Origin:

On 05-08-13, I was assigned as the House 1 Rover Deputy at the George Bailey Detention Facility (GBDF). At approximately 1143 hours, I was conducting a security check in "C" Module, when inmate Bryan Helm BKN 13710251 exited Quad #209 stating he was feeling homicidal and suicidal.

Background:

Helm has multiple Inmate Status Reports (ISR's) for placement into a Safety Cell due to suicidal thoughts from multiple incarcerations dating back to 2010. Helm is currently sentenced to 3 years and is awaiting transport to Patton State Hospital.

Deputy's Observations and Actions:

Helm hastily went down the stairs and sat down at a table in the "C" Module Dayroom. I instructed Helm to walk to and face the wall to his left as I was walked down the stairs. Helm stood up and walked to the wall stating, "Don't fuck with me. I'm homicidal. I'll kill you!" I immediately placed handcuffs on Helm for my safety because of Helm's statement. Once secured in handcuffs, Helm began pulling away from me, attempting to leave the module. I instructed Helm to not pull away from me. Helm continued to yell stating that the inmates in Quad #209 did not know who they were messing with. I asked Helm why he was feeling suicidal and homicidal. Helm stated he was over being in the world and would kill the next person he saw. I deemed it necessary to place Helm into a Safety Cell due to his homicidal intentions. I escorted Helm near the House 1 Entry and awaited an additional deputy to help me escort Helm into a Safety Cell.

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Deputy Hall #4738 arrived to help me escort Helm. While escorting Helm down the House 1 Corridor, Helm pulled away from me several times. I instructed Helm not to pull away from me. Helm got visibly more upset, yelling obscenities, clenching his fists and tensing his muscles. Helm then suddenly pivoted his upper body to his right and quickly cocked his head back as if to head butt me. Helm's proximity to my head was close enough to where he would have made contact with my temple. In order to prevent Helm from head butting me, I wrapped my left arm around Helm's head and utilized his momentum to tackle him to the ground. Helm landed on the ground, face down. I landed with my body positioned on top of Helm's back. Once on the ground, Helm began yelling, "I'm going to 187 (187 PC-homicide) on cops!" Although he was shouting, Helm's offered no physical resistance after he was tackled. I maintained my position on Helm's back to prevent him from getting up.

A medical gurney was called to transport Helm to GBDF Medical for evaluation and treatment. When the gurney arrived, I released my hold on Helm. At this time, a spit mask was placed over Helm's head to prevent him from spitting on any staff members. Once in medical, Doctor bserved Helm and deemed it necessary for him to be transported to the University California San Diego (UCSD) Medical Center for sutures to the forehead of Helm's face. I had no further contact with Helm.

I felt pain in my left elbow following the incident. I went the US Healthworks occupational medical clinic in Kearney Mesa for evaluation and treatment of my left elbow. An X-ray was taken and examined by Doctor I was cleared to return to work with no restrictions.

On 05-09-13, Deputy Velasquez #5384 took digital photographs of Helm's injuries while at UCSD Medical Center.

Force Used:

I wrapped my left arm around Helm's head and utilized Helm's momentum to tackle him to the ground.

Injuries:

Helm sustained a laceration to the mid-section of his forehead. Helm was taken to UCSD Medical Center for sutures.

I was treated at US Healworks occupational medical clinic for pain to my left elbow.

Use of Force Supplemental Instructions

Lines 1 & 3: Fill in the blanks.

<u>Line 2</u>: If the suspect was committing a crime and force was used to stop or apprehend the subject, document the appropriate penal code. Primary Reason for Using Force: Check appropriate box(s).

Subject Appeared To Be: Check if applicable.

Number of Officers on Scene: List number of officers present.

Number of Officers Using Force: List number of officers that used force.

<u>Level(s) of Resistance Encountered</u>: Check appropriate box(s).

REPORT NARRATIVE

ORIGIN:

On 05-08-13 at approximately 1155 hours, I was assigned as the House 1 Rover at the George Bailey Detention Facility (GBDF), as Corporal Alvarado #7311 and I were escorting inmate Helm, Bryan BN 13710251, I witnessed the following use of force.

DEPUTY'S OBSERVATIONS AND ACTIONS:

As Corporal Alvarado and I were escorting Helm down the House 1 Corridor Hallway, I witnessed Corporal Alvarado holding Helm by the handcuffs on his wrists. Helm was yelling incoherently. I witnessed Corporal Alvarado tell Helm to not pull away from him. Helm did not comply and appeared to keep pulling away. Corporal Alvarado quickly took Helm to the ground, stomach first. Corporal Alvarado landed on top of Helm. While Helm was lying on his stomach, I saw blood that came from what appeared to be a possible head injury. A medical gurney arrived to transport Helm to the medical area of the facility for treatment. I had no further contact or observation of Helm.
