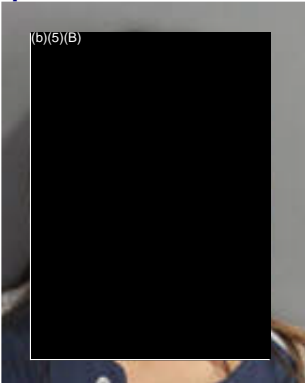

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(b)(5)(B) went to Rollins Way to meet her friend Jorge Earle who had left a backpack in her car the day before. She was in the driver's seat when Earle and his girlfriend, (b)(5)(B), approached the vehicle. (b)(5)(B) opened the car door while possessing a small extended pocket knife in her right hand. (b)(5)(B) attempted to keep the knife away from her cutting her hand in the process. (b)(5)(B) began to punch (b)(5)(B) with her left hand and stabbed (b)(5)(B) in the right thigh with the knife. Earle and (b)(5)(B) then dragged (b)(5)(B) out of the car and onto the ground. (b)(5)(B) got in the driver's seat and Earle got into the passenger's seat. The two left the area to an unknown destination.

Vista Fire transported (b)(5)(B) to Tri City Hospital. There is no video surveillance of the area. (b)(5)(B) desires prosecution.

ORIGIN:

On 10/05/17 at approximately 0420 hours, I received a radio call to investigate a stolen vehicle at Aladdin Bail Bonds located at 575 West Vista Way, Vista, county of San Diego (E4473971).

BACKGROUND:

The husband of (b)(5)(B) is (b)(5)(B) is currently incarcerated at the George Baily Detention Facility. (b)(5)(B) is the registered owner of a 1997 Toyota Camry (b)(5)(B). Jorge Earle (b)(5)(A) and (b)(5)(B) are in a dating relationship. Earle and (b)(5)(B) are acquaintances of both (b)(5)(B). All have extensive criminal records. Earle is a documented member of the Vista Home Boys (VHB) criminal street gang.

On 10/04/17 at 2254 hours (b)(5)(B) was stopped by Oceanside police in her vehicle. Earle was not present but a weapon belonging to Earle was recovered from the vehicle. (b)(5)(B) was interviewed and released by Oceanside police (Incident #113974).

INVESTIGATION:

At approximately 0425 hours, I arrived on scene and contacted a shaking and bloody Hispanic female, later identified as (b)(5)(B) lying on the floor. I observed (b)(5)(B) had a laceration to her right thigh and cuts to her right hand. I photographed (b)(5)(B) and called Vista Fire to the scene. (b)(5)(B) stated she had been assaulted and her car taken by Jorge Earle and (b)(5)(B) to an unknown location. Vista fire transported and I followed (b)(5)(B) to Tri City Hospital. I issued a bulletin (BOL) for the vehicle. I took the following statement from (b)(5)(B)

STATEMENT O (b)(5)(B) (Victim):

(b)(5)(B) stated she was the owner of a 1997 Toyota Camry (b)(5)(B). On 10/04/17 she had been with Jorge Earle in her vehicle. Earle had left his backpack behind. Earle had texted her about 0300 hours

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and told her to come by (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way and hang out so he could get his backpack from her. Martinez went to Rollins Way and parked along the roadway before the house near the parking lot of 537 West Vista Way. (b)(5)(B) stayed in the driver's seat of the vehicle. Earle and (b)(5)(B) approached the vehicle. (b)(5)(B) ordered (b)(5)(B) to get out of the car. (b)(5)(B) refused. (b)(5)(B) opened the car door. (b)(5)(B) saw an extended "pocket-knife" in (b)(5)(B) right hand. (b)(5)(B) attempted to keep the knife away from her cutting her hand in the process. (b)(5)(B) began to punch (b)(5)(B) with her left hand and at some point stabbed (b)(5)(B) in the right thigh with the knife. Earle and (b)(5)(B) then dragged (b)(5)(B) out of the car and tossed her onto the ground. (b)(5)(B) got in the driver's seat and Earle got into the passenger's seat. The two left the area to an unknown destination in (b)(5)(B) vehicle. (b)(5)(B) cellular phone and purse were inside the vehicle. (b)(5)(B) walked to Aladdin Bail Bonds to contact law enforcement.

(b)(5)(B) speculated that Earle may believe that she is a "snitch". She was unable to provide a clothing description or a description of the pocket knifed due to the fact she was overwhelmed by the attack. (b)(5)(B) desires prosecution.

INVESTIGATION (CONTINUED)

(b)(5)(B) estimated the value of the vehicle is approximately \$1500. She did not give (b)(5)(B) or Earle permission to use the vehicle. Both Plates were on the vehicle. I obtained a signed medical release form from (b)(5)(B) I provided (b)(5)(B) a case number and informed her to contact Law Enforcement before touching or driving the vehicle if she happened upon it.

I returned to (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way. The vehicle was not present. I contacted Detective Haddad from the Street Narcotic Gang Detective Unit (SNGD). Detective Haddad contacted (b)(5)(B) at Tri City Hospital. At 0502 hours, the vehicle was entered into the stolen vehicle system.

I determined probable cause existed to arrest (b)(5)(B) for 245 PC - Assault with a Deadly Weapon. I determined probable cause existed to arrest both Earle and (b)(5)(B) for both 215 PC - Carjacking and 182 PC - Conspiracy to Commit Crime.

Later at the Vista Patrol Station I copied all photographs to a CD and entered into the Vista Evidence Locker. I scanned a copy of the Medical Release Form to the case file.

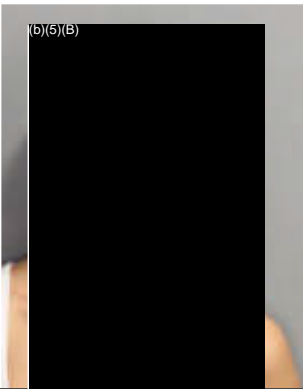

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On 10/05/2017, Jorge Earl (b)(5)(A) and (b)(5)(B) were arrested for 215(A) PC and 182(A)(1) PC. (b)(5)(B) was additionally arrested for 245(A)(1) PC.

(b)(5)(B) was arrested for 1203.2 (A) PC, 148 (A)(1), 496D PC, 466 PC, and 11378 HS.

(b)(5)(B), who attempted to harbor a wanted felon, Jorge Earl, were arrested for 32 PC and 148 (A)(1) PC. (b)(5)(B) was found to be in possession of Methamphetamine during the arrest and was also arrested for 11377 (A) HS.

All subjects were later transported to the Vista Detention Facility for booking.

ORIGIN:

On 10/05/2017, at about 1907 hours, Deputies contacted the suspects of a carjacking and stabbing that occurred earlier in the morning at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way, in the City of Vista, County of San Diego (CAD #E4475960). I was on duty, in full San Diego County Sheriff's uniform, driving a fully marked Sheriff's patrol vehicle.

BACKGROUND:

On 10/05/17, at about 0400 hours, Jorge Earl (b)(5)(A) and (b)(5)(B) approached (b)(5)(B) who was sitting in the driver's seat of her white Toyota Camry at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way, in the City of Vista. (b)(5)(B) and Earl began violently attacking (b)(5)(B) while she was sitting in the driver's seat. (b)(5)(B) retrieved a knife and stabbed (b)(5)(B) in the leg and hand. (b)(5)(B) also punched (b)(5)(B) in the face with a closed fist. (b)(5)(B) and Earl dragged (b)(5)(B) out of the vehicle and then stole her vehicle. (b)(5)(B) and Earl were last seen driving the vehicle northbound on N. Melrose Drive. The Camry belongs to (b)(5)(B) and her husband. (b)(5)(B) and Earl have never been given permission to drive the vehicle.

(b)(5)(B) sustained lacerations on her right leg and right hand from the stab wounds. (b)(5)(B) face was covered in blood and she sustained an apparent broken nose.

(b)(5)(B) has known (b)(5)(B) and Earl for at least a year and she positively identified them both as the suspects.

(See Deputy Myers report for further Background information on the location of 391 North Melrose Drive (b)(5)(B) in Vista).

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Primary Victim: (b)(5)(B)

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INVESTIGATION:

While in the area of the 76 Gas Station, 485 North Melrose Drive, Vista, Detective Haddad located the stolen white Toyota Camry (Lic (b)(5)(B)) parked in front of a gas pump. Detective Haddad noticed the vehicle was occupied by the suspects, Jorge Earl and (b)(5)(B), as well as a third individual, later identified as (b)(5)(B). Detective Haddad relayed the location of the vehicle to responding Deputies. Multiple Sheriff's Deputies arrived on scene in marked Sheriff's Patrol vehicles. Upon arrival, Earl, (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) noticed the Deputies presence and immediately fled the vehicle on foot. (b)(5)(B) began running southbound on North Melrose Drive, while Earl and (b)(5)(B) fled eastbound on Olive Avenue. (b)(5)(B) was quickly detained by Deputy Gallagher without incident (See Deputy Gallagher's report for further details). (b)(5)(B) was detained a short distance away by Deputy Minami (See Deputy Minami's report for further details). Earl continued running southbound towards a housing complex located at 391 North Melrose Drive. Earl was seen by Deputy Lemaster running towards the area of apartment # (b)(5)(B) (See Deputy Lemaster's report for details). A perimeter was quickly established and a Sheriff's K-9 was requested to respond to conduct a track for Earl (See Deputy Crawford's report for further details). While Sheriff's K-9 unit and Sheriff's Helicopter were responding, Deputy Myers and I conducted a check of # (b)(5)(B) for Earl.

Deputy Myers and I knew that apartment # (b)(5)(B) is a location known for gang and narcotics activity (See Background for further details). We additionally knew (b)(5)(B) lived at the location and had a valid Fourth Amendment waiver. Upon arriving at the location, Deputy Myers and I observed a male whom I immediately recognized from prior contacts as (b)(5)(B) standing inside of the kitchen of the location. From prior contacts, I knew (b)(5)(B) had a valid Fourth Amendment waiver. Deputy Myers and I entered into the apartment and conducted a check for Earl. Once inside of the apartment, I contacted (b)(5)(B) and asked "Is Jorge here, where did he go?" (b)(5)(B) said something to the effect of, "not to my knowledge." Deputy Myers and I also contacted a female, identified as (b)(5)(B) who was also in the kitchen with (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) said Earl was not in the apartment and did not know what we were "talking about." Deputy Myers and I also contacted (b)(5)(B) who was inside of a bedroom. Deputy Myers and I conducted a check of the residence and did not locate Earl. We left the location and waited for Sheriff K-9 to conduct a track of Earl. The perimeter of apartment # (b)(5)(B) was held until Sheriff's K-9 arrived, and was later able to conduct a thorough search for Earl.

ABLE, a San Diego Police helicopter arrived and conducted a search for Earl. Numerous announcements were made over the loudspeaker of the helicopter. The announcements provided a description of Earl, and also essentially instructed him to turn himself into law enforcement.

After about an hour of announcements from the helicopter, Sheriff's K-9 Deputy Crawford and his K-9 partner "Marko" arrived and conducted a check of apartment # (b)(5)(B). Deputy Crawford located Earl hiding in a small crawlspace underneath the water heater of the apartment. The crawlspace where Earl was hiding was no more than about 10 feet from the kitchen, or the bedroom where (b)(5)(B) were upon initial contact. Sheriff K-9 announcements were made, but Earl refused to comply with

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deputies commands. With the assistance of Sheriff's K-9, Earl was detained in handcuffs (See Deputy Crawford's report for further details).

(b)(5)(B) were also detained in handcuffs, as I believed they had knowledge Earl was inside of the apartment. Apartment (b)(5)(B) is no more than about 1300 square feet. It has a front door entrance and a side slider entrance, both of which lead to the main kitchen area, where (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) were standing upon initial contact. The crawlspace where Earl was hiding was directly across a hallway from the bedroom where (b)(5)(B) was contacted. Based on the close proximity of Earl to (b)(5)(B), coupled with the fact that Earl did not enter the apartment after Deputy Myers and I were initially checking for him, I believed they had knowledge Earl was inside of the location. Additionally, (b)(5)(B), even when asked, did not indicate that Earl was hiding in the crawlspace. Based on the aforementioned facts, I arrested (b)(5)(B) for 32 - PC - ACCESSORY TO FELONY (F) and 148 (A)(1) - PC - OBSTRUCT/RESIST PEACE OFCR/EMER MED TECH (M).

San Diego County Humane Society was notified and responded to the scene for (b)(5)(B) dog that was unattended in the apartment. SD Humane Society Officer Tarnowski arrived and took custody of (b)(5)(B) dog (See SD Humane Society Impound Card for further details).

A Sheriff's Record's check confirmed Earl had an outstanding Felony warrant (CPR160773) for his arrest. The warrant was issued on 09/18/2017 by Judge Rogers from North County Superior Court for 3455(B)(2). I arrested Earl for his outstanding Felony warrant, as well as 215(A) PC, 148 (A)(1) and 182(A)(1) PC.

Vista Fire and Paramedics arrived and medically treated Earl for his injuries sustained during the arrest. Paramedics transported Earl to Tri-City Hospital to be evaluated by medical staff. Deputy Landwehr followed Earl and the Paramedics to Tri-City Hospital.

I arrested (b)(5)(B) who was detained by Deputy Gallagher, for 215(A) PC, 245(A)(1) PC, and 182(A)(1) PC.

I contacted Deputy Minami who had initially detained (b)(5)(B). Deputy Minami told me he observed (b)(5)(B) throw a clear plastic baggie behind a white Nissan SUV during the foot pursuit. He also provided me with a black backpack that (b)(5)(B) was carrying upon initial contact. I checked the area in which Deputy Minami had originally seen (b)(5)(B) throw the baggie. I located a clear plastic baggie directly behind a white Nissan SUV, in between the SUV and a wooden fence. I noticed the baggie contained four individually packaged plastic, twisted up baggies. The baggies contained a white crystal-like substance. Based on my training and experience, I recognized the substance as Methamphetamine. I additionally know that individuals involved in the sale of illegal controlled substances typically separately package narcotics for easier and quicker transactions.

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A Sheriff's Records check indicated (b)(5)(B) was on County Probation. San Diego County Probation was notified and informed of the incident. County Probation placed (b)(5)(B) on a hold pursuant to 1203.2 (A) - PC - PROBATION VIOLATION:REARREST/REVOKE.

I conducted a search of the backpack that (b)(5)(B) was holding upon initial contact. The backpack contained multiple items including a Certificate of Title for the stolen Toyota Camry, belonging to (b)(5)(B). I additionally located a car key that had been altered or "shaved." Based on my training and experience, I know that individuals involved with stealing or burglarizing cars, will commonly use an altered or "shaved" key as a tool to gain entry or start the vehicle's engine.

I contacted (b)(5)(B) who was detained in the backseat of a Sheriff's patrol vehicle. I arrested (b)(5)(B) for 11378 - HS - POSS CONTROLLED SUBS FOR SALE (F), 148 (A)(1) - PC - OBSTRUCT/RESIST PEACE OFCR/EMER MED TECH (M), 466 - PC - POSS BURGLARY TOOLS (M), and 496 D (A) - PC - POSS STOLEN VEH/VESSEL (F).

(b)(5)(B) spontaneously said, "Bowman, I'm going to be strait up with you, I am a little high, my mom has been sick and I just fucked up." (b)(5)(B) continued by saying that he should not have "took off running or thrown the dope."

Detective Haddad processed the stolen Toyota Camry at the scene and contacted Sheriff's Teletype to take it out of the Stolen Vehicle System. Detective Haddad located blood inside the cab of the vehicle. Using a DNA swab, he collected a sample of the blood, which will later be tested for DNA. The vehicle was towed by S&R Towing pursuant to CVC 22651(C) - recovered stolen vehicle.

All arrested subjects were transported to the Vista Patrol Station for processing.

Once at the Vista Patrol Station, Deputy Myers processed the Methamphetamine that was located near the Nissan SUV. Deputy Myers additionally read (b)(5)(B) his Miranda Rights directly from the back of his deputy's notepad (See Deputy Myers report for further details). Detective Haddad arrived and conducted an interview with (b)(5)(B) (See Detective Haddad's report for further details).

I contacted (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B). I individually read them their Miranda Rights directly from the back of my Deputies Notepad. (b)(5)(B) said "Yes" he understood his rights and "No" he was not willing to speak to me about the incident. (b)(5)(B) said "Yes" he understood his rights and "Yes" he was willing to speak to me about the incident. (b)(5)(B) told me the following.

STATEMENTS:

Statement of (b)(5)(B) Suspect

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(b)(5)(B) told me he was in the kitchen with (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) when Earl "came running in" the apartment. (b)(5)(B) said he knew Earl "really good" but hadn't seen him in a while. (b)(5)(B) said he instructed Earl to get into the crawlspace and "stay there for two hours." (b)(5)(B) stated he instructed Earl to stay in the crawlspace so he could inform Law Enforcement that he was inside the apartment, but did not want Earl to know. (b)(5)(B) stated that about two minutes later, Deputy Myers and I arrived to check the apartment. (b)(5)(B) said he knew Earl was in the apartment when Myers and I were inside. (b)(5)(B) acknowledged he should have somehow indicated Earl was in the apartment. (b)(5)(B) said everyone knew Earl was "wanted" and said he heard the "police helicopter" making the announcements outside. (b)(5)(B) said Earl continued hiding inside of the crawlspace until the Sheriff's K-9 unit arrived and located him. When asked why he didn't notify law enforcement in the hour or so in between when Deputy Myers and I were inside the apartment, he said he did not want anyone to find out he was calling law enforcement.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

All arrested subjects, with the exception of Earl, as he was still at the hospital, were transported to the Vista Detention Facility for booking. Once at the Vista Detention Facility, (b)(5)(B) told me he had "a little dope," hidden inside of his shorts. I un-handcuffed (b)(5)(B) then retrieved a clear plastic baggie and a hypodermic syringe from the inside of a seam in the front of his shorts. The clear plastic baggie contained a white crystal-like substance. Based on my training and experience, I recognized the substance as Methamphetamine.

(b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) were all booked into jail without further incident.

I later tested the white crystal-like substance located on (b)(5)(B) person using a NIK-Kit "U." The substance tested positive for the presence of Methamphetamine. The net weight of the substance was .18 grams.

I additionally arrested (b)(5)(B) for 11377 (A) HS.

All digital photographs taken during the investigation were transferred onto a Compact Disc. I entered the disc and all evidentiary items into Evidence at the Vista Patrol Station.

It was later determined that Earl struck "Marko," the Sheriff's K-9 by kicking him in the legs. I would additionally request to charge Earl with 600 (B) - PC - WILLFULLY INTERFERE ETC PEACE OFCRS ANIMAL (M).

I concluded my investigation.

DISPOSITION:

Arrest.

SYNOPSIS:

On 10/05/17, at about 0400 hours, Jorge Earl (b)(5)(A)) and (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(A)) approached (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B)) who was sitting in the driver's seat of her white Toyota Camry (Lic#(b)(5)(B)) at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way, in the City of Vista. (b)(5)(B) began violently attacking (b)(5)(B) while she was sitting in the driver's seat. (b)(5)(B) retrieved a knife and stabbed (b)(5)(B) in the leg and hand.

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(b)(5)(B) also punched (b)(5)(B) in the face with a closed fist. (b)(5)(B) and Earl forcefully dragged (b)(5)(B) out of the vehicle and then stole her vehicle. (b)(5)(B) and Earl fled the area in the carjacked vehicle. (b)(5)(B) and Earl have never been given permission to drive the vehicle. (b)(5)(B) sustained lacerations on her right leg and right hand from the stab wounds. (b)(5)(B) face was covered in blood and she sustained an apparent broken nose.

Later that day, at about 1900 hours, Deputies located Jorge Earl and (b)(5)(B) in the carjacked Camry at the gas station at 485 N. Melrose Drive, in Vista. Upon seeing the Deputies, (b)(5)(B) and Earl fled from the Camry on foot and a foot pursuit ensued. (b)(5)(B) was detained about 100 yards down the street, but Earl fled into a nearby condo. Earl hid in a crawlspace in the condo at 391 N. Melrose Drive (b)(5)(B), and was later located and apprehended by a Sheriff's K-9. Earl sustained injuries from the K9 contact. A third passenger was also in the Camry, (b)(5)(B) ((b)(5)(A)), and he also fled on foot. (b)(5)(B) was not involved with the carjacking but he was found to be in possession of several bags of suspected methamphetamine. (b)(5)(B) was arrested for possession of methamphetamine for sales.

During a Post-Miranda interview with (b)(5)(B) she admitted to attacking and stabbing (b)(5)(A) and then stealing (b)(5)(A) vehicle. (b)(5)(B) said the incident happened because she was jealous that (b)(5)(A) was hanging out with (b)(5)(B) boyfriend, Jorge Earl. (b)(5)(B), Jorge Earl, and (b)(5)(B) were arrested and booked into the Vista Detention Facility.

INVESTIGATIVE FOLLOW-UP:

On 10/05/17, at about 0500 hours, Deputy Taylor contacted me advising me there was a carjacking / stabbing that occurred in Vista. Deputy Taylor gave me a short brief on the details of the incident and I responded to assist with follow-up on this case. Deputy Taylor advised me the victim was at Tri City Medical Center.

On 10/05/17, at about 0640 hours, I arrived to the emergency room at Tri City Medical Center and met with the victim, (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) was laying down in a hospital bed in the emergency room. (b)(5)(B) nose and mouth were covered in dry blood. (b)(5)(B) nose appeared to be broken and swollen. (b)(5)(B) upper lip was swollen and covered in blood. (b)(5)(B) seemed very fearful and upset. (b)(5)(B) had dry blood smeared on her left shoulder, both of her arms, her neck, legs, and her clothing. (b)(5)(B) had several stab wounds on her body which were covered up with bandages from the hospital staff. (b)(5)(B) removed the bandages to show me the stab wounds. (b)(5)(B) had a thick puncture wound on her upper right thigh area about one inch long. There was dry blood smeared around the wound and fresh blood bleeding from the cut. (b)(5)(B) also had a laceration on her right leg just below her knee. (b)(5)(B) had a large laceration on her right hand between her thumb and pointer finger. The cut was about an inch and half long which started on the top of her hand and extended to the palm

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of her hand. (b)(5)(B) had another laceration on her middle fingernail of her right hand. (b)(5)(B) had abrasions on the back of her neck. I took digital photographs of (b)(5)(B) injuries.

I explained to (b)(5)(B) I was the Detective assigned to this case and I was conducting follow-up investigation. (b)(5)(B) essentially gave me the following statement. I recorded my interview with (b)(5)(B) on a department issued audio recording device. The following statement is a summarized account of (b)(5)(B) interview. Refer to the recorded interview for the entire statement.

STATEMENT OF (b)(5)(B) (VICTIM):

On 10/04/17, in the evening hours, (b)(5)(B) was hanging out with an acquaintance, Jorge Earl ((b)(5)(A)). (b)(5)(B) said she has known Earl for about a year and she met him through a friend. (b)(5)(B) was driving Earl around Vista and Oceanside in her 1997 Toyota Camry (Lic (b)(5)(B)). The Camry belongs to (b)(5)(B) and her boyfriend, (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B)). (b)(5) is the registered owner but (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5) both drive the car an equal amount.

While inside of (b)(5)(B) car, (b)(5)(B) saw Earl use a syringe to inject methamphetamine into his arm. (b)(5)(B) was in the driver's seat and Earl was in the front passenger seat. (b)(5)(B) mentioned to Earl that she had never shot a gun before. Earl told (b)(5)(B) that he had a gun and the gun was being stored at a friend's house in Vista at an apartment complex on Postal Way. (b)(5)(B) drove Earl to the friend's apartment and Earl retrieved the firearm from the apartment and returned back to the car. (b)(5)(B) stayed in the driver's seat while Earl went into the apartment. Earl put the gun in the backseat of the Camry. (b)(5)(B) described Earl's gun as a long rifle type of gun that was silver and brown in color. Earl and (b)(5)(B) drove to an uninhabited ravine area near Highway 76 and E. Vista Way. Upon their arrival to the ravine, Earl removed the gun from the car and showed it to (b)(5)(B). Earl loaded the gun with two bullets. (b)(5)(B) described the bullets as being blue in color. Earl then pointed the gun towards the hillside and shot one round from the gun. Earl then handed the gun to (b)(5)(B) and showed her how to hold and operate the gun. (b)(5)(B) then shot the second bullet from the gun towards the hillside. After shooting the gun, Earl put the gun in the backseat of the Camry. (b)(5)(B) and Earl then drove into the city of Oceanside. (b)(5)(B) boyfriend, (b)(5)(B), had the phone number for an Oceanside Police Detective saved in their phone. (b)(5)(B) sent a text message to Oceanside Police Detectives about Earl being in possession of a firearm.

While driving near the Walmart by Highway 76 and College Blvd, a Police Officer pulled (b)(5)(B) over by driving behind her Camry and activating the lights and sirens on the police car. When Earl noticed the police were behind them, he told (b)(5)(B) he was going to run from the cops. (b)(5)(B) pulled over and Earl ran from the car. Oceanside Police Officers attempted to chase after Earl but he was able to escape without being detained. The Police Officers retrieved Earl's firearm from the backseat of (b)(5)(B) Camry. (b)(5)(B) was released from the scene without incident.

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(b)(5)(B) left Oceanside and drove towards Escondido. Several hours later, (b)(5)(B) received text messages from Earl asking her about what happened. (b)(5)(B) said she was released from the scene and Earl began questioning (b)(5)(B) if she told the police anything about him. (b)(5)(B) told Earl that she did not say anything. Earl told (b)(5)(B) that he left his bag in the back of her Camry and that he needed his bag. Earl told (b)(5)(B) he was in Vista at the house by the Wendy's. The house Earl was referring to was (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way, in Vista, which is a known drug house that generates numerous calls for service.

(b)(5)(B) drove to the house at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way to meet Earl to give him his belongings. (b)(5)(B) said she had a bad feeling about meeting up with Earl. (b)(5)(B) initially parked in an adjacent parking lot to the house at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way because she did not want to go into the house. When (b)(5)(B) arrived to the parking lot, she texted Earl telling him that she was there. Earl texted her back telling her to pull up to the driveway. (b)(5)(B) pulled into the driveway area of the house at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way. Earl texted (b)(5)(B) again telling her to come into the house but (b)(5)(B) stayed in the driver's seat of the car in the driveway. Earl told (b)(5)(B) "Why don't you come over here and squash this."

When (b)(5)(B) parked her car in the driveway, Earl's girlfriend came running out of the house. Earl's girlfriend is (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(A). (b)(5)(B) also knows (b)(5)(B) as an acquaintance. Once (b)(5)(B) exited the house, Earl followed right behind her.

(b)(5)(B) began yelling at (b)(5)(B) while (b)(5)(B) still remained seated in the driver's seat of the Camry. (b)(5)(B) was screaming at (b)(5)(B) saying "Get the fuck out of the car!" (b)(5)(B) did not exit the car and (b)(5)(B) continued to scream at her. (b)(5)(B) told (b)(5)(B) that she was "fucking with her man." (b)(5)(B) opened the driver's door and began attacking (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) forcefully punched (b)(5)(B) in the nose with a closed fist. After punching (b)(5)(B), (b)(5)(B) got into the car and positioned her body on top of (b)(5)(B) body in the driver's seat. (b)(5)(B) said she was not trying to fight back and she was just trying to cover her face to block (b)(5)(B) punches. (b)(5)(B) yelled "Look bitch you're gonna get out of the car, before you have a big ass fucking hole right there in the center of your stomach." (b)(5)(B) also said she was going to slice (b)(5)(B) into pieces.

(b)(5)(B) pulled out a knife from her sweatpants pocket. (b)(5)(B) described (b)(5)(B) knife as being a large folding knife, about 8 inches long when opened, and it was silver in color. (b)(5)(B) then attempted to stab (b)(5)(B) with the knife. (b)(5)(B) said he was able to dodge her body away from (b)(5)(B) initial stabbing motions. (b)(5)(B) was making the stabbing motions with the knife towards (b)(5)(B) stomach area. (b)(5)(B) stabbed (b)(5)(B) in the upper right thigh and lower right leg with the knife. After getting stabbed by (b)(5)(B), (b)(5)(B) retrieved a knife that belonged to her. (b)(5)(B) said she retrieved her knife in self-defense due to (b)(5)(B) attacking her and stabbing her. (b)(5)(B) continued slashing her knife towards (b)(5)(B) face and neck area. Fearing (b)(5)(B) was going to stab her again, (b)(5)(B) used her knife in an attempt to stab (b)(5)(B) to get her off of her body. (b)(5)(B) said she was unsure if she actually stabbed (b)(5)(B) but she believed her knife made contact with (b)(5)(B) body. (b)(5)(B) then grabbed (b)(5)(B) knife from her hand and wrestled the knife away from (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) then stabbed (b)(5)(B) right hand with the knife.

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During the attack, (b)(5)(B) was calling (b)(5)(B) a "snitch." (b)(5)(B) took the key out of the ignition of the car. While (b)(5)(B) was stabbing and attacking (b)(5)(B) Earl was standing a couple feet away from the car smoking a cigarette. (b)(5)(B) asked Earl to help her and to get (b)(5)(B) off of her but Earl stood there and did nothing.

(b)(5)(B) dropped the knife but continued attacking (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) was punching (b)(5)(B) and grabbing her hair. (b)(5)(B) then put (b)(5)(B) in a "choke hold" by wrapping her arm around (b)(5)(B) neck and applying pressure. (b)(5)(B) attempted to pull (b)(5)(B) out of the car while she still had (b)(5)(B) in a choke hold. (b)(5)(B) put both her hands on the steering wheel of the car to prevent (b)(5)(B) from pulling her out. (b)(5)(B) said she nearly lost consciousness from the choke hold but she did not entirely black out. Earl then ran over to assist (b)(5)(B) Earl grabbed (b)(5)(B) hands, which were on the steering wheel, and began pulling her out of the car. Earl and (b)(5)(B) overpowered (b)(5)(B) and dragged her body out of the car.

Once (b)(5)(B) was on the ground outside of the car, (b)(5)(B) got into the driver's seat of the Camry and started the ignition with the key. Earl got into the front passenger seat of the Camry with "no hesitation." (b)(5)(B) and Earl drove off in the Camry.

(b)(5)(B) said that Earl and (b)(5)(B) have never had permission to drive or use her Camry.

(b)(5)(B) ran to Aladdin Bail Bonds down the street at 575 W. Vista Way, to report the crime and get medical aid.

(b)(5)(B) said her cell phone, ID, and purse were still in the car. (b)(5)(B) said her phone was a black Android phone, through AT&T, and the phone number is (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) said the phone has a black "dot" pattern on the back of the phone. The phone also has a magnet attached to the back of the phone. (b)(5)(B) described her purse as a tan colored leather Liz Claiborne purse.

(b)(5)(B) described the car as a 4-door white 1997 Toyota Camry (Lic#(b)(5)(B)). (b)(5)(B) said there is a crack on the left side of the windshield. (b)(5)(B) valued the car at approximately \$2000. (b)(5)(B) did not recall any significant damage or scratch marks on the car.

(b)(5)(B) desires prosecution for this case.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

I located the most recent jail booking photographs of Jorge Earl and (b)(5)(B) using my department issued device. The photographs were colored photographs and Earl's photo was taken on 04/06/17 and

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(b)(5)(B) was taken on 05/03/17. I showed the photographs of Jorge Earl and (b)(5)(B) to (b)(5)(B) and she positively identified both Earl and (b)(5)(B) as the suspects.

I noticed (b)(5)(B) shirt had several blood droplets on the front of the shirt and I collected the shirt as evidence.

Detective Ortiz then drove to (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way to assess the crime scene. Detective Ortiz was approached by staff at Saint Francis of Assisi Catholic School at 525 W. Vista Way, which is directly next to the house at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way. Staff advised Detective Ortiz that their fence to their property was damaged sometime overnight and the damage appeared to have been caused by a vehicle colliding into the fence. Staff then showed Detective Ortiz a broken driver's side mirror that was found next to the damaged fence. The detached mirror was white in color. Detective Ortiz took digital photographs of the fence and collected the mirror as evidence.

Detective Ortiz checked the surrounding area for video surveillance cameras but did not locate any cameras that would have captured the incident.

I created a "Probable Cause to Arrest" bulletin for Earl and (b)(5)(B) and dispersed the bulletin to deputies at the Vista Patrol Station.

Later that day, at about 1900 hours, I was driving around the City of Vista searching for Earl, (b)(5)(B) and the carjacked vehicle. While driving near the intersection of N. Melrose Drive and Olive Avenue, I saw the white Toyota Camry (Lic#(b)(5)(B)) parked at a gas pump at the United Oil 76 Gas Station at 485 N. Melrose Drive. I saw (b)(5)(B) in the driver's seat of the Camry and Jorge Earl in the front passenger seat. There was another male, later identified as (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(A)), in the backseat of the Camry.

Once (b)(5)(B) and Earl finished pumping gas into the Camry, (b)(5)(B) started the car. There was another car getting gas at the pump directly in front of them, which prevented them from driving away from the gas station.

I advised Sheriff's Dispatch that I located the carjacking vehicle and that (b)(5)(B) and Jorge Earl were both in the car. I requested for additional deputies, a Sheriff's K9, and for air support. I was in an unmarked vehicle and I watched the car from a distance and guided responding units to the area. Shortly after, Deputies arrived to the gas station and located the car. As soon as Deputies arrived, all three subjects exited the Camry and fled the vehicle on foot. Several foot pursuits ensued as Deputies chased all three suspects. Jorge Earl and (b)(5)(B) ran away from the car heading eastbound on Olive Avenue as Deputies gave chase. (b)(5)(B) ran away from the vehicle heading southbound on N. Melrose Drive.

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Deputy Gallagher quickly caught up to (b)(5)(B) and detained her near the 400 block of N. Melrose Drive. Deputy Minami caught up to (b)(5)(B) and detained him. (b)(5)(B) removed a bag from his pocket and threw it to the ground prior to Deputy Minami detaining him. The bag contained separate baggies which each contained a white crystalline substance. Refer to Deputy Minami and Deputy Bowman's reports for further details.

Sergeant Whalen and Deputy Landwehr stayed with the vehicle at the gas station to secure the crime scene.

Jorge Earl continued running away from Deputies and he jumped several fences in the area. Deputies observed Earl jump a fence and run towards a condominium at 391 N. Melrose Drive (b) This condo unit is a known drug house which has generated numerous calls for service. Gang members, felons, and drug users frequently stay at this residence. The Sheriff's Department has conducted several search warrants, arrests, and probation/parole searches at this condo that have resulted in firearms arrests, drug arrests, and felony warrant arrests. A perimeter was established around the area and K9 Deputy Crawford arrived to track the suspect. Earl was later found hiding in the condo at 391 N. Melrose Drive (b) in a crawl space. Earl was uncooperative with Deputies and was contacted by a Sheriff's K9. Refer to Deputy Crawford's report for details.

There were three occupants inside of 391 N. Melrose Drive (b) that repeatedly lied to deputies in an attempt to assist Earl in avoiding arrest. Deputy Bowman arrested those three subjects for 32 PC-ACCESSORY. The three subjects were identified as (b)(5)(B), (b)(5)(A), (b)(5)(B), (b)(5)(A), and (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(A). Refer to Deputy Bowman's arrest report (SDSO#17152031) for details.

Earl sustained injuries from the K9 contact and was transported via ambulance to Tri City Medical Center. (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) were arrested and transported to the Vista Patrol Station for processing. (b)(5)(B) was arrested for 215(A) PC, 245(A)(1) PC, and 182(A)(1) PC. (b)(5)(B) was arrested for possession of methamphetamine for sales and a probation violation.

I drove to the gas station where the carjacked Camry was left. Sergeant Whalen was standing by with the Camry.

I took digital photographs of the Camry and later attached them to this case as evidence.

The Camry's driver side mirror was missing and there was significant damage and scratch marks on the entire left side of the car. The front windshield had a large crack on the left side.

While examining the Camry, I noticed there were blood droplets and blood smears on the interior and exterior of the car. The majority of the blood drops were near the driver's seat area. I located blood in the

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following areas: the steering wheel, the steering column, the driver's seat, the key ignition area, the interior of the driver's door and the exterior of the driver's door.

I used stain collection kit swabs and collected the blood as evidence.

I also located (b)(5)(A) phone and purse inside of the car and collected them as evidence. I found an additional black cell phone in the car and collected it as evidence.

Once I finished processing the Camry for evidence, the vehicle was towed and I removed it from the Stolen Vehicle System.

Detective Ortiz obtained video surveillance footage from the 76 gas station which shows Earl, (b)(5)(B) lee from the carjacked Camry. The video was attached as evidence to this case.

I drove to the Vista Patrol Station to conduct follow up interviews with (b)(5)(B)

Detective Astorga and I escorted (b)(5)(B) to an interview room at the Vista Patrol Station. The video room is equipped with video/audio recording and I recorded the interview. I later placed the recording of the interview into evidence and attached it to this case. The following statement is a summarized account of (b)(5)(B) interview. Refer to the recorded interview for the entire statement.

STATEMENT OF (b)(5)(B) (ARRESTEE):

I asked (b)(5)(B) how she has been and she immediately replied "Bad. I've been doing bad."

I read (b)(5)(B) the Miranda Admonishment verbatim from my deputy notebook. I asked (b)(5)(B) "Do you understand each of these rights that I have explained to you?" and (b)(5)(B) replied "Yes sir." I asked (b)(5)(B) if she wanted to speak to me and (b)(5)(B) replied "Ya I do."

(b)(5)(B) said she has been dating Jorge Earl for a while. (b)(5)(B) said her relationship with Earl has been up and down. They often use each other to get high. (b)(5)(B) said Earl got sent to prison last year and Earl did his time. (b)(5)(B) said "And I've been out here just running amok."

(b)(5)(B) and Earl have been having problems recently. (b)(5)(B) said Earl has been "tripping" lately. (b)(5)(B) said her brother, (b)(5)(B) recently started dating (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) said she has been hanging out a lot at the "Wendy's house." (b)(5)(B) said that her, Earl, (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) have been hanging out together.

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On 10/04/17, 0200 hours, (b)(5)(B) was hanging out at the Wendy's house when Earl came over to the house. (b)(5)(B) saw Earl's cell phone and she started looking through his phone. When (b)(5)(B) was looking through Earl's phone, she noticed he was talking to (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) became angry and jealous. (b)(5)(B) said she got "pissed off." This also upset (b)(5)(B) because (b)(5)(B) was supposedly dating her brother, (b)(5)(B).

(b)(5)(B) noticed one of the text messages between Earl and (b)(5)(B) mentioned them wanting to meet up. Shortly after, (b)(5)(B) saw a text from (b)(5)(B) to Earl saying she was there and waiting outside of the house. (b)(5)(B) said she got mad and she went outside to (b)(5)(B) and told her that she wanted to fight her. (b)(5)(B) said "I don't know I was just so mad. And I fought her. It just got out of hand. And I took her car."

(b)(5)(B) said when she first approached (b)(5)(B) she told (b)(5)(B) "Get out of the car and fight me." (b)(5)(B) said (b)(5)(B) did not exit the car but instead just sat there looking at (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) said she got even more mad when she noticed what (b)(5)(B) was wearing. (b)(5)(B) was wearing very short shorts and (b)(5)(B) became more jealous. (b)(5)(B) asked (b)(5)(B) "What are you talking about?"

(b)(5)(B) then told (b)(5)(B) "If you don't get out of the car, I'm gonna get you out the car!" (b)(5)(B) said "I started just socking her" while (b)(5)(B) was sitting in the driver's seat. (b)(5)(B) told (b)(5)(B) to calm down and she could explain what happened.

(b)(5)(B) said she got into the car on top of (b)(5)(B) and started fighting with her. At some point, (b)(5)(B) said she yelled "Explain to me then!" (b)(5)(B) said they continued fighting and (b)(5)(B) hit (b)(5)(B) "really good in the face." (b)(5)(B) said "I was getting her good." (b)(5)(B) said she then felt her leg get poked with a knife. (b)(5)(B) said she grabbed the knife from (b)(5)(B).

(b)(5)(B) said (b)(5)(B) always carries a knife on her person. (b)(5)(B) said she always carries a knife on her as well, but it just recently got stolen. (b)(5)(B) could not explain the details of how her knife was stolen. She described her stolen knife as being gray and orange in color.

I asked (b)(5)(B) to clarify the details of where she was when this was happening. (b)(5)(B) said she got into the car. (b)(5)(B) said "I hit her first. If that's what you mean. I hit her first." (b)(5)(B) said "I went in (to the car) because she started tilting back. I felt like I needed to just keep going in there." As (b)(5)(B) said this she was making punching motions with her hands.

(b)(5)(B) said "I guess I'm stronger." I then said "So you were getting the better of her a little bit." (b)(5)(B) interrupted me and said "No, a lot. A lot." (b)(5)(B) said "I was really just mad. I wanted her to get hurt."

(b)(5)(B) said once she felt the poke from (b)(5)(B) knife, (b)(5)(B) grabbed the knife with her right hand. (b)(5)(B) said "When I took the knife away from her, I felt like I needed to get her back." As (b)(5)(B) said this, she made a stabbing motion with her hand. (b)(5)(B) said "I hit her. I kept hitting her." (b)(5)(B) said "I

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remember telling her, get out of the fucking car! I don't know why, at that moment I wanted her to get out of the car. I wanted to take her car." (b)(5)(B) seemed upset and she said "That's not me though. I don't act like that. I don't know how I got like that. I've been feeling all bad all day. I don't know what to do. I'm just driving around in circles. I picked up my brother (b)(5)(B)

Detective Astorga asked (b)(5)(B) "So you start telling her to get out of the car. Did she get out?" (b)(5)(B) replied "Ya, I pulled her out. And I threw her out." (b)(5)(B) said once she threw (b)(5)(B) out of the car, she stole the car.

Detective Astorga asked (b)(5)(B) "Why did you take the car?" and (b)(5)(B) replied "Because I don't know. I don't have nothing. I've took a car before."

Detective Astorga said "But why did you take hers?" and (b)(5)(B) said "I wanted her just to. I don't know. This isn't me. But I'm here and I'm fessing up to what I did." (b)(5)(B) said "It sounds malicious of me. I don't know. It sounds all bad. Maybe I just did it because. I don't know."

I asked (b)(5)(B) to explain more details of the fight. I asked (b)(5)(B) how many times she punched (b)(5)(B) and she said "seven." (b)(5)(B) said "it just happened fast. I'm here. I stole her car, fine, I accept that. I got in an argument with her, I accept that. I did what I did."

(b)(5)(B) said she did not know if Earl hit (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) said she would "fess up" to her actions but she did not want to talk about Earl's involvement.

(b)(5)(B) said "I feel really bad about it. Really really bad about it."

(b)(5)(B) said during the struggle, she felt a poke on her leg and she grabbed the knife. (b)(5)(B) said she then wanted to use the knife on (b)(5)(B). (b)(5)(B) said she was playing "monkey in the middle" with the knife.

I asked (b)(5)(B) "Where did you stab her at?" (b)(5)(B) said "I don't remember. That knife was so sharp." I asked (b)(5)(B) how many times she made a stabbing motion with the knife towards (b)(5)(B) (b)(5)(B) said she could not remember and "That's what fucking happens when you fucking do drugs. I fucking fucked up." (b)(5)(B) admitted to smoking "crystal meth."

(b)(5)(B) said "I just felt betrayed." Detective Astorga said "If you were getting her pretty good with punches, why'd you use the knife on her." (b)(5)(B) said "Because she used it on me."

I asked (b)(5)(B) if (b)(5)(B) was bleeding and she said yes. (b)(5)(B) saw (b)(5)(B) face was covered in blood.

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I asked (b)(5)(B) if she could explain again how she got (b)(5)(B) out of the car. (b)(5)(B) replied "I just remember trying to yank her out." (b)(5)(B) said after she pulled (b)(5)(B) out of the car, she got in the driver's seat and Earl got in the passenger seat. (b)(5)(B) said the car was already running with the key in the ignition. (b)(5)(B) said she drove the car away and "spazzed out and drove like an idiot. I was not really sober." (b)(5)(B) turned out of the house by the church parking lot and "did donuts." I asked (b)(5)(B) "Did you hit that fence where the mirror came off?" and she said "Ya."

(b)(5)(B) said her and Earl fled the area in the stolen car. (b)(5)(B) said "All I know is I was just mad. I was under the influence. I was just mad. I probably said some dumb stuff."

(b)(5)(B) said after stealing the car, her and Earl have just been driving the car around and "dodging the cops." (b)(5)(B) said they went far away to the "boonies."

(b)(5)(B) later picked up her brother, (b)(5)(B) in the car. (b)(5)(B) said when the cops showed up at the gas station, she, Earl and (b)(5)(B) all ran. (b)(5)(B) said "I ran. I ran because I know what I did. I knew I was gonna get arrested."

I asked (b)(5)(B) where the knife went and she said she did not know.

I asked (b)(5)(B) what she was hoping to accomplish by doing this. (b)(5)(B) said "It happened because at the moment I was mad. I was mad. Like how could you do this to me?" (b)(5)(B) said "There are things that come with like being out there on the streets. You've gotta have this tough shell."

(b)(5)(B) said she has never driven (b)(5)(B) car before and (b)(5)(B) has never given her permission to drive it.

(b)(5)(B) said "I'm a freaking hot-head man. I was a hot-head at that moment. I was just hurt."

I asked (b)(5)(B) how bad the scratch on her leg was from the knife. (b)(5)(B) said "You're probably thinking I am the bad guy, and I am the bad guy you know. I'll be the bad guy because I took the car. I did all that. I went through the fence."

I told (b)(5)(B) that (b)(5)(B) told me that (b)(5)(B) stabbed (b)(5)(B) first. (b)(5)(B) said "No. Well, we both stabbed each other."

(b)(5)(B) said "Nothing is going to change the fact that I did those things. I did them. I did them."

I asked (b)(5)(B) "When you were pulling her out of the car, I think that Jorge also helped pull on her. Am I right in thinking that?" and (b)(5)(B) replied "I don't know. Probably. All I know is I got her out."

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I asked (b)(5)(B) if she was yelling at (b)(5)(B) while she was pulling her out of the car and she said "Ya, I was freaking pissed man."

(b)(5)(B) said "I know it sounds like we teamed up on her. It wasn't like that. I was the one that wanted to fight her cuz she was with him. I take ownership for that."

I asked (b)(5)(B) "Who do you think hurt the other person more?" and she replied "Oh my God, does it matter? I just know that I stabbed her and I'm the one."

(b)(5)(B) said "It looks all bad on my side because I had him (Earl) hop in the car with me. Whatever. It's not whatever actually. She got hurt and stuff. But, I didn't mean for it to escalate like that. I was just angry. I got mine. I got mine."

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

I showed (b)(5)(B) a recent colored photograph of (b)(5)(B) and she positively identified (b)(5)(B) as the person she stole the car from.

Detective Astorga took photographs of (b)(5)(B) Sergeant Whalen then came into the room and took photographs of (b)(5)(B) cut on her leg from the knife. The cut was a small cut on the upper portion of her left leg. (b)(5)(B) also had cuts on her right hand from grabbing the knife.

I then interviewed (b)(5)(B) and I recorded the interview. I later placed the recording of the interview into evidence and attached it to this case. The following statement is a summarized account of (b)(5)(B) interview. Refer to the recorded interview for the entire statement.

STATEMENT OF (b)(5)(B) (ARRESTEE):

I read (b)(5)(B) the Miranda Admonishment verbatim from my deputy notebook. I asked (b)(5)(B) "Do you understand each of these rights that I have explained to you?" and Yobani replied "Yes." I asked (b)(5)(B) if he wanted to speak to me and (b)(5)(B) replied "Yes."

(b)(5)(B) said he was picked up by his sister, (b)(5)(B) and her boyfriend, Jorge Earl. (b)(5)(B) was driving a white Toyota Camry and Earl was in the passenger seat. (b)(5)(B) said he had never seen the Camry before but he did not think the Camry was stolen. (b)(5)(B) said he had nothing to do with the stolen car and he simply got picked up by (b)(5)(B) because he needed a ride. (b)(5)(B) was sitting in the backseat of the Camry.

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(b)(5)(B) admitted to running from the Camry at the gas station. (b)(5)(B) said he ran because he had "a little bit of dope." (b)(5)(B) estimated that he had one gram of methamphetamine broken up into three different baggies. (b)(5)(B) said he tossed the bags of methamphetamine prior to being arrested.

I asked (b)(5)(B) what he knew about Jorge Earl. (b)(5)(B) said "Right now he's doing bad. He's all smoked out."

(b)(5)(B) did not know anything about the carjacking or the assault.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

Earl was transported from Tri City Medical Center to Scripps Memorial Hospital in La Jolla, San Diego.

On 10/06/17, I arrived to Scripps Memorial Hospital Room #504 and interviewed Jorge Earl. I recorded my interview with Earl on a department issued audio recording device. The following statement is a summarized account of Earl's interview. Refer to the recorded interview for the entire statement.

STATEMENT OF JORGE EARL (ARRESTEE):

I read Earl the Miranda Admonishment verbatim from my deputy notebook. I asked Earl "Do you understand each of these rights that I have explained to you?" and Earl replied "Yes sir." I asked Earl if he wanted to speak to me and Earl replied "Yes sir."

Earl said he arrived to the house at (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way on 10/04/17. When he arrived, Earl's girlfriend, (b)(5)(B), started arguing with him about being with another girl. (b)(5)(B) was mad that Earl was talking with (b)(5)(B). Earl said he was with (b)(5)(B) earlier that day and that she was "just giving me a ride." Earl said (b)(5)(B) was "talking shit" and "tripping" about Earl hanging out with (b)(5)(B). Earl said (b)(5)(B) is a "really jealous fucking freak."

Earl said (b)(5)(B) arrived to (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way in her white Toyota Camry. When (b)(5)(B) arrived, (b)(5)(B) went outside and "got down" with (b)(5)(B). Earl said (b)(5)(B) started fighting with (b)(5)(B) inside of the car in the driveway. Earl said they were scratching and biting each other. Earl said they finally got out of the car after they were done fighting.

Earl said after (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) fought, (b)(5)(B) willingly gave (b)(5)(B) the keys to the Camry and allowed (b)(5)(B) to drive the car.

(b)(5)(B) got in the driver's seat and Earl got in the front passenger seat.

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Earl said "We were all tweaking. We're all on drugs man." I asked Earl how much methamphetamine he used and he said "a lot."

Earl said he did not see any knives during the fight.

I told Earl that I knew he was withholding information from me and that (b)(5)(B) already admitted to what happened. Earl started crying and asked me "then why are you interviewing me?" Earl said "Look man, I love her dude."

I asked Earl to give me the real version of what happened. Earl said "I'm not gonna put myself in a situation where I'm not main line no more." Earl was referring to "main line" as general population in jail rather than being in protective custody for being labeled as a "snitch."

Earl said he loves (b)(5)(B) and he "would do anything for her, even lie." Earl said "I'm not gonna put her in a situation where she's gonna get fucked."

Earl said (b)(5)(B) is "going through some shit."

I asked Earl "Jorge, what really happened?"

Earl said he wanted to wait to give a statement and wait to see the "discovery" for this case. Earl wanted to hear (b)(5)(B) statement and (b)(5)(B) statement before he gave me an honest statement.

I asked Earl what happened when (b)(5)(B) arrived to (b)(5)(B) Rollins Way. Earl said he just saw (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) fighting. I asked Earl "did you help pull her out of the car?" Earl paused and seemed concerned. Earl replied "Is that what (b)(5)(B) said I did?"

Earl said "she got out by herself and said 'here take the key' and she fucking ran."

Earl and (b)(5)(B) then got in the car and took off.

I told Earl that was a completely nonsensical statement and no one would ever believe that. I asked Earl why would anyone willingly give someone the keys to their car and let them take their car after getting assaulted by that person. Earl said he did not know what happened.

Earl said he wants to hear (b)(5)(B) and (b)(5)(B) statements and see the discovery before he spoke.

I concluded my interview.

REPORT NARRATIVE**DEPUTY'S OBSERVATIONS AND ACTIONS:**

On 10-05-2017, at about 1908 hours, I was working as a Deputy Sheriff assigned as a Canine Handler to the Northern San Diego County Canine Centralization Unit when I received a radio call (CAD #E4475960) to assist the Vista Gang Enforcement Team who were watching a stolen vehicle from a carjacking and was occupied by three subjects at the intersection of North Melrose Drive and Olive Avenue.

While I was enroute, Deputy Haddad (#0803) advised over Sheriff's dispatch that the vehicle was parked at the 76 Gas Station located at the intersection of North Melrose Drive and Olive Avenue. He also advised that the occupants in the vehicle were suspects involved in a carjacking where the victim was stabbed and dragged out of her car. Prior to my arrival, all three occupants fled from the stolen car. Two of the subjects were detained shortly after. The third subject, later identified as Jorge Earl, was still outstanding.

I arrived on scene at 1920 hours. I met with Deputy Danza (5662). Deputy Danza advised me the subject, (Earl) outstanding matched the description of the suspect and that there was Probable cause to arrest him for 245(a)(1) PC-Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and 215 PC- Carjacking. He said Earl fled from Deputies and was last seen running eastbound on Olive Avenue and was wearing a black sweatshirt and jean shorts. He advised me Earl has an extensive history of violent crimes that include 211 PC-Robbery, 459 PC-Burglary, VC 2800.2(a)-Felony Evading and 148(a)(1) PC- Resisting Arrest. He also advised me the prior evening, Oceanside Police located a gun inside Earl's car after he fled from officers.

I know based on my law enforcement experience as a Deputy Sheriff that felony suspects will often become extremely violent when confronted and use any means possible to escape capture. They also have a high tolerance for pain due to possibly having alcohol and illegal drugs in their systems. This was a high risk incident which was going to place law enforcement in a position of disadvantage based on the fact that the suspects would potentially see law enforcement arrive before we could see them. It was also unknown if the suspect was armed with a weapon. My intention was to have the canine available at the

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scene as a psychological deterrent to any aggressive acts the suspects might make against us. Additionally, I wanted to prevent the using of a higher level of force.

After I spoke with Deputy Danza, I retrieved my K9 partner, Marko from the back seat and attached him to a ten foot lead. San Diego Police Helicopter (ABLE) was also on scene assisting with the search. Prior to conducting my search with my K9, ABLE gave two loud and clear K9 announcements over the loud speaker. Deputy Danza and I then conducted a field search with my K9 on lead. We began our search from the suspect's vehicle.

I began my search eastbound on Olive Avenue. During the search, perimeter Deputies on scene advised they last saw Earl jump a fence to the apartment complex located at 391 North Melrose. Deputy Danza and I backtracked to the suspect vehicle and then made our way to the apartment complex at 391 North Melrose Drive.

While at the apartment complex, we met with Deputy Deputies LaMaster (#0037), Meyers (#7284) and Nahan (#3298). I was told by Deputies that the occupants of 391 North Melrose apartment # [REDACTED] was a known to associate with Earl and that he may be possibly hiding there. Deputy Meyers made contact with the occupants of the apartment. Deputy Meyers advised me the occupants gave Deputies consent to search their apartment for Earl who they claimed was not in the apartment.

The front door was open, at which point I gave two K9 announcements. The K9 announcements consisted of the following: "Sheriff's Department with a dog, come out now or you may get bit." After my K9 announcements, Earl did not show himself nor did I hear anything. Deputies Nahan and Danza assisted me with the search.

While I maintaining Marko on a traffic lead, I gave him the search command and he immediately began searching the residence. Trash and personal belongings, tools and random items littered the floors and surfaces. Marko and I searched the living room, kitchen and a bedroom. When I exited the bedroom, I noticed a crawl space opening on the bottom of what appeared to be the heater space room. From where I was standing I could not see all the way inside. I removed my Glock handgun from the holster and turned on the handgun flashlight. I removed my handgun because of the nature of the suspect's criminal history I felt the situation may escalate to the use of deadly force. I shined my light into the crawl space and observed a male Hispanic who fit the description of Earl lying on his side and curled up. At the same time, Marko showed a sign he was in odor of a human scent and began pulling me towards the crawl space, indicating to me someone was inside there.

I pointed my handgun at Earl and ordered him to show me his hands or he may get bit. Earl didn't move or say anything and due to the confine space, I could not see his hands and feared he could have a weapon in his hand or nearby and use it to ambush deputies.

Based on my training and experience, I know when felony suspects when captured or cornered may commit violent and potentially lethal actions against law enforcement or citizens to avoid capture and may become desperate enough to take innocent people nearby hostage if they see an opportunity to improve their chances of escape. Taking into an account Earl was demonstrating an eagerness and desperation to avoid arrest and maybe possibly armed with unknown weapons and the seriousness of crime at hand, I decided to deploy my K9 partner and prevent the use of a higher level of force. Using Marko as a force option would prevent me and / or my partners from possibly getting injured.

At 2008 hours, Marko made contact with Earl's right calf and pulled him out of the crawl space. Earl was kicking his legs and with his free leg was trying to kick away Marko. I shouted at Earl to stop kicking the dog and his legs. Earl continued to thrash his body and legs. I shouted at Earl again to stop kicking and he complied. Deputy Nahan assisted with placing Earl in handcuffs. Once Earl was in handcuffs, I physically removed Marko from his hold on Earl. A request for paramedics was then made for the canine contact along with a notification to the Canine Supervisor, Sergeant Pavlenko (#0760).

Vista Fire/ Medic #121 arrived on scene and medically triaged Earl's injuries from the K9 bite. Earl was transported to Tri-City Medical Facility in the City of Vista for further treatment. Physician Assistant (b)(5)(B) medically evaluated Earl who had sustained a canine contact bite on the right calf.

Sergeant Pavlenko from the Sheriff Canine Unit arrived at Tri-City Medical Facility to complete a K-9 deployment investigation. I later completed a Department of Animal Control Bite Report, which was faxed to the Carlsbad Humane

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Society. A County of San Diego (Use of Force) SO-120 form was completed, which detailed the canine contact points and pointing of my handgun during the apprehension of the Earl. During the K9 deployment investigation, photos were taken of Earl's injury from the K9 bite and an audio recording of the K9 Sergeant interview. The photos and an audio recording of the interview with Earl were later transferred to a CD and later placed into the Vista Patrol Station Evidence.

Earl was charged with violation of 245(a)(1) PC-Assault with a Deadly Weapon, 215 PC- Carjacking, 182(a)(1) PC-Conspiracy to Commit Crime, 148(a)(1) PC- Resisting a Peace Officer, 600 PC- Willfully Harm Peace Officer's working dog. Earl was later booked into the Vista Detention Facility.

This incident was captured on a department issued body worn camera (BWC). I reviewed the BWC video partially prior to this report.

I conducted no further investigation.

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While In route to the scene, I heard Detective Haddad advise over the radio the vehicle, a white 1997 Toyota Camry CA (b)(5)(B) was parked in front of the gas pumps. Detective Haddad further advised the suspects (b)(5)(B) and Jorge Earl were sitting inside the vehicle.

I approached from the south and staged for additional units to arrive. Once hearing units advise over the radio they were moving in, I pulled my marked patrol vehicle to the beginning of the south driveway entrance and exited. Based upon information by detectives regarding the victim being violently attacked and stabbed during a carjacking, I removed my department issued Glock 22 from my holster and pointed it at the front passenger, Jorge Earl. I immediately yelled, "Sheriff's Department, show me your hands." Earl immediately exited the front passenger's seat and fled northeast through the parking lot of the gas station and continued eastbound on Olive Avenue. A second subject later identified as (b)(5)(B) fled from the left rear passenger's seat and fled with Earl.

I holstered my Glock 22 and pursued both subjects on foot eastbound on Olive Avenue. Earl and (b)(5)(B) jumped the metal fence at 538 Olive Avenue and fled southbound through the parking lot. (b)(5)(B) passed the first building and as he fled began reaching into his pockets and turned left down the driveway. Fearing (b)(5)(B) was possibly armed and reaching for a weapon, I pursued him to prevent an ambush. (b)(5)(B) continued running eastbound down the driveway until he was stopped by a brick wall. (b)(5)(B) had his back to me and continued to reach inside his right pocket. Fearing (b)(5)(B) was reaching for a weapon, I drew my department issued Glock 22 and pointed it at (b)(5)(B). I immediately instructed (b)(5)(B) to stop reaching into his pocket and get on the ground. (b)(5)(B) continued to reach into his pocket. I again instructed him to stop reaching into his pocket and get on the ground. (b)(5)(B) pulled out a clear plastic baggie, turned towards me and threw it over his shoulder. Once the baggie was tossed, (b)(5)(B) complied with my instructions and laid down on his stomach. I immediately holstered my Glock 22 and took (b)(5)(B) into custody without further incident.

I believed that if I did not point my weapon at the suspect(s) it may have placed me and my partners at a tactical disadvantage and the suspects could have ambushed us. Deputy Bowman and I later recovered a clear plastic bag containing four (4) white bindles (See Deputy Bowman's report for further details).

REPORT NARRATIVE

Origin:

On 10/5/17, at about 1907 hours, I responded to a report a vehicle involved in a carjacking at the 76 gas station located at 485 N. Melrose in the City of Vista (EV #E4475960).

Deputy's Observations and Actions:

On 10/5/17, at about 1907 hours, I responded to a report of a carjacking vehicle spotted at 485 N. Melrose at the 76 gas station. The vehicle involved was a 1997 white Toyota Camry with California license plate # (b)(5)(B). I had previous knowledge of the incident that occurred on 10/5/17, at about 1620 hours, at (b)(5) Rollins way in Vista (CAD #E4473971). The suspects were identified as (b)(5)(B), (b)(5) and Jorge Earl (b)(5). Upon arriving at the location, Detective Haddad stated two subjects were running eastbound on Olive Ave. I observed one of the subjects running, a Hispanic male adult with a shaved head, wearing a dark colored shirt and dark colored shorts running eastbound and then southbound, jumping over the gate at MC Tires at 538 Olive Ave. I pursued the suspect on foot, later identified as Jorge Earl (b)(5), southbound through the parking lot. I observed Earl jump the fence heading southbound into the condominiums located at 391 N. Melrose Ave. I was able to jump on top of a vehicle and observe Earl running on the south side of the condos at 391 N. Melrose and then head north between the buildings where unit (b) is located. I gave commands to Earl to stop running and to get on the ground. Earl refused to obey the commands. I broadcast this information over the radio to advise responding units to the area. Based on my training and experience I know that 391 N. Melrose unit (b) is a common meeting place for people who use narcotics. We have received several complaints about the subjects in that unit and have served search warrants there in the past. I know that the homeowner, (b)(5)(B), (b)(5), is on probation with a valid 4th Amendment Waiver.

After seeing Earl run between the buildings towards unit (b) I jumped the fence and took a southern perimeter along 391 N. Melrose. At about 1927 hours, SDPD helicopter ABLE arrived on scene to assist in the search. ABLE made several announcements over the public address system giving a description of what Earl was wearing and the subject's name of

CONFIDENTIAL:

On 10-05-17 at about 1908 hours, Deputy Crawford and his canine partner, Marko, responded to assist Vista units with searching for outstanding carjacking suspects. A detective in the area advised he had observation on a carjacking vehicle with the suspects sitting inside. The suspects were all named by the detective. The detective also stated the suspects stabbed the victim during the carjacking.

As other patrol units arrived in the area the three suspects fled from the vehicle on foot. Two were quickly apprehended. The outstanding suspect, Jorge Earl (b)(5)(A) evaded the first responding deputies. Deputy Crawford arrived and began searching the area with his canine. After a lengthy search it was determined Earl was possibly hiding in a nearby condominium. Deputies checked the condominium and Deputy Crawford had Marko on a short lead. During the search Deputy Crawford saw Earl hiding in a crawl space. Earl was ordered out and advised if he did not comply he would get bit by the dog. Earl did not comply and Marko was deployed to apprehend Earl. Marko bit Earl on the right leg and pulled him out of the crawl space. Earl was eventually taken into custody and placed under arrest for carjacking, assault with a deadly weapon, conspiracy, and various other charges. Earl was transported to Tri City Hospital for treatment of his injuries.

REVIEW:

On 10-05-17, at about 2000 hours, I was monitoring the radio communications related to the event. I heard the advisement of a canine contact and was told Earl would be transported to Tri City Hospital located at 4002 Vista Way in Oceanside.

I met with Deputy Crawford at the hospital and completed this investigation.

I made all appropriate notifications to both the Emergency Services Lieutenant as well as the on-call Divisional of Inspectional Services Sergeant Stranger.

Photos were taken of Earl's injuries were taken at a later date by Sergeant McConnaughey. I conducted an interview with Earl while at the hospital. The photographs of Earl and the audio recording of the interview were copied to a CD-R disc and attached to this investigation. Earl's statement is essentially as follows.

STATEMENT OF EARL:

Earl said he understood the interview was being recorded.

Earl said he doesn't suffer from any mental illness.

Earl has no problems with his ears or eyes.

Earl said he is not taking any medications. Earl told me he uses methamphetamine, marijuana, and alcohol. Earl told me he used methamphetamine at about 1000 hours that day.

I asked Earl if he heard the Sheriff's K9 announcement. Earl said he did not hear the warning because he was underneath the house.

Earl said the dog was biting him for a minute.

Earl said he did not know how the dog was taken off of him.

When asked if there was anything he would like to add Earl told me he told deputies he wasn't resisting. Earl said the deputies were not handcuffing him they were just letting the dog bite him. Earl said the deputies were laughing also.

I concluded my interview of Earl.

CONCLUSION:

Deputy Crawford was wearing his issued body worn camera (BWC) during the incident. I reviewed the video footage of the incident prior to concluding this investigation. Deputy Crawford's decision to use his canine was based on the following factors:

Earl was involved in a violent felony crime of assault with a deadly weapon and carjacking.

Earl evaded deputies by fleeing on foot into a residence that he was familiar with.

Earl hid in a small crawl space that would have been unsafe for deputies to go into to get him out.

Earl refused to obey lawful commands to surrender during canine announcements.

The use of the canine was **within policy** and deployed in an appropriate manner.

INJURIES:

Earl had lacerations, rakes, and punctures on his right calf.

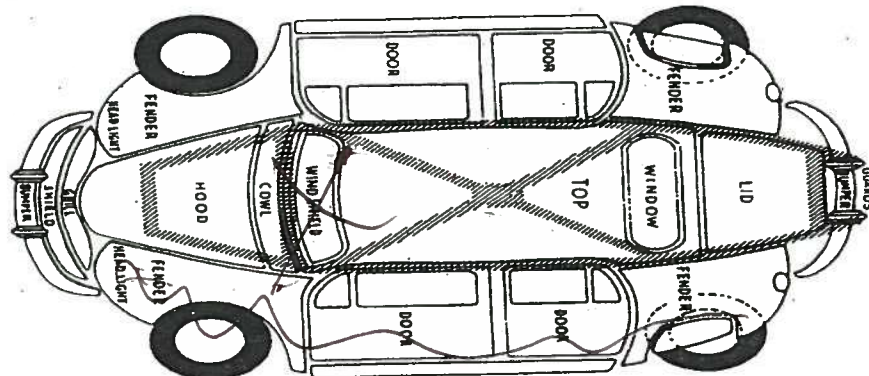
