I gave each victim a business card and explained the process for qualifying when they are released back to full duty.

During this incident I did not take any statements from any Deputies or witnesses.

Origin:

On Friday, August 4, 2017, at 0825 hours, I received a telephone call from Homicide Detective Sergeant T. Norton #2333. He requested I respond to an Officer Involved Shooting at (b)(5)(A) Second Avenue in the city of San Diego. Sergeant Norton stated Deputies were involved in the shooting in San Diego Police Department (SDPD) jurisdiction. I was assigned to act as a liaison between SDPD and the Sheriff's Department for purposes of the investigation.

Investigation:

On Friday, August 4, 2017, at 0912 hours, I arrived at the scene. I spoke with Lieutenant M. Rand of the Court Services Division. He stated two Deputies with the Court Service Field Division were involved in a shooting while serving an eviction. He provided me with Eviction #37-2017-000-18604. The target of the eviction was James Lacy (b)(5)(A). According to Sheriff's dispatch, Deputies arrived (10-97) at the location at 0739 hours, stated they were contacting the suspect (11-51) at 0747 hours and broadcast shots fired at 0748 hours.

On Friday, August 4, 2017, at 0925 hours, I attended a briefing provided by SDPD Sergeant Minter #6052. For details of the briefing, refer to SDPD Homicide reports. During the briefing, I learned Deputy S. Ochoa #1193 and Deputy D. Wood #7730 were involved in the shooting at (b)(5)(A) Second Avenue. The suspect, James Lacy, produced a firearm as Deputies entered the residence and was shot by Deputies. He was pronounced deceased at the hospital at 0937 hours. Sergeant D. Malinowski was assigned at the lead for the shooting investigation. The briefing concluded at 0948 hours.

On Friday, August 4, 2017, at 1035 hours, I received a packet of paperwork from the eviction at the location from Sergeant J. Golembiewski. He had received the paperwork moments before from Court Field Services Deputy M. Stacy. At 1037 hours, I provided the paperwork to Sergeant Malinowski.

On 08/04/17, at approximately 0748 hours, I was monitoring Court Services Dispatch when I overheard a radio transmission from a court services field unit (15A5), advising "shots fired" **(b)(5)(A)** 2nd Avenue in the city of San Diego. (SDSD CAD-E4334106)

DEPUTIES OBSERVATIONS AND ACTIONS:

While monitoring the radio, I overheard Deputy Don Wood (7730), whom I recognized by voice, ask for a cover unit. Utilizing Sheriff's CAD, I looked up the radio call he was on and discovered he was doing an eviction at **(b)(5)(A)** 2nd Avenue in the city of San Diego. As I was reviewing the call on the computer, I heard Deputy Wood advise, "Shots fired." I left my office and drove to the command post which had been established by the San Diego Police Department in front of the address. Upon arrival, I observed Deputy Wood who was with Deputy Bryan (4866). I also observed Deputy Ochoa (1193) who was with Deputy Stacy (4095). While speaking with Deputy Stacy, I learned that both Deputy Wood and Deputy Ochoa had fired their duty weapons and had already provided a safety statement to an on-scene SDPD Sergeant, Sergeant Minter. Deputy Wood and Deputy Ochoa were kept separate from each other and then driven, individually, to the Court Services Field office located at 220 West Broadway in San Diego. I then met with SDPD Lieutenant Holden.

Lieutenant Holden advised me that since the incident occurred in their jurisdiction, SDPD would handle the investigation. He also advised that he had already notified their homicide team. At that point, I made notifications to Court Services Command, peer support, and the Division of Inspectional Services (DIS). I remained on scene and attended the SDPD homicide briefing at about 0930 hours. After the briefing, Lieutenant Holden advised me that I was no longer needed at the scene. I then left the scene, leaving Sergeant J. Golembiewski (5651) as the Sheriff's Department Liaison.

This ended my investigation of this incident.

INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE

Decedent: LACY, James

Antemortem Events:

On 08/04/2017, the following preliminary information was learned during a personal interview conducted at the scene with Officer Dungan ID 6137, San Diego Police Department. On the morning hours of 08/04/2017, San Diego Sheriff Department Court Service Deputies arrived to the decedent, James Lacy's, house to serve him an eviction notice. Deputies knocked on the door and the decedent stated to them "go away or I'll shoot you." The deputies informed him that they were unable to leave. The decedent refused to open the door and deputies forced entry into the home. Upon entering, the decedent brandished what reportedly appeared to be a firearm and deputies fired their weapons toward him. Paramedics were summoned to the scene, and the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) was called for backup. SDPD arrived to the scene at 0756 hours. The decedent was transported to Scripps Mercy Hospital, where he was taken into the operating room for surgery.

On 08/04/2017, the following preliminary information was learned during a telephone interview conducted with Detective Yancovich, San Diego Police Department. The San Diego Sheriff Department Court Service Deputies that responded to the decedent's residence on 08/04/2017 at 0743 hours were deputies S. Ochoa ID 1193 and D. Wood ID 7730. The deputies forced entry into the home by pulling open the decedent's security screen door. Upon entering, the decedent brandished a Daisy BB gun, and at 0748 hours, deputies each fired a 40 caliber Glock 22 toward him. SDPD arrived to the scene at 0756 hours.

On 08/04/2017, the following preliminary information was learned during a telephone interview conducted with Detective Sanchez, SDPD. At 0753 hours, SDPD received a call from the San Diego Sheriff's Department requesting assistance and stating that shots had been fired at (b)(5)(B) 2nd Avenue in San Diego. SDPD and paramedics were dispatched to the location. At 0756 hours, Officers Larson ID 7347, Castillo ID 7156, Ponce ID 6859, Ohlwiler ID 6657, and Nills ID 7643 were first to arrive on scene. San Diego Paramedic 26 and San Diego Fire Engine 3 arrived on scene, and transported the decedent to Scripps Mercy Hospital.

On 08/04/2017, the following information was learned through a personal interview conducted at the scene with medical staff from Scripps Mercy Hospital and supplemented with medical records. On 08/04/2017 at 0817 hours, the decedent arrived to the emergency department pulseless, with cardiopulmonary resuscitation in progress by paramedics. Pulses were lost en route to the hospital. He arrived with a Glasgow Coma Scale score of three, and he was given the trauma name D1298-17 Trauma. He had a needle thoracotomy to the right aspect of the chest, and was intubated. At 0840 hours, his aorta was clamped. At 0902 hours, he arrived to the operating room for bilateral thoracotomies. At 0925 hours, he went into cardiac arrest. Despite lifesaving efforts, he was unable to be revived, and his death was pronounced at 0937 hours. His right lung, which was removed from his body, had a perforating wound.

The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office was informed of the death at 1041 hours, and jurisdiction was invoked.

Past Medical, Surgical, and Social History:

The following information was learned during a telephone interview with the decedent's brother (b)(5)(B). The decedent took medications for unknown mental health diagnoses. The decedent was thought to have possibly been diagnosed with bipolar disorder. The family has a history of heart murmurs. It was unknown if the decedent used illicit drugs, and he drank socially.

Scene Description:

At approximately 1132 hours on 08/04/2017, I arrived to the scene, which was Operating Room 6 in Scripps Mercy Hospital, located at 4077 Fifth Avenue in San Diego. The room was a standard operating room, furnished with medical equipment.

The incident scene given was (b)(5)(B) 2nd Avenue in San Diego. I did not view the incident scene.

Body Description:

On 08/04/2017, I viewed the body of an adult Black male, covered with blue medical blankets, lying supine on a hospital gurney. I removed the blankets to continue my investigation. He was lying on top of blankets, which were soiled with blood. He was flaccid and cool to the touch. Both arms were extended and perpendicular to his body. His legs were extended and in line with his torso. He was clad in plaid boxer shorts, which were soiled with blood and had been cut away by medical personnel. Medical therapy observed in place included a heart monitor on his left ear, an endotracheal tube, two identification bands around his right wrist, an intravenous line in the palmar aspect of his right wrist, an intravenous line in his right antecubital fossa, a support splint board taped to his right hand and wrist, a blood pressure sleeve on his left arm, a heart monitor on his left middle finger, EKG leads, a left femoral line, urinary catheter, and a right intraosseous tibial catheter. Lividity was unable to be assessed due to his skin tone.

There was no crepitus upon palpation of his head or neck. There was coagulated blood on the left side of his mandible. There was a defect observed near the midline of his chest. There was what appeared to be an abrasion located near the defect. There was a freshly sutured surgical incision extending across his abdomen right below his chest area. A defect was observed on the midline of his abdomen and also on the right flank aspect of his body. There were defects located both on the palmar and dorsal aspects of the decedent's left wrist. The remainder of the upper extremities appeared unremarkable. The lower extremities appeared unremarkable. The posterior aspect of his body was only partially able to be observed due to the decedent's weight.

92M Transport personnel, (b)(5)(B) arrived and assisted me with the body. A yellow identification band was placed around his right ankle. At 1227 hours, a paper bag was placed around his right hand, and at 1228 hours one was placed around his left hand. At 1229 hours, a paper bag was placed around his left foot, and at 1230 hours one was placed around his right foot. At 1237 hours, a paper bag was placed around his head. He was placed into a new white vinyl body pouch for transport. His right lung, which had been removed during surgery, was placed into a bag and placed into the body pouch with the decedent. Defibrillator pads, which were initially attached to the decedent during medical workup and removed for surgery, were also placed into the pouch with the decedent. Red tamperproof seal 2390185 was affixed to the pouch, and he was transported to the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office for an examination.

He was identified to me by San Diego Police Officer Dungan ID 6137. I confirmed his identification by comparing his physical characteristics to his San Diego County Jail booking photograph.

Antemortem Specimens:

Three vials of antemortem specimens were collected.

Public Administrator:

This case was not referred to the Public Administrator's Office.

Other Important Factors:

The decedent's right lung was removed during surgery. It was placed into a bag, which was put into the vinyl body pouch with the decedent.

AUTOPSY SUMMARY:

- I. Multiple gunshot wounds:
 - A. Gunshot wound of the chest:
 1. Entrance wound (GSW #1): right upper chest with no surrounding soot or stippling.
 2. Exit wound: no exit.
 3. Path: through the anterior chest wall, right lung, lateral chest wall.
 4. Injuries: lacerations of the right lung with right hemothorax, status post excision of part of the right lung.
 5. Trajectory: left-to-right, back-to-front and downward.
 6. Projectile: a deformed, partially jacketed, mushroomed projectile is recovered from the fat of the back; photographed and submitted as evidence to SDPD.
 - B. Gunshot wound of abdomen:
 1. Entrance wound (GSW #2): on the left upper abdominal quadrant just right of the anterior midline, no soot or stippling noted.
 2. Exit wound (GSW #3): on the right side, on the anterior axillary line.
 3. Path: through the fat of the anterior abdominal wall with no penetration of the abdominal cavity.
 4. Injuries: no significant injuries.
 5. Trajectory: left-to-right, front-to-back and downward.

6. Projectile: the wound is through-and-through and no projectile is recovered during autopsy.
 - C. Gunshot wound of the left wrist:
 1. Entrance wound (GSW #5): on the posterior surface of the distal forearm, no surrounding soot or stippling.
 2. Exit wound (GSW #6): on the anterior surface of the distal left forearm, left of the extremity midline.
 3. Path: through the bones of the radius and ulna.
 4. Injuries: fracture of both distal radius and ulna.
 5. Trajectory: straight, back-to-front and right-to-left.
 6. Projectile: two small fragments are noted on radiographs, the largest fragment is recovered. The other fragment is too small to be of any evidentiary value; not recovered and.
 - D. Gunshot wound of left upper chest:
 1. GSW #4 is a graze wound on the left upper chest with no significant associated injuries. No soot or stippling noted.
- II. Other findings:
- A. No non-firearm injuries.
 - B. Hypertrophic cardiomyopathy.
 1. Markedly enlarged heart with hypertrophic ventricles, 530 grams.
 - C. Fatty change of liver.
 - D. No other significant natural disease noted.
- III. Toxicology pending.
- A. Methamphetamine 0.72 mg/L and amphetamine 0.03 mg/L.
 - B. No alcohol or other screened illicit drugs of abuse detected.

OPINION: According to the Investigator's Report, on the morning of 8/4/2017, sheriff deputies arrived at the residence of this 47-year-old Black male to serve him an eviction notice. The decedent stated that he was going to shoot the deputies if they did not leave the residence. Deputies forced entry into the home and the decedent picked up what appeared to be a firearm. Deputies opened fire, striking the decedent. He was transported to the hospital, where he underwent emergency resuscitation and bilateral thoracotomies. During the procedure, he suffered cardiac arrest and was pronounced dead at 0937 hours.

The autopsy revealed multiple gunshot wounds (six gunshot wounds, consistent with three gunshots). The gunshot wounds (GSW) were labeled 1 – 6 and the gunshots (GS) were labeled A, B, and C. Gunshot A (GS A) was a penetrating wound noted to the right upper chest, with entrance wound GSW #1. The projectile trajectory was left-to-right, front-to-

back and downward. It was associated with fracture of multiple ribs, laceration of the right lung, and right hemothorax. A projectile was recovered from the right back; photographed and retained as evidence by SDPD. Gunshot B (GS B) was perforating wound to the abdomen with the entrance wound (GSW #2) on the right upper abdominal quadrant and exit (GSW #3) on the right side. The projectile passed through the anterior abdominal wall with no perforation of the abdominal cavity. The projectile trajectory was left-to-right, front-to-back and downward. No projectile was recovered. Gunshot C (GS C) was perforating to the left distal forearm, with entrance wound on the posterior surface (GSW #5) and exit wound on the anterior surface of the wrist (GSW #6), with straight, back-to-front and right-to-left trajectory. The projectile fractured the distal radius and ulna. A small fragment of lead core was recovered and submitted as evidence. GS D was a graze wound (GSW #4) noted on the right upper chest with no associated significant injuries. Sutured surgical incision, bilateral thoracotomy, was noted. Internal examination revealed partial transection of the right lung. The resected part was submitted separately. Multiple rib fractures were noted on the right side, ribs # 2 and 3 anterior and ribs # 5 and 6 posterior lateral. Examination of the major body organs revealed an enlarged heart, and fatty change of liver. No other significant non-traumatic focal lesions or significant natural disease noted.

Microscopic examination of sections of the major organs revealed no contributory pathology to cause of death. Sections of the heart revealed diffuse hypertrophic changes, focal myocardial scarring, and interstitial and perivascular fibrosis. Sections of the lungs revealed pulmonary congestion and no significant pathology. The liver revealed mild-to-moderate diffuse micro and macrovesicular steatosis, fatty change, and no interlobular fibrosis. The kidneys revealed focal arteriosclerosis suggestive of early hypertensive changes. Toxicological testing was positive for methamphetamine and its active metabolite amphetamine.

Based on the autopsy findings and the circumstances surrounding the death, as currently understood, the cause of death is gunshot wound of the chest, and the manner of death is homicide. The decedent was shot by law enforcement officers.

CLOTHING: The body is clad in dark plaid boxers. It was reported that the decedent was also wearing a blue shirt, retained at the scene.

EVIDENCE OF MEDICAL THERAPY: Endotracheal tube, sutured bilateral thoracotomy incision, central and intravenous access lines, intraosseous access line and urinary catheter are noted. There is a blood pressure cuff on the left arm and oximeter on the middle finger of the left hand.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION

The body is that of a normally developed and well-nourished Black male appearing consistent with the listed age of 47 years. The length is 68 inches, and the weight is 242 pounds, with body mass index of 36.8. The body is well preserved, cold, and has not been embalmed. Rigidity is fully developed in the jaw and extremities. Lividity is nonblanching on the back, limited by dark skin pigmentation. Brown paper bags secured with duct tape are noted over the head, the hands, and feet; retained as evidence by SDPD.

The head is normocephalic and the scalp is covered with very short black hair. The facial hair is stubble beard and moustache. The ears are normally formed and without drainage. The earlobes are not pierced. The irides are brown, the corneas opaque, and the bulbar and palpebral conjunctivae free of petechiae. The sclerae are white. The nose is intact, and the nares are clean and unobstructed. The lips are normally formed. The teeth are natural and in good condition. The neck is without injuries or deformities.

The chest is normally formed and symmetrical, with multiple gunshot wounds on the upper chest. There is sutured bilateral thoracotomy surgical incision on the midchest.

The abdomen is slightly protuberant and soft, with two gunshot wounds. No masses are palpable. The external genitalia are those of an uncircumcised adult male with both testes palpable in the scrotum. The back is straight and symmetrical with no trauma or defects. The anus is atraumatic.

The upper extremities are normally formed. No needle punctures, track marks, or ventral wrist scars are noted. The fingernails are unremarkable. There is a perforating gunshot wound of the distal left forearm. The lower extremities are normally formed and have no edema, amputations, or deformity. The toenails are unremarkable.

BODY MARKINGS (SCARS AND TATTOOS): No tattoos or major surgical scars noted. Two well-healed round scars are noted on the upper abdominal wall.

EVIDENCE OF INJURY

Multiple gunshot wounds (GSW) are noted, labeled #1-6, consistent with 4 gunshots (GS) labelled A-D. The numbers and letters are for documentation only and not intended to indicate sequence of fire or clinical significance. The trajectory is documented in the standard anatomic position and does not take into account the actual position of the victim or suspect.

MUTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS:

- A. Gunshot wound of the chest (GS A):
 - 1. Entrance wound (GSW #1): on the right upper chest, 13 inches from the top of the head and 1-1/2 inches right of the anterior midline. The wound measures 5/8 x 3/8 inch in its largest dimension and surrounded with symmetric abrasion rim. No surrounding soot or stippling noted.
 - 2. Exit wound: no exit wound noted.
 - 3. Path: the projectile passed through the anterior chest wall, right lung, and lateral chest wall.
 - 4. Injuries: fracture of right ribs #2 and 3 anteriorly, lacerations of the right lung with right, status post partial resection and right hemothorax, and fractures of right ribs #5 and 6 laterally.
 - 5. Trajectory: left-to-right, back-to-front and downward.
 - 6. Projectile: a deformed, partially jacketed, mushroomed projectile is recovered from the fat of the right side/back; photographed and submitted as evidence to SDPD.
- B. Gunshot wound of the abdomen (GS B):
 - 1. Entrance wound (GSW #2): on the upper left abdominal quadrant, 23 inches

- from the top of the head and 1 inch left of the anterior midline. It measures 3/4 inch with surrounding asymmetric abrasion-laceration measuring 1-1/2 x 1 inch in its largest dimensions, opposite the 2 o'clock position. No soot or stippling noted.
2. Exit wound (GSW #3): on the right side of abdomen, along the anterior axillary line, 25 inches from the top of the head and 10-1/2 inches right of anterior midline. It measures 3/4 x 1/2 inch in its largest dimensions.
 3. Path: through the fat of the anterior abdominal wall with no penetration of the abdominal cavity.
 4. Injuries: no associated significant injuries noted.
 5. Trajectory: left-to-right, front-to-back and downward.
 6. Projectile: the wound is through-and-through and no projectile is recovered during autopsy.
- C. Gunshot wound of the left wrist (GS C):
1. Entrance wound (GSW #5): on the posterior surface of the distal forearm, on the midline of the extremity, 1/2 inch above the wrist, measuring 3/8 inch in diameter with a surrounding thin abrasion rim. No soot or stippling noted on the surrounding skin.
 2. Exit wound (GSW #6): on the anterior surface of the distal left forearm, 1/2 inch above the wrist, and 3/4 inch left of the midline of the extremity.
 3. Path: through the bones and soft tissue of the distal forearm.
 4. Injuries: fracture of both distal radius and ulna and soft tissue injuries.
 5. Trajectory: straight, back-to-front and right-to-left.
 6. Projectile: two small fragments are noted on radiographs, the largest fragment is recovered. The other smaller fragment, too small to be of any evidentiary value, was not recovered.
- D. Gunshot wound of the left chest (GS D):
1. GSW #4 is a graze wound on the left upper chest with no significant associated injuries. No soot or stippling noted.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION

INITIAL INCISION: The body cavities are entered through the standard coronal incision and the standard Y-shaped incision.

BODY CAVITIES: See "Evidence of Injury." The abdominal fat layer measures up to 8 cm in thickness. There is bilateral thoracotomy and blood is noted in both chest cavities, more on the right. The hemothorax cannot be definitively quantified due to surgical intervention. Part of the right lung is surgically absent. The serosal surfaces are smooth, glistening, and without adhesions. The organs are normally located. The diaphragm is intact.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM: The pericardium is thin and smooth. Within the

pericardial sac, there is no blood or excessive fluid. The heart weighs 530 grams and is enlarged. It has a normal shape with a smooth, glistening epicardium. The coronary arteries have a normal origin and distribution with right dominance. The coronary have no atherosclerotic changes and are widely patent.

The chambers are normally developed and are without mural thrombosis. The myocardium is red-brown, firm, and uniform without focal fibrosis, softening, or hyperemia. The ventricles are hypertrophied, and there is no dilatation. The right ventricle, left ventricle, and interventricular septum measure 0.7 cm, 2.5 cm, and 2.5 cm, respectively.

The endocardium is intact, smooth, and glistening. The cardiac valve leaflets are of normal number, pliable, intact, and free of vegetations. The tricuspid, pulmonic, mitral and aortic valves measure 12 cm, 7 cm, 10 cm, and 7 cm, respectively. The atrial and ventricular septa are free of defects. There is no abnormality of the apices of the papillary musculature.

The great vessels enter and leave in a normal fashion. The aorta follows its usual course and has minimal atherosclerotic changes. There are no vascular anomalies or aneurysms. The vena cavae and pulmonary arteries are without thrombus or embolus.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM: See "Evidence of Injury." The right and left lungs weigh 410 and 270 grams, respectively, and have the usual lobation. The pleura are smooth and glistening; the lungs have small anthracotic pigments. The lungs are atelectatic and non-crepitant. The parenchyma is dark red and exudes moderate amounts of fluid. The lungs have no consolidation, infarct, tumor, gross fibrosis, or enlargement of airspaces. The bronchi contain no foreign material and have unremarkable mucosa. The hilar lymph nodes are not enlarged. The right lung reveals evidence of surgical resection of part of the right upper and middle lobes. The resected parts are submitted separately in a plastic container.

HEPATOBIILIARY SYSTEM: The liver weighs 2100 grams, is of average size. The intact capsule is smooth and glistening. The parenchyma is red-brown and uniform without mass, hemorrhage, yellow discoloration, or palpable fibrosis. The gallbladder contains dark green bile and no stones. Its mucosa is uniform and the wall is not thickened.

The pancreas has a normal size, shape, and lobulated structure. The parenchyma is pink-tan, firm, and uniform. The pancreatic ducts are not ectatic, and there is no parenchymal calcification.

HEMOLYMPHATIC SYSTEM: The spleen weighs 130 grams. The capsule is smooth and intact. The parenchyma is maroon, firm, and uniform. There is no enlargement of the

lymph nodes in the neck, chest, or abdomen.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM: The thyroid gland is not enlarged, and the lobes are symmetrical. The parenchyma is uniform, firm, and red-brown. The parathyroid glands are not identified. The adrenal glands have the usual size and shape. The cortices are thin, uniform, and yellow, and there is no hemorrhage or tumor. The pituitary gland is not enlarged and is unremarkable.

GASTROINTESTINAL SYSTEM: The esophagus and gastroesophageal junction are unremarkable. The stomach is not distended. The stomach contains approximately 200 ml of tan paste of digested and undigested food. The gastric and duodenal mucosae are intact and unremarkable. The small and large intestines are unremarkable to inspection and palpation and sectioning. The appendix is present and is unremarkable.

GENITOURINARY SYSTEM: The right and left kidneys weigh 160 and 160 grams, respectively, and have a normal shape and position. The cortical surfaces are smooth. The kidneys have the usual corticomedullary structure without tumors or cysts. The pelves and ureters are not dilated or thickened. The bladder contains no urine. The mucosa is intact, and the bladder wall is not hypertrophied.

The prostate gland is of average size and grossly unremarkable. The testes are without hemorrhage or tumor.

NECK: The tongue, strap muscles, and other anterior neck soft tissues have no hemorrhage. The hyoid bone and the cartilaginous structures of the larynx and trachea are normally formed and without fracture. The airway is unobstructed, lined by smooth, pink-tan mucosa, and contains no foreign material. The cervical vertebrae have no displacement, hypermobility, or crepitus.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM: See "Evidence of Injury." The musculoskeletal system is well developed and free of deformity. There are no fractures of the clavicles, sternum, vertebrae, or pelvis. The ribs are not brittle. The skeletal muscle is dark red and firm. There are fractures of the anterior ribs #2 and 3, ribs #5 and 6, posterolateral.

CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM: The scalp is free of hemorrhage. The calvarium and base of the skull are normally configured and have no fractures. The dura is intact, and there is no epidural, subdural or subarachnoid hemorrhage.

The unfixed brain weighs 1210 grams. The leptomeninges are glistening, thin and transparent without underlying hemorrhage, exudate, or cortical contusions. The hemispheres are symmetrical and have a normal gyral pattern. There is no flattening of the gyri, narrowing of the sulci, midline shift, or evidence of herniation. The arteries at the

base of brain have no significant atherosclerotic changes or aneurysms.

Sections through the cerebral hemispheres have a uniform, intact cortical ribbon and uniform white matter. Anatomic landmarks are preserved, symmetrical and without focal change. The ventricles are not enlarged without dilation or distortion, and the linings are smooth and glistening. The pons, medulla, and cerebellum are unremarkable, without focal lesions. There is no evidence of uncal or cerebral herniation.

SPECIMENS RETAINED

TOXICOLOGY: Samples of central and peripheral blood, vitreous humor, liver and gastric contents are retained for toxicology. Toxicology testing is positive for methamphetamine and amphetamine.

HISTOLOGY: Representative sections from the major organs are preserved in one storage jar in 10% formalin. Representative sections of major organs submitted for histology in 4 cassettes labelled: #1 Liver and Kidney, #2 Lungs, and #3 and 4 Heart.

PHOTOGRAPHS: Digital identification photographs are obtained. Selected photographs are obtained during autopsy for documentation.

RADIOGRAPHS: Head, neck, and chest radiographs are obtained.

MICROSCOPIC EXAMINATION

HEART: Diffuse hypertrophic changes with focal myocardial scarring, and interstitial and perivascular fibrosis.

LUNG: Congestion and postmortem artifacts.

LIVER: Mild-to-moderate diffuse micro and macrovesicular steatosis and no interlobular fibrosis or significant inflammation.

KIDNEY: Focal arteriolosclerosis possibly early hypertensive changes.

I contacted Sheriff's Communications to request Peer Support to be enroute the San Diego Court Services Field Office to meet with deputies involved in the shooting. At 0829 hours, Sergeant Garrett went to the San Diego Court Services Field Office to be the point of contact for the deputies involved.

While on scene, I assisted with supplying information needed to/from San Diego police, as well as assisted with any issues that arose. At 0840 hours, Sergeant Lacroix arrived on scene. At 0930 hours, San Diego Police Homicide conducted their case briefing. Sergeant Golembiewski arrived on scene at 0930 hours.

San Diego Police Homicide requested the deputies involved in the shooting to obtain a separate set of clothing for after their evidence processing. San Diego Police Homicide requested Deputies Wilm and Baquiran, who were at Scripps Mercy Hospital, to respond to the scene to be interviewed. Sergeant Golembiewski notified the deputies to respond.

At 1026 hours, Lieutenant Rand and I left the scene to go to the San Diego Court Services Field Office. I emailed the Sheriff's staff, who had been at the scene, to complete a deputy's report to document their involvement.
