John Walters ((b)(5)(A) was arrested for being drunk in public. While transporting Walters to the jail, Walters slipped the handcuffs from behind his back to the front of his body.

Walters tried to use the seatbelt buckle to break the handcuffs. Walters then tried to use the buckle to break the rear driver's side window. Walters began kicking the rear driver's side door and also the buckle that he positioned against the window. Upon attempting to remove Walters from the patrol vehicle, he exhibited assaultive behavior by posturing that he would kick me and possibly use the handcuffs as a weapon. Physical force was used to overcome Walters' resistance and he was placed into maximum restraints.

Walters was transported to Grossmont Hospital by paramedics. Walters was admitted to the hospital for possible facial fractures. Walters was released from custody pursuant to 849 (b) (2) PC. The additional charges of 664-594 (B) (2) (a) PC and 148 (a) (1) PC were added to this case.

ORIGIN:

On 05-13-12, at about 1800 hours, I received a radio call to investigate a family disturbance at Diego Avenue in Ramona.

BACKGROUND:

The reporting party, **(b)(5)(B)** reported that **(b)(5)(B)**, John Walters, was in a verbal argument with her. John was possibly drunk or under the influence of a controlled substance.

(b)(5)(B) lives alone in the residence. John Walters has been living out of the broken down motorhome in her front yard for the past three months.

INVESTIGATION:

Deputy Foote (7349) and I arrived at about 1806 hours. I contacted John Walters wandering in the front yard near the motorhome and a broken down truck. Walters had been drinking alcohol and claimed to be looking for his cat. Walters was compliant and cooperative during the contact. I explained that he was creating stress for **(b)(5)(B)** by arguing with her. He reported that he gets frustrated with because she has dementia and he just wants to try to help her. Walters started crying while talking to me and Deputy Foote.

I went to contact (b)(5)(B) in the residence while Deputy Foote stayed with John Walters. (b)(5)(B) provided the following statement.

STATEMENTS:

Statement of (b)(5)(B) (witness):

(b)(5)(B) could tell that John had been drinking today. John came into the house to find something (possibly a tool) to get the motorhome started. John became angry when he could not find what he was looking for. John accused (b)(5)(B) of throwing the item away. (b)(5)(B) stated that John had cussed and yelled at her. (b)(5)(B) wants John to leave her property.

Investigation continued:

(b)(5)(B) received a phone call from (b)(5)(B) in Vista. I briefly spoke to (b)(5)(B) and she was aware of the eviction process. I explained to $\binom{b}{(5)(B)}$ that she needed to legally evict John from the property. I went back out to speak with John Walters. Walters was apologetic that we had to be called out. Walters agreed to leave (b)(5)(B) alone. Deputy Foote and I cleared from the scene at about 1819 hours.

At about 1820 hours, (b)(5)(B) had called back to the Sheriff's Communications Center. (b)(5)(B) requested contact from the deputies. I attempted about four phone calls to (b)(5)(B) with no answer. At about 1846 hours, (b)(5)(B) called back to report that John Walters was banging on her front door and yelling at her. I spoke to (b)(5)(B) after the call back. (b)(5)(B) felt that John was going to kill her. (b)(5)(B) now had (b)(5)(B), at the residence with her. (b)(5)(B) spoke on the phone with me. She reported that John was currently banging on the front door and yelling that he needed help. (b)(5)(B) told me that she had to leave soon and go back to work nearby.

I returned to the address at about 1855 hours. John Walters was still wandering in the front yard. I detained him in handcuffs. John denied that he had banged on the front door and yelled at (b)(5)(B). I determined that John could not care for his safety due to his level of intoxication. I also believed that John would continue to harass and scare (b)(5)(B)

I placed John Walters under arrest for a violation of 647 (f) PC. Walters was compliant and his only concern was for his lost cat. I looked for the cat with ^{(D)(5)(B)} but did not find it.

I placed Walters into my patrol vehicle and buckled his seatbelt. I started to transport him to the jail. Walters admitted that he had been drinking tequila today. On southbound State Route 67 just past Scripps Poway Parkway, Walters complained about being arrested and believed that he should be handcuffed in the front. I told him that I could not do that. Walters proceeded to unbuckle his seatbelt. Walters was able to transfer his handcuffed arms around his legs and now had his handcuffed arms in front of his body. Walters then positioned his body with his back against the cabin divider and had his feet towards the rear window. I believed that Walters was going to "kick-out" the back window.

I used my radio to report that my prisoner had slipped his handcuffs and requested that a deputy from Lakeside assist me in re-handcuffing Walters at State Route 67 and Slaughterhouse Canyon Road. I pulled over at that location at about 1916 hours.

NOTE: On my patrol vehicle (20354), the two rear doors have bars over the window portions of the doors.

I exited my patrol vehicle. I saw that Walters now had the buckle of the seatbelt wedged between his handcuffs. Walters then banged the buckle on the bars of the driver's side door. I told Walters to stop trying to break the handcuffs. I believed that Walters was trying to escape from custody. Walters hit the

bars about three more times with the buckle wedged between his handcuffs. I saw Walters manipulate the seatbelt buckle to fit between the bars of the driver's side door against the glass window. I told Walters to stop and put his hands back behind his back. Walters kept yelling, "Fuck you! Let me go!" Walters tried hitting the buckle with the handcuffs to break the window. Walters then kicked the bars with his feet where he had positioned the buckle.

I know from previous cases of vandalism where the suspect kicked a patrol vehicle door and the repair had exceeded \$400. I believed that Walters could have damaged my patrol vehicle, kicked out a window and would try to escape.

I went to the passenger side of the vehicle to distract Walters from kicking the door. Walters had now turned with his feet toward me and the passenger side door. I believed that if I had opened the door, Walters was going to kick me. I went back to the driver's side of the vehicle. Walters turned his body back to the driver's side with his feet extended. Walters started to place the seatbelt buckle back between the driver's side bars.

At about 1925 hours, I walked back around to the passenger side of my patrol vehicle. I opened the rear door. I grabbed onto the back of Walters' t-shirt. I told him to get out of the car. Walters pulled his body away from me. I grabbed Walters in a control hold by positioning my right arm around his neck in a carotid restraint hold. I did not apply pressure to Walters' neck as my intention was to remove him from the vehicle. I used my hold to pull Walters out of the vehicle. Walters held onto the seat belt as I pulled him out. When the seatbelt became taught, I lost my hold of Walters. Walters let go of the seatbelt and rolled onto his back on the ground. Walters had his handcuffed hands clenched in fists in front of his face. I believed that Walters was going to assault me by using the handcuffs as a weapon. I attempted to gain control of Walters' hands by pushing them away from me as I used my body weight to control Walters' legs. I instructed Walters to get onto his stomach. Walters continued to resist by wrapping his legs around mine. I was able to keep Walters' arms away from me as he rolled onto his side facing towards me. Walters now had his hands close to his chest. I used my right thumb to apply pressure to Walters' mandibular angle pressure point on his left side. I instructed him to stop resisting and to roll onto his stomach. Walters continued to resist by trying to bring his hands back towards my face. I used two knee strikes to Walters' abdomen. The pressure point and knee strikes had no effect on Walters.

Walters had thrashed his body and legs with me on top of him during the incident. We had moved about six feet on the asphalt road to the asphalt gutter at the edge of the roadway. I used four closed fist strikes with my left hand to Walters' face. The first fist strike landed above Walters' left ear as he ducked his head. The next two strikes landed in the area of Walters' left eye. The last strike landed on Walters' nose. The fist strikes were effective and I was able to gain control of Walters. Walters was now on his stomach and I used my body weight to keep Walters pinned in the gutter. I had my knees straddling his back and I used my hands to keep Walters' arms extended above his head.

Walters began to bleed from his nose. Walters started to spit blood and spray blood out of his nose. I kept downward pressure on the left side of Walter's head with my right hand to prevent him from turning

and spitting on me. Walters continued to yell, "Fuck you! Let go of me! Get the fuck off of me!" I was not injured during the incident.

At about 1927 hours, Deputy Thayer (9921) arrived to assist me. Deputy Thayer used his radio to call for paramedics. I informed Deputy Thayer that Walters needed to be placed in cord cuffs (maximum restraints). Walters continued to resist at this point. I maintained my position on Walters' upper body. I could feel that Walters was kicking his legs and trying to twist his body under me. I told Walters to stop resisting. Deputy Thayer also instructed Walters to stop kicking and stop resisting.

See Deputy Thayer's report for his observations and actions. Deputy Kastelic (6333) arrived to assist. See Deputy Kastelic's report for his observations and actions. Lakeside Fire Engine 2 and Medic 2 arrived on scene. Walters was secured in cord cuffs and waist chains with the assistance of Deputy Thayer and Deputy Kastelic.

The paramedics injected Walters with two doses of (b)(5)(C) to calm Walters down. I rode in the ambulance with the paramedics and Walters to Grossmont Hospital.

Walters was still resisting while in the restraints by kicking his legs. The hospital staff and hospital security guards secured Walters in "leather restraints". Walters was injected with (b)(5)(C) to calm him down. After a few minutes, Walters calmed down and fell asleep.

Doctor (b)(5)(B) observed possible facial fractures above Walters' left eye and believed that Walters' nose was broken. Walters was going to be admitted to the hospital. Walters was coherent and able to answer the nurse's questions.

I completed the Certificate of Release form and released Walters from custody at about 2355 hours.

ORIGIN:

On 05/13/2012 at about 1931 hours, I received a radio call (CAD#S9994316) to assist Lakeside Deputy C. Thayer and Ramona Deputy C. Martinez with a drunken prisoner who had slipped his handcuffs at the intersection of Slaughterhouse Canyon Rd and Highway 67 in Lakeside.

INVESTIGATION:

I arrived at the above location. At the side of the road, I observed Deputies C. Martinez and C. Thayer positioned over a prone, handcuffed subject (who was later identified to me as John Walters). Deputy Thayer was holding Walters feet and ankles, and Deputy Martinez was holding Walter's outstretched and bloody arms. Walters was twisting from side to side and was kicking his feet.

Deputy Thayer asked me to assist him with applying a cord cuff restraint. I held Walters feet and ankles while Deputy Thayer applied the cord cuff restraint. Walters yelled loudly "fuck you, why are you doing this to me! I'll fucking kill you!" Walters continued to twist and kick his feet, so I positioned my body weight over his legs and buttocks to prevent him from moving. Deputy Thayer and I assisted Deputy Martinez into repositioning Walters' hands from the handcuffs and into waist chains.

Paramedics from the Lakeside Fire Department arrived, and I assisted them into placing Walters onto a gurney. During the entirety of my involvement in the incident, Walters behaved violently, actively and aggressively resisted law enforcement, and did not obey any commands to calm down or comply with lawful orders. I photographed Walters, Deputy Martinez (who had blood stains on his uniform sleeves), and the scene. Walters was transported to Grossmont Hospital.

I concluded my involvement in the matter.

ORIGIN:

On 05/13/12, at about 1917 hours, I assisted Deputy Martinez #1472 on an assist call on Slaughter House canyon in Lakeside.

DEPUTY OBSERVATIONS AND ACTIONS:

I arrived on scene and saw Deputy Martinez #1472 holding the suspect John Walters arms over his head. Walters was kicking and fighting with Deputy Martinez. When attempting to place the chord cuff around Walters ankle. He repeatedly kicked and thrashed around preventing me from placing the chord cuff. Fearing that Walters would kick Deputy Martinez and I. I placed Walters left leg behind his right knee and applied pressure preventing Walters from kicking us further.

After securing is legs, Walters agreed to be somewhat compliant and agreed to relax so I could place the chord cuffs around his ankles. I secured to the chord cuff temporally to his belt loop. Deputy Kastelic #6333 arrived and held Walters legs while i grabbed a second chord cuff from Deputy Martinez's car and placed it around his waist and secured it to his ankle chord cuff.

Deputy Martinez had a waist chains on the rear of his vehicle. I placed the waist chains around Walters. Deputy Kastelic and I helped Deputy Martinez place Walter in the waist chain restraints.

Paramedics from the Lakeside Fire Department arrived; Deputy Kastelic and I assisted them into placing Walters onto a gurney. During the entirety of my involvement in the incident, Walters behaved violently, actively and aggressively resisted law enforcement, and did not obey any commands to calm down or comply with lawful orders. Walters was transported to Grossmont Hospital.
