove up to the residence in a blue car. **(b)(5)** said he thought it looked like a RAV 4. The man was older. He had gray hair, reddish complexion and a heavy

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build. The man (Pines) was yelling from his vehicle that the eviction was unlawful. Pines said they were all going to be arrested. Pines had a verbal exchange with the San Diego County Sheriff's Deputies and he drove away.

(b)(5) said he had never met the man in the blue car before and he never spoke with him while they were on the property. (b)(5) said he did not witness the man in the blue car (Pines) make any threats to anyone there. (b)(5) said he was standing about 50 feet away from Pines while he was talking with the San Diego County Sheriff's Deputies.

(b)(5) said between 1715 hours and 1720 hours, his shift was over and he left the property. He was relieved by (b)(5)(B).

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

On 12-13-11 at 1525 hours, I called (b)(5)(B) DOB (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) made the following statement

WITNESS (b)(5)(B) STATEMENT:

(b)(5)(B) stated he is th (b)(5)(B) of (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) has been at (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe about nines times regarding the bank foreclosing on this property. During the morning of 10-26-11 he was standing in the garage when Pines drove up in an older model gray BMW. Pines was talking with a security officer. Pines was angry and was speaking loudly to the security officer. He overheard Pines say, "We're coming back! This is illegal! You'll be sorry." (b)(5)(B) couldn't hear distinctly anything else Pines was saying. (b)(5)(B)'s girlfriend, (b)(5)(B) (who had been there since about 20 minutes after they had arrived) walked into the garage and picked up some .22 caliber ammunition and walked out.

Other people who were standing by Pines then walked up to the house. He heard them say, "Did you hear what he said? He said they were going to come back and shoot us!" They gathered everyone who was at the house and they all moved to the second story of the residence for safety. The security officers closed the gate to the residence and someone called the Sheriff's Department to respond to the house.

(b)(5)(B) stated the whole incident was videotaped by someone that (b)(5)(B) had hired. The woman who videotaped the eviction was (b)(5)(B) from (b)(5)(B)

On 12-13-11 at 1745 hours, I talked with (b)(5)(B) DO (b)(5)(B) on the telephone and took her statement.

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(b)(5)(B) stated she is employed by (b)(5)(B) On 10-26-11 at approximately 1000 hours, she went to (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe to video tape the eviction being conducted there. Her assignment was to videotape the entire residence inside and out to document (on video) what was there.

When she arrived there she met with the other people involved in the eviction. She heard that they were not sure if the residence was occupied or not. Someone (a locksmith or other worker) opened the front gate to the driveway and they entered the property. She started filming as the front door was unlocked and they entered the residence.

(b)(5)(B) remembers that before they entered the residence she videotaped Michel Pines talking with the Sheriff's Deputies, but she didn't hear what was said and it was only 30 to 45 seconds of video. Pines drove away after talking with the Sheriff's Deputies for a short period of time.

A few hours later, (b)(5)(B) girlfriend, (b)(5)(B) drove up to the residence in a white Range Rover. She left shortly afterwards. She did not take any property from the residence.

(b)(5)(B) stated she heard people talking about Pines making a threat that he was going to come back to the residence and shoot everyone there. (b)(5)(B) said she never directly heard Pines say it.

(b)(5)(B) said I could get a copy of the video from her supervisor, (b)(5)(B)

INVESTIGATION (CONT.):

I called (b)(5)(B) on the telephone and asked him for a copy of the video (b)(5)(B) had taken of the eviction. (b)(5)(B) told me he would need authorization from (b)(5)(B) to release it.

On 12-19-11, I received a telephone call from (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) told me copies of the video recordings were available for me to pick up. On 12-19-11 at 1450 hours, I went to (b)(5)(B) and met with (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) gave me five CD video discs. (b)(5)(B) told me these CDs contained all of the video (b)(5)(B) had shot at (b)(5)(B) in Rancho Santa Fe. There were two CDs dated 10-26-11, two CDs dated 10-27-11 and one CD dated 11-01-11.

On 12-20-11, I reviewed the video from 10-26-11. The beginning of the video is marked at 1045 hours. San Diego County Sheriff's Deputies Scott Swannie #1959 and Gerald Rabidou #2290 are standing by a dark blue Rav 4 automobile. (b)(5)(B) is standing by Deputy Swannie and Rabidou. A voice is heard from the vehicle. The person asked for the Deputies' name and badge numbers. The Sheriff's Deputies appear to be giving the person in the blue car their business cards. Deputy Rabidou told the driver of the blue car, "Have a nice day Mr. Pines Drive careful." The vehicle drove away.

REPORT NARRATIVE

Origin:

On 10/27/11, at about 1254 hours, I received a radio call to investigate a report of trespassing at the intersection of El Tordo and Avenida De Acacias, Rancho Santa Fe.

Deputy's Observations and Actions:

I asked Deputy Bloomberg to accompany me. Deputy Bloomberg had handled a similar situation the previous day. I arrived at about 1321 hours. I was directed by a **(b)(5)(B)** to the protestors. They were standing in front of 6094 El Tordo. I parked across the street and exited my car. There were a total of four protestors. I told them to have a seat on the wall. I recognized one of them. I had met Michael Pines on a previous occasion in Encinitas. I asked who the leader of the protest was. Pines said he was. I asked if he was Mr. Pines. He confirmed he was. I for got my voice recorder in the car. I went back to get it while Deputy Bloomberg stayed with the protestors.

I retrieved my voice recorder and turned it on. The name of the recording was DS300018.wma. Deputy Bloomberg contacted the victim of a threat that occurred the previous day. I told Pines he was being detained and was not free to leave. Pines said he understood. Two additional protestors joined the larger group.

At about 2:55 hours on the recording, Deputy Bloomberg told Pines to put his hands behind his back. Pines said "No." I told Pines he was given a lawful order and told him to put his hands behind his back. Deputy Bloomberg told Pines he was under arrest for terrorist threats. Deputy Bloomberg again told Pines to put his hands behind his back. Pines said he needed to make a phone call. Both Deputy Bloomberg and I told him no. I took Pines phone from his hands. Pines put his hands behind his back. As Deputy Bloomberg was about to apply the handcuffs Pines pulled away and said "No, I don't." Pines pulled his hands away and tried to walk away. Deputy Bloomberg and I stopped him. Deputy Bloomberg told him not to resist and I told him not to pull away. I told Pines he would get additional charges if he resisted. He said "That's fine."

After being handcuffed Deputy Bloomberg walked Pines to his car. Pines told me to use his phone to call someone. I told Pines he didn't have a right to an attorney until he was questioned about the crime he was accused of.

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At 5:40 hours on the recording, Deputy Bloomberg told Pines to step inside the back seat of the car. Pines said "No." Deputy Bloomberg asked him to step into the car again. Pines said "I'm waiting until the armed reinforcements get here." Deputy Bloomberg tried to clarify what the armed reinforcements were for. Pines said "They are coming here." At 5:55 on the recording, I asked Pines if he was refusing a lawful order. He said "Yes." I told Pines he was being recorded. He said "Good." Deputy Bloomberg asked Pines to get inside the car again. He again refused. Deputy Bloomberg tried several times in different ways to persuade Pines to get into the car. Pines said "I'm not getting in the car." Pines turned and tried to walk away. Deputy Bloomberg and I grabbed Pines by the arms. We lifted his arms behind his back to keep him from getting away. Pines said "Ok." Deputy Bloomberg and I released our holds. We held him by his arms to keep him from getting away. Deputy Bloomberg helped Pines into the car. Deputy Lovato helped Pines into the seat from the passenger side of the car.

I used my radio and had dispatch inform Sgt. Lawrence of a use of force. Deputy Bloomberg asked the (b)(5)(B) for a written statement because he was a witness to the incident. I followed Deputy Bloomberg to the Sheriff's Encinitas Station.

Pines asked me if he could use the restroom. I told him it would be a few minutes before I could get him to the bathroom. He said he was ok with that.

At about 35:10 on the recording Deputy Bloomberg admonished Pines. Pines statement continues until about 45:00.

At about 45:00 on the recording, Deputy Bloomberg released Pines' handcuff from the bench. On the recording you can hear Deputy Bloomberg yell "Hey, hey, get down!" Deputy Bloomberg continues to say "Down, down. Don't move."

I was in the Sergeants office. I heard Deputy Bloomberg yell. I turned around and saw Pines on the floor with Deputy Bloomberg next to him. I ran to see if anyone needed help. I called dispatch to ask for paramedics to the station. I found Deputy Bloomberg's handcuff key on the floor. Pines was moved to a cell while waiting for paramedics.

When Paramedics arrived I took photographs of his injuries. I rode with the ambulance to Scripps Hospital Encinitas.

I stayed with Pines at the hospital while he was being seen. After getting back a set of x-rays, the doctor decided to move Pines to Scripps Hospital La Jolla. I rode in the ambulance with Pines.

The entire time I was with Pines he never asked to use the restroom. He didn't use the restroom while he was in the holding cell either. Pines asked me where his phone and belongings were I told him they were at the station. Pines never asked to make a phone call.

I continued the recording until my battery died at the hospital. I placed the photographs and audio recording onto a CD and gave them to Deputy Bloomberg for evidence.

Pines was told again to put his hands behind his back. Pines was holding a cell phone and asked to make a call. Both Deputy Bloomberg and Deputy Abbott told him no. Pines put his hands behind his back. As Deputy Bloomberg was about to apply the handcuffs, Pines pulled away and yelled "No, I don't." Pines attempted to pull his hands away and tried to leave. I heard Deputy Bloomberg yell something to the effect of, "Hey, come back here, stop." When I turned around I saw that Deputy Bloomberg was standing behind Pines. Pines was pulling away from Bloomberg, towards the direction of the exit. Deputy Bloomberg grabbed Pines by the arms to control him. When Pines continued to pull away, Bloomberg pulled Pines towards him and placed his arms under Pines' armpits. Bloomberg twisted his body, pushing Pines to the floor. Pines landed on his left side, with his head and shoulder contacting the ground first.

I ran to assist Bloomberg. I pulled Pines' legs straight to prevent him from spinning. I then folded Pines' legs bending them at the knee. I crossed Pines' ankles and bent them towards his hips and pressed my bodyweight into Pines to prevent him from kicking or spinning.

When it was apparent that Pines was not resisting us, I removed my bodyweight from Pines' legs. Pines was turned onto his left side, into the recovery position. Paramedics were called.

On Thursday, October 27, 2011 at about 1421 hours, I was walking through the Encinitas Station briefing room when I observed a use of force by Deputy Brian Bloomberg.

Deputy's Observations and Actions:

I was in the station briefing room walking from the locker room toward the front office area. I observed Deputy Bloomberg behind a subject, later identified as Michael Pines. They were standing by the prisoner bench. Deputy Bloomberg was taking a pair of handcuffs off of Pines and I thought I heard him say he was moving Pines to one of the holding cells. When Deputy Bloomberg had the left cuff off of Pines left wrist, Pines raised both of his arms as if he were trying to pull away from Deputy Bloomberg. I started to move toward Deputy Bloomberg so I could help gain control of Pines. Pines still had the pair of handcuffs attached to his right wrist and I was worried that he might be able to use the handcuff as a weapon.

I noticed that Deputy Bloomberg still had a grip on Pines right arm. Deputy Bloomberg was giving orders for Pines to stop. As I approached, Deputy Bloomberg used his leverage and body weight to turn Pines to the left and he took Pines to the floor. Pines landed on his head and left shoulder. I was now standing over Pines and Deputy Bloomberg getting ready to apply body weight with the intent of grabbing an arm. As I bent over, it appeared that Pines may have lost consciousness and there was no need for me to apply any additional body weight. Another deputy I believe was Deputy Longfellow assisted Deputy Bloomberg with putting the handcuff back on Pines' left wrist.

Deputy Abbott and Sergeant Lawrence had come out of the patrol sergeant's office. Sergeant Lawrence asked Deputy Abbott to notify the communications center that we needed the paramedics to respond to the station. I was evaluating Pines breathing and responsiveness and I asked Deputy Bloomberg to place Pines in a recovery position on his side. Pines was becoming more responsive and he started to complain about his shoulder hurting. It appeared that being in the recovery position on his left side was causing him some discomfort. I asked Pines if there was another position that he would be more comfortable in and he wanted to sit up. I asked him if he was going to be cooperative and he said he would. Deputy Bloomberg assisted Pines into a seated position. I believed this position improved Pines level of comfort but Pines was still complaining about his shoulder hurting. Pines was now alert and responsive to questioning. A decision was made to move Pines to one of the holding cells. Deputy Bloomberg explained to Pines how he was going to assist Pines in standing. Deputy Bloomberg assisted Pines to his feet and he was escorted into holding cell number two. I stayed in the area until the paramedics arrived to evaluate Pines. Pines was subsequently transported to the hospital.

Origin: Notification of trespassers in the park by RSFP Officer (b)(5)(B)

Activity: I was notified by Officer (b)(5)(B) that the "Occupy" protesters had returned and were setting up camp in the park. Upon arrival the "Occupy" protesters were in the North Park at the corner of Avenida De Acacias and El Tordo. The park is owned and maintained by the Rancho Santa Fe Association. They had erected signs and had personal property and a bedroll. When contacted by Officer (b)(5) they refused to leave. Upon my arrival at 13:00 hrs., I contacted the protesters and asked them to leave, advising them the park is private property. They refused. I advised them that the Sheriff was enroute and would tell them the same thing. After about 10 minutes, they decided to move to the law offices of Luce, Forward at 6050 El Tordo, RSF.

They were then contacted by the Sheriff's Dept. regarding their refusal to leave the park. I was on scene acting as a representative of the Association.

Sheriff Deputies then arrested Michael Pines (one of the protesters) on an unrelated charge of 422 p.c. When Pines was instructed to turn around and place his hands behind his back, he resisted their commands both verbally and physically. The Deputies warned him not to resist, that it was a lawful order. It was obvious he was resisting the Deputy's efforts to handcuff him. They again instructed him not to resist as he could have additional charges brought against him for resisting a peace officer. Pines said "that's fine". Eventually, they handcuffed him and they moved him to a patrol car that was parked in the street in front of 6050 El Tordo.

As they started to place Pines into the car, Pines began resisting their efforts to put him in the back seat. He would not put his feet into the car and was pushing back against the Deputies. The Deputies had to use force in order to place him into the car. It took three deputies to do so- two on one side of the car, and another reaching in from the opposite side. Once in the car, Pines calmed down and quit resisting.
