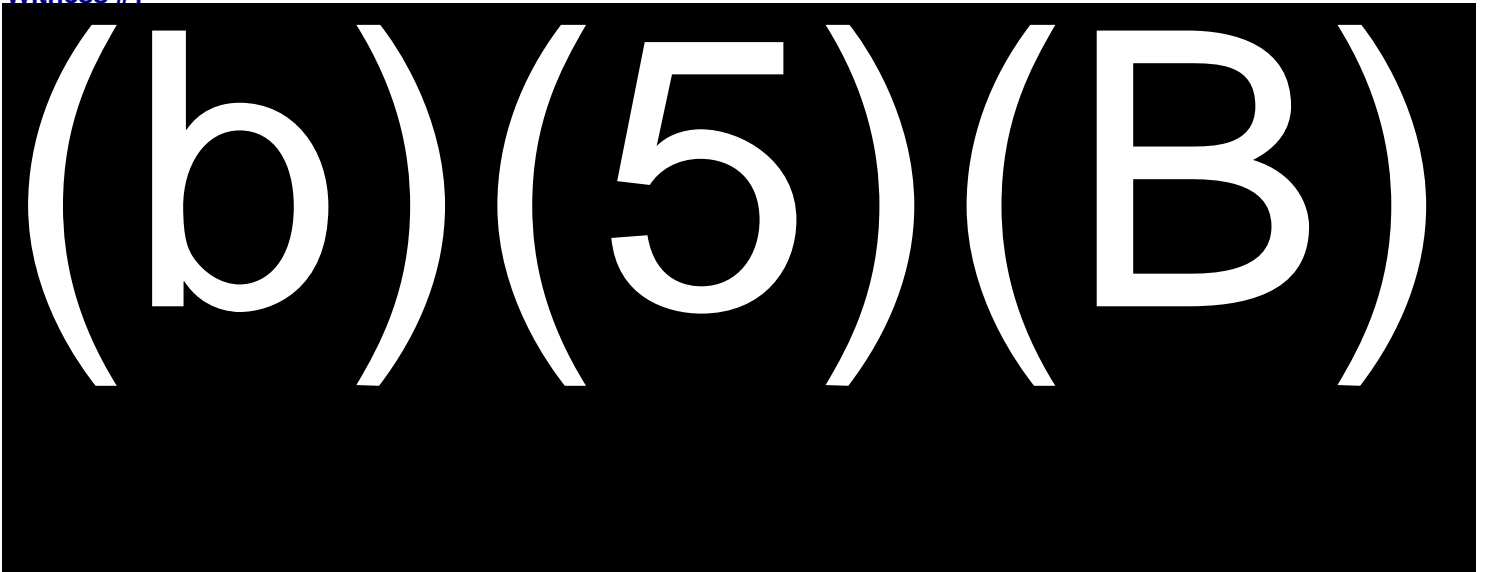

Morgen Johnson was contacted at his residence due to a call regarding screaming and banging coming from inside his home. Johnson became assaultive toward Deputies while being detained. Force was

used to detain Johnson and resulted in a dog bite from K-9 Conti. Deputy Meharg (6962) sustained a 3-4 in scratch on his right inner elbow. Deputy Feistel (4714) sustained a small cut on his right inner wrist.

Johnson was transported by ambulance and treated at Sharp Memorial Hospital for multiple lacerations and contusions to his head, neck, and torso.

## ORIGIN:

On 10/18/12 at 2309 hours, Deputy Meharg (6962) was dispatched to investigate a report of unknown trouble at (b)(5)(A) Lorena Lane in unincorporated El Cajon. Deputy Reed (1670), Deputy Feistel (4714) and his K-9 partner Conti, responded as cover. At 2329 hours a call for "code cover" was requested. I responded with emergency lights and siren to the aforementioned address. (CAD#E344307)

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

See Deputy Feistel, Deputy Meharg, and Deputy Reed's reports.

## INVESTIGATION:

I arrived on scene and approached Deputy Feistel near his car. He was standing with his hands on the roof of the car and looked exhausted. Deputy Fiestel was not wearing his prescription eyeglasses as he normally does. After confirming he was ok, I approached the house. I saw a white male adult, later identified as Johnson, sitting handcuffed on the ground outside of the garage. There was a large amount of blood on the ground by his side, and I could see that his face and hair was bloody. Deputies Meharg and Piland (1113) were speaking with a female, later identified as Johnson's wife, (b)(5)(B)). Deputy Reed was standing watch over Johnson. Medics arrived moments later and began evaluating Johnson's injuries. Deputy Reed took photos of Johnson. Deputies Piland and Meharg entered and cleared the residence. I located Deputy Feistel's eyeglasses on the floor of the garage. The frames of the glasses were bent and damaged.

Deputy Reed and I went inside the house with (b)(5)(B). Deputy Reed went to Johnson's room at the end of the hall and began taking photos. I remained with (b)(5)(B) who provided me with the following statement.

## STATEMENT OF (b)(5)(B) (WITNESS):

(b)(5)(B) is Johnson's wife. She insists Johnson was not yelling or fighting with her and has never laid a hand on her. She is unsure what he was so upset about but thinks it may be regarding finances of his business. Johnson is a (b)(5)(B) and runs his own business, (b)(5)(A), out of his home office. (b)(5)(B) explained she and Johnson sleep in separate rooms because his snoring keeps her awake. Since he was in his own room, she is unsure what exactly was going on.

Johnson got home between 1830 -1900 hours. He seemed frustrated. She said they had a brief disagreement regarding their relationship. He accused her of being "detached and despondent" but it had not escalated into anything serious. Johnson went to his room to work on invoices. (b)(5)(B) noticed Johnson began drinking a bottle of champagne at approximately 2100 hours. She found this to be odd because he is a light drinker. (b)(5)(B) believes he drank the entire bottle. She denied knowledge of any use of any form of drugs stating, "this is an organic household, we eat healthy, we live healthy, we don't do anything like that." (b)(5)(B) went to bed sometime around 2230. Shortley thereafter she began to hear Johnson cursing from his room. The cursing got louder and louder until he was basically screaming. She got up and went to his room and was yelling trying to get his attention. She said "it was as if he didn't even hear me, it was like he was in his own world." She told him to keep it down because she was trying to sleep and she returned to her room. A few minutes later, she began to hear banging and the sounds of things being thrown around in his room. Next she heard Johnson throwing up in the bathroom. (In addition to his outburst, this is why she believes he had too much to drink.) She heard Johnson return to his room and heard him moaning and mumbling to himself. A short time later she heard the knocking on the door. She went out through the garage to greet the Deputies (she explained they'd just sealed the front door to prevent drafts now that it is getting cold). Johnson came outside and approached the Deputies. She heard Johnson make some sort of snide comment then say "We don't need the cops here." She is unsure of what exactly took place next. She remembers seeing Deputies try to put Johnson in handcuffs, then Johnson being taken to the ground. She also remembers hearing a Deputy say something to the effect of "He's got my leg." She saw the Deputies fighting with Johnson and saw him get bitten by the K-9. She again advised Johnson has never caused her any harm. She does not believe she was the cause of whatever had triggered Johnson's episode. All of the property damaged was his own property in his own room.

### INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

(b)(5)(B) pulled her zip-up sweater down off her shoulders to show me she did not have any injuries. Her hair was smooth and straight and she did not show any signs of having been physically assaulted.

I provided (b)(5)(B) with the case number and advised her that Johnson was taken to Sharp Memorial Hospital for treatment of his injuries. Upon release from the hospital, he was to be booked at San Diego Central Jail.

(b)(5)(B) and Johnson had two handguns in the household. In the garage, we located a Glock 19, 9mm pistol. It was found unloaded, in its case, with two empty magazines. In Johnson's bedroom I recovered a Smith and Wesson 357 Magnum revolver. It was also unloaded and zipped up inside a maroon soft case. I confiscated both weapons in accordance with 12028.5 (b) PC for the safety of all parties concerned and I explained the reason to (b)(5)(B). She understood and willingly signed the Confiscation of Weapons Receipt. I provided (b)(5)(B) with her copy and briefly explained the procedure for how to receive the weapons back.

I arrived on scene at about 2321 hours and contacted Deputy Meharg #6962 who was already on scene. Deputy Meharg advised me he could hear someone yelling in the back of the residence and could hear things being thrown around. I could hear from the front of the residence what sounded like items being thrown about the residence. The noise appeared to be coming from the rear bedroom of the residence. The male subject inside of the residence was yelling but I could not make out what was being said. Deputy Meharg was on the side of the residence and heard the subject say, "I don't care if the cops are here." Based on the loud noise coming from inside of the residence and the subjects statement, I believe we had a possible domestic violence incident occurring.

It was unknown on how many subjects were inside of the residence and if anyone was injured. I removed my canine partner "Conti" from my patrol vehicle to have at the scene as a psychological deterrent. Deputy Reed #1670 began knocking on the front door of the residence and shouting Sheriff's department, come to the front door. There was no response. Deputy Reed continued to knock on the front door and announce our presence. Several minutes passed by and Deputy Reed stated he saw a male subject walk into the hallway and then back into a bedroom. From the front of the residence I could see lights going on and off in the back bedroom. Deputy Reed and Deputy Meharg continued to yell Sheriff's department, come to the front door.

A few minutes later Deputy Reed said a female adult was walking down the hallway towards the front door. A few seconds later the garage door began to open. I walked over towards the garage and observed a White female adult standing in the garage. I yelled at the female to walk over to Deputy Reed who was still by the front door of the residence. The female would not walk out of the garage and continued to ask what was going on. Deputy Reed walked over to the female to speak with her

when Deputy Meharg advised the male subject was standing in the kitchen. Deputy Meharg was telling the male subject to come outside. Deputy Meharg advised me the subject was not responding.

As Deputy Reed was speaking with the female to try and determine what was going on inside of the residence, the male subject later identified as Morgen Johnson, walked out of the kitchen and into the garage through the side door. Johnson appeared agitated and began yelling. I shouted at Johnson, "Sheriff's department with a canine," in an attempt to gain his attention and compliance. Johnson was yelling at Deputy Reed stating his wife didn't have to go anywhere and we had no right to be at his residence. Deputy Reed tried to tell Johnson why we were at the residence but Johnson continued to yell at Deputy Reed. I could see Johnson's fists were clenched and he appeared really agitated.

Deputy Meharg then walked into the garage and gave Johnson verbal commands to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Johnson did not comply with Deputy Meharg's verbal commands and refused to turn around. I then observed Deputy Meharg grab Johnson by the arm and spin him towards a cabinet. Deputy Meharg then attempted to place Johnson's hands behind his back. Johnson tried to pull away from Deputy Meharg and began flailing his arms about. Johnson then swung his right elbow backwards towards Deputy Meharg's head. It appeared Johnson was trying to hit Deputy Meharg. Deputy Meharg then forced Johnson to the ground.

Johnson then rolled onto his back and began actively resisting by trying to punch Deputy Meharg. Johnson grabbed a hold of Deputy Meharg's uniform as he continued to try and punch him. Deputy Meharg was unable to gain control of Johnson's arms. Due to Johnson actively fighting with Deputy Meharg, I deployed my canine partner on Johnson in an attempt to gain compliance. My canine partner bit Johnson on the left side of his neck as I gave verbal commands to stop resisting. Johnson did not comply and continued swing his arms at Deputy Meharg. I tried to grab Johnson's arms in an attempt to gain control. Johnson turned onto his right side and grabbed my right leg with his hands. As Johnson grabbed a hold of my leg, my canine partner bit him on his right ear. Johnson then wrapped both of his arms around my lower right leg and began squeezing my leg.

I did not know what Johnson's intentions were but I feared he was going to try and take me down to the ground. I then began giving Johnson verbal commands to let go of my leg. Johnson did not comply. I then began striking Johnson on the left side of back with my flash light in an attempt to gain compliance. Johnson did not comply as I repeatedly told him to let go of my leg and stop resisting. Johnson held my leg tighter and now had his arms wrapped around my thigh. I continued to strike Johnson with my flashlight on the left side of his back as my canine partner bit him on the right side of his back. Johnson did not comply nor did he make any sounds.

I was yelling at Deputy Meharg that Johnson had my leg. Deputy Meharg punched Johnson numerous times on his upper body telling him to let go of my leg. Johnson did not comply. Deputy Meharg also deployed his taser on Johnson but it had no effect on him. Johnson appeared to be impervious to pain as he was making no sounds even though he was being bit by my canine partner, struck with the flashlight and being punched. At this point I feared Johnson would try to take me down to the ground or possibly reach for my duty weapon or taser and try to use one these weapons against me or my partners.

At this point I had struck Johnson with my flashlight anywhere from ten to twenty times and given numerous commands to stop resisting and to let go of my leg. Johnson was still not complying with my commands and still holding onto my leg tightly. Deputy Meharg then kicked Johnson in the head. Johnson loosened his grip on my leg and I was able to pull away from him. I stepped back away from Johnson and pulled my canine partner back with me. Johnson had stopped actively resisting. Deputy Reed and Deputy Meharg were able to gain compliance and place Johnson into handcuffs.

The fire department and paramedics arrived on scene and began treating Johnson for his injuries. Johnson was then transported to Sharp Memorial Hospital for further evaluation.

**REPORT NARRATIVE****Origin:**

On 10/18/12, at about 2310 hours, I responded to an unknown trouble call behind **(b)(5)(B)**. The reporting stated she heard someone yelling and slamming items.

**Deputies Observations and Actions:**

I was the first to arrive on scene and parked west of **(b)(5)(A)** Lorena Ln. I walked towards the address and while about 50 yards from the house, I heard something being slammed inside the house. I waited for Deputy Reed (1670) to arrive and we approached the house. The entire time I heard doors being slammed and other banging noises. I was unable to observe anyone in the front of the house but could tell the noises coming from the back of the house.

Deputy Feistel (4714) arrived on scene with his partner, Canine Conti. Deputies Reed and Feistel stayed at the front of the house while I observed the inside from the side of the house. The noises continued and I could hear a male, later identified as Morgen Johnson **(b)(5)(B)**, yelling at someone, "Fuck you" and other statements which I could not make out. I believed Johnson was possibly assaulting someone inside. Deputy Reed knocked on the front door. I heard Johnson state, "Who called the police? I don't care about the police."

The noise and yelling stopped and the lights at the back of the house were turned off. Deputy Reed continued to knock on the door and state, "Sheriff's Department" but received no answer. I now thought Johnson was possibly arming himself with a weapon or further harming the person he was yelling at. Deputy Reed continued to knock and a female eventually came to the front of the house. I maintained a visual of the inside of the house while Deputies Reed and Feistel contacted the female in the garage.

After about 30 seconds, I observed Johnson walk from the back of the house to the kitchen. Johnson did not acknowledge my presence while telling him to come to the door. He washed his hands, wiped his face with a towel, and blew his nose. I thought he may be washing blood off of himself. He appeared to be in an altered state of mind as he continued ignoring me and just walked around in the kitchen. Johnson eventually came to the door and I went to the garage.

As I got closer to the garage I heard Johnson yelling at Deputy Reed. He said something along the lines of you don't have a right to be here. Deputy Feistel shouted Sheriff's Canine and I told Johnson to turn around. Johnson was standing about one foot into the garage with the door leading into the house partially open. Johnson is about 6'6" tall and has an athletic build, his arms were tensed and both fists were balled up. Johnson refused to comply and said something along the lines of fuck you.

I believed he was either going to assault one of us or run into the house where he could possibly arm himself. He was refusing lawful commands and was verbally combative. I ran at Johnson and grabbed his right arm. I twisted his arm using his wrist and shoulder as leverage to make him face away from me as I pushed him into a wall. Johnson swung his right elbow back at me in an attempt to hit me with his elbow while turning his body to face me.

I held Johnson against the wall with my left arm and punched him in his face two times with my right fist while yelling, "turn around." Johnson grabbed onto my right sleeve with his left hand. I grabbed him around his neck with my right hand and spun him down to the ground. Johnson landed on his back still holding onto my sleeve. I continued punching him in his head with my left fist in an attempt to gain his compliance and have him let go of my shirt.

Johnson let go of my sleeve and I could see his hands reaching up towards my head. He was not complying with commands to turn over and I continued to punch Johnson in his head with both fists. Johnson could have easily punched me and caused an injury to my face or head. Johnson then turned around but was on his hands and knees, not lying on the ground. I heard Deputy Feistel yell, "He's got my leg." I observed Canine Conti contact Johnson on his right side and I stood up so I would not be bit. I began kicking Johnson in his right ribs while yelling, "Let go." Johnson continued to hold onto Deputy Feistel. I used my TASER and tried deploying it in the probe mode but it did not work. I then drive stunned Johnson in his left shoulder in an attempt to get him to let go of Deputy Feistel's Leg. I requested CODE cover from additional units.

Johnson continued holding onto Deputy Feistel. I placed my TASER in my holster. Deputy Feistel continued to yell, "He's got my leg." Johnson was now holding onto Deputy Feistel's thigh and not his lower leg.

The entire time we were attempting to gain compliance from Johnson, he did not make any noise or quiver away from us but continued holding on and actually worked his way up Deputy Feistel's leg. I did not believe he could feel pain and was possibly using a controlled substance. I was getting tired and did not know how much longer we would have to fight Johnson to gain his compliance. I even grabbed onto my pistol thinking I would have to shoot him to prevent him from gaining control of Deputy Feistel's weapons and using one against us.

I delivered several kicks to Johnson's head while yelling, "Let go" and, "Stop resisting." Johnson released his grip from Deputy Feistel's leg and laid on his stomach with his right arm tucked under his chest. Deputy Feistel pulled Canine Conti off of Johnson. I pulled Johnson's arm out from under his chest and handcuffed him with Deputy Reed. The entire incident occurred in the garage.

I requested Paramedics due to Johnson bleeding. Additional units arrived to assist.

Believing a crime was committed inside and someone may possibly be injured, I searched the house for any victims. Inside the hallway between the living room and bedrooms I observed blood spots in several places on the walls. Inside one of the bedrooms I observed several holes in the drywall and numerous items broken and laying on the floor. I did not locate any victims inside the residence. Johnson was attended to by paramedics and transported to Sharps Memorial Hospital.

I went in the Ambulance with Johnson to the Hospital. In the Ambulance, Johnson asked several times, "What happened?" and stated, "I don't recall anything." Johnson also thanked me several times for helping him. He also stated that he never resisted us.

(b)(5)(B) was the Trauma Doctor attending to Johnson. Johnson suffered a fractured right eye orbital, punctured left lung, bruising to his left ribs, dog rakes to his left ribs, a lacerated right ear, two lacerations to his left neck, a broken right hand, and various small scrapes and bruises. Nurse (b)(5)(B) arrived and obtained two blood samples from Johnson. Johnson was admitted into the hospital for treatment and moved into room 415.

During their conversation I heard Johnson ask, "I was TASED?" as well as, "I don't recall anything, I remember coming out to the garage and then being handcuffed." Johnson then said, "Well I'll have to take responsibility for my actions then."

While engaging in casual conversation with Johnson he appeared to be a good person who possibly had a bad day and consumed too much alcohol. I do believe he did not know what he was doing and did not remember what happened. He continually spoke about having to work in the morning and told me how much digging and other work he had to do earlier in the day.

Deputy Rodriguez (3241) relieved me from the hospital.

This completed my actions.

Johnson either did not know I was there or would not acknowledge my presence. The female walked towards Meharg and I walked towards him to contact the female. The female asked us why we were there.

Johnson walked into the garage and told us, "We had no right to be at his house." Meharg walked towards Johnson and asked him to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Johnson refused to comply with Meharg's verbal commands.

Johnson turned away from Meharg and pushed Meharg away. Meharg grabbed Johnson and pushed him to the ground and tried to handcuff him. Feistel stood next to us and he had his K-9 partner, Conti with him.

As Johnson fell to the ground, I saw him attempt to kick Meharg so I used my body weight to control his legs so Meharg would not get assaulted. After a few seconds, Johnson relaxed his legs.

I looked up and I saw Johnson grab one of Feistel's legs. Feistel verbally ordered him to let go and Johnson did not comply. I saw Feistel punching Johnson so he would release his leg. I did not count how many times Feistel punched him. Johnson continued to hold his leg for about one minute.

As Feistel punched him, Conti bit Johnson as well. During this time, I did not hear Johnson make any sounds during the one minute. He did not speak during this time either. I felt Conti's bites and Feistel punches had no effect on Johnson.

Johnson finally released his left arm from Feistel's leg and I grabbed his wrist and I handcuffed it. Meharg and I attempted to grab his right wrist but he put it underneath his body. Meharg and I pulled his right arm out and we handcuffed his right wrist.

After he was handcuffed, Johnson sat up and a small pool of blood on the ground. I looked at his face and head and I saw blood on both. Paramedics arrived on scene a few minutes later and preformed first aid on him. Before the paramedics arrived, I photograph Johnson and the ground near him.

As Johnson was being treated by paramedics, I heard him say, "I did not know a dog bit me. I did not feel any pain. "I grabbed my digital camera and I photographed Johnson and the ground near him showing the blood on the ground.

I walked into the residence to conduct a welfare check/safety sweep for any injured persons or evidence of a crime. I walked into a rear bedroom and I saw numerous holes on the wall of this bedroom.

I had my digital camera with me and I photographed the interior of this room showing the damage to the walls. I walked outside the room and I saw what I believed to be blood stains on the wall. I photographed the stains also.

I left the Lorena address and I drove to (b)(5)(B) to contact to reporting party. I arrived on scene and I contacted (b)(5)(B). She gave me the following response.

## STATEMENTS:

Statement of (b)(5)(B) (Reporting Party) >

(b)(5)(B) was inside her residence and she was watching television. It was just after 2300 hours and she had a rear window open. She heard some loud yelling coming from the neighbor behind her residence.

Her dog began barking loudly so this concerned her. She heard the male whom she knows as Morgen yelling fuck numerous times. She heard noises like he was hitting something or someone.

(b)(5)(B) heard a female scream and she felt by the tone of the scream, the female sounded frighten. She felt the female and male were having an argument or something more serious. She feared for the female safety so she dialed "911."

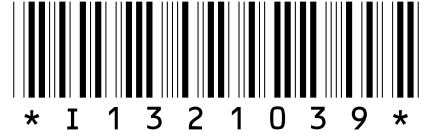

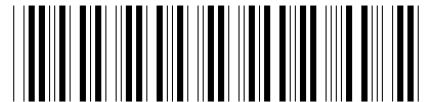



Check "Hospitalized" if subject was admitted to the Hospital as a result of injuries that were sustained as a result of force applied by officer(s).

**Officer Injured:** Check appropriate box (see above).

Specifically, check "Treated at Scene" if officer was treated at scene by EMS for injuries. Check "Treated at Hospital" if officer was transported to hospital for treatment of injuries. **Other Force Used/Comments/Equipment Performance:** This section can be used to document other force options not listed on the form; relevant comments about the incident such as complaints of pain/injury (room permitting) and negative/positive comments regarding equipment performance.

**Mark Figure to Indicate Contact Points:** When applicable, mark the areas on the figure where applied force contacted the subject's body.
